Aberlour is in Moray. It was an estate village established by the Grant family. It is known for its distillery and shortbread factory. It is located on the Speyside way and tourism is a key industry.

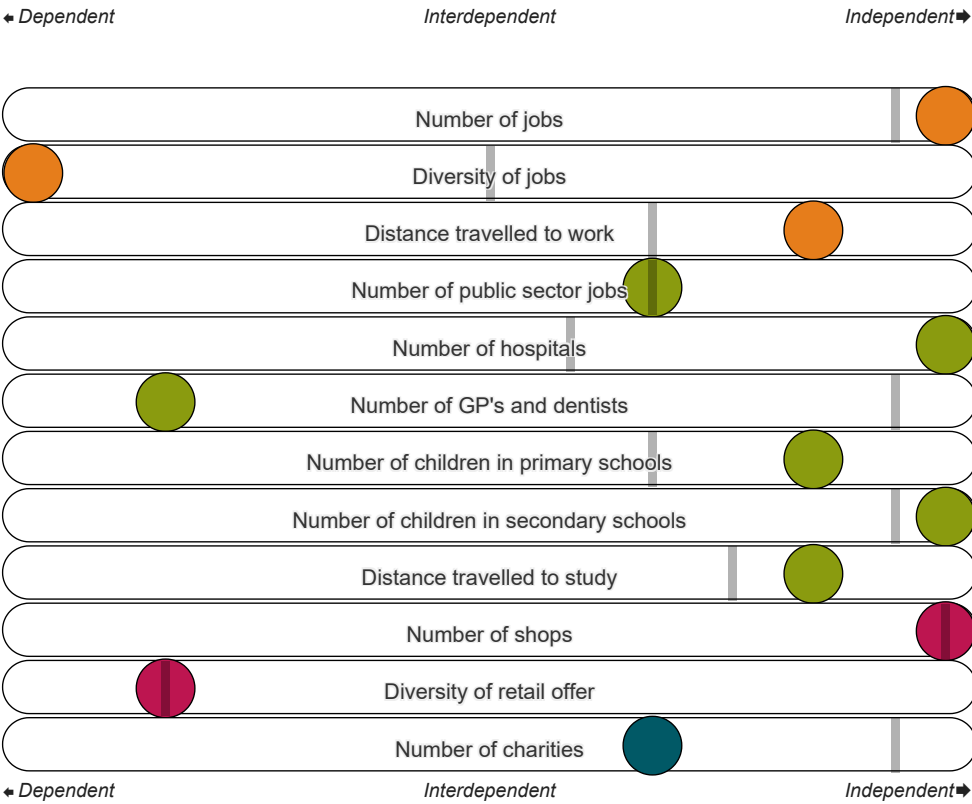
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Aberlour is an independent to interdependent town.

Aberlour is an **independent to interdependent** town.

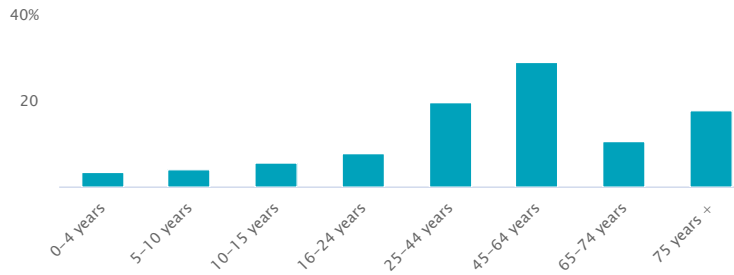

It differs in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, and GP's and dentists. Aberlour differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

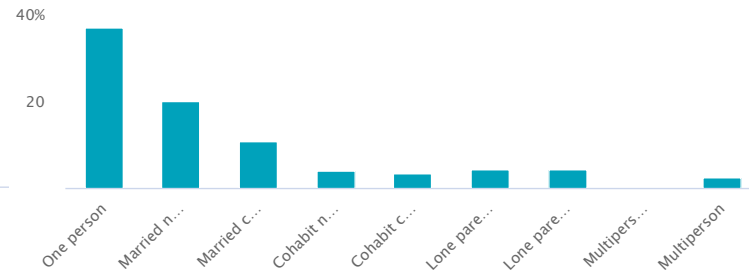

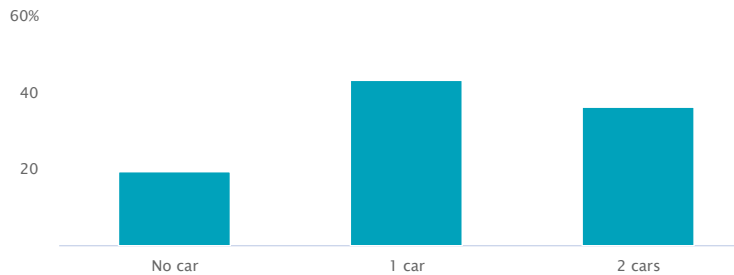
Age



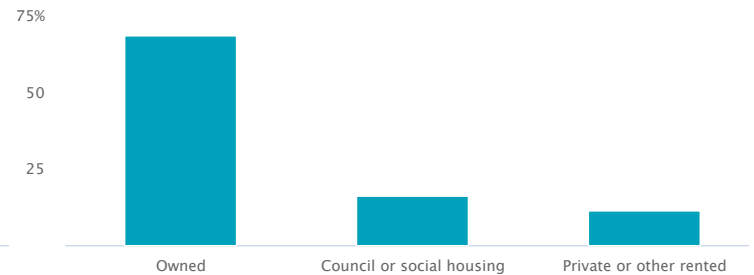
Household composition

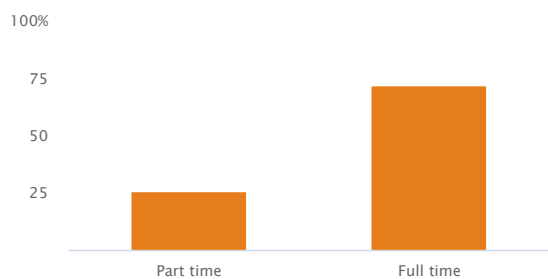

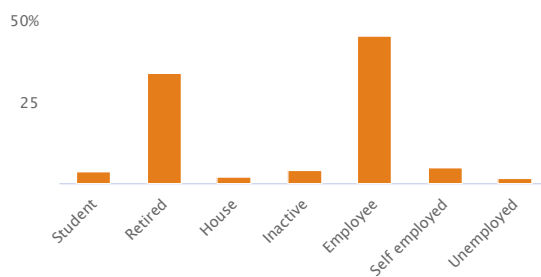
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



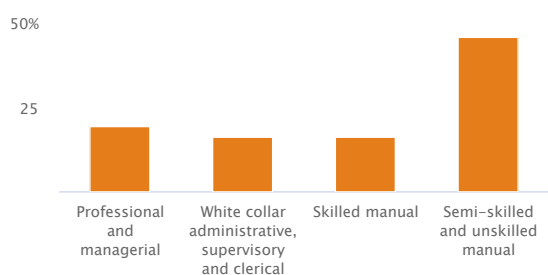
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

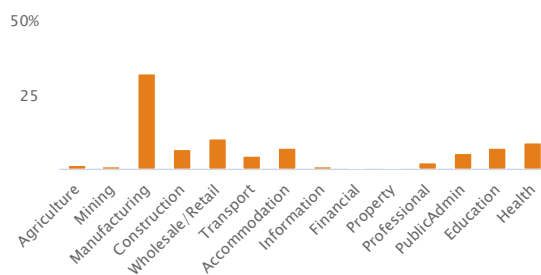

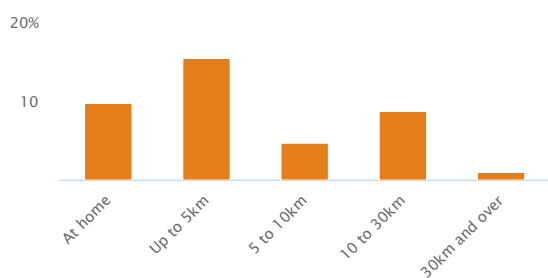
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

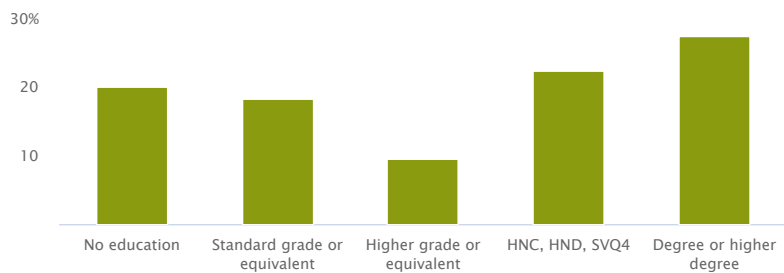


Distance travelled to work

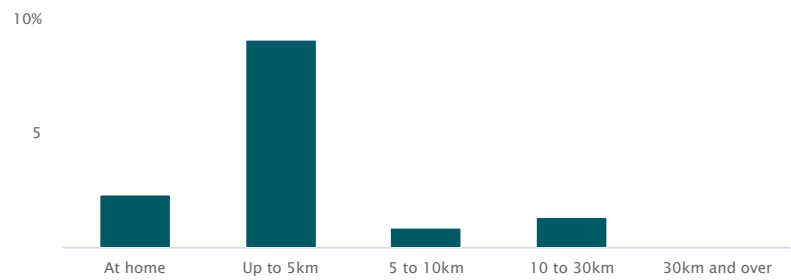
