



Stewarton, East Ayrshire

Population 7,065

Stewarton is in East Ayrshire. It emerged as an 18th century textile town becoming known as 'The Bonnet Toun' due to its speciality in making headgear including the Glengarry and Tam O'Shanter. It is a market and rural service centre. There are small engineering works.

This type of medium-sized town is extremely mixed in terms of demographics. There is a particularly wide range of people, housing and activities. The number of older couples with no children are higher than average. There is a mix of professional and non-professional jobs, and part-time and self-employment are both important for a significant proportion of residents. Socioeconomic status is higher than in other kinds of town and there is a mix of professionals and nonprofessionals, those with higher and lower educational attainment.

Stewarton is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Bonnybridge, Lesmahagow, Galston, and Loanhead.



Stewarton is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Stewarton is grouped with 13 other towns. 






Employment type(%working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation (% aged 16-74)




Social Grade (% households aged 16-64)





Coloured and grey lines/pins show the main and smaller commuter flows, respectively, between this town and the other towns in Scotland.


