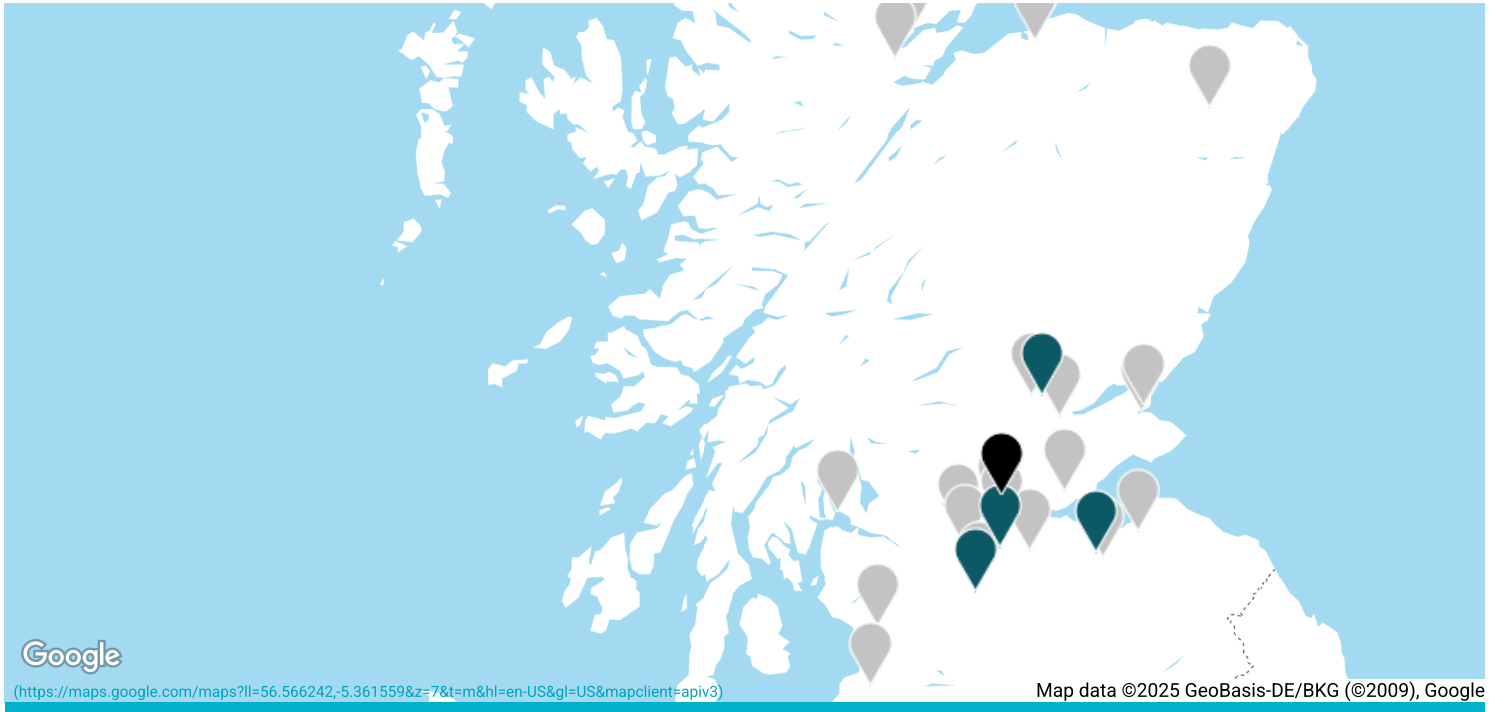

Airth is a historic trading port on the Forth, now in Falkirk Council.

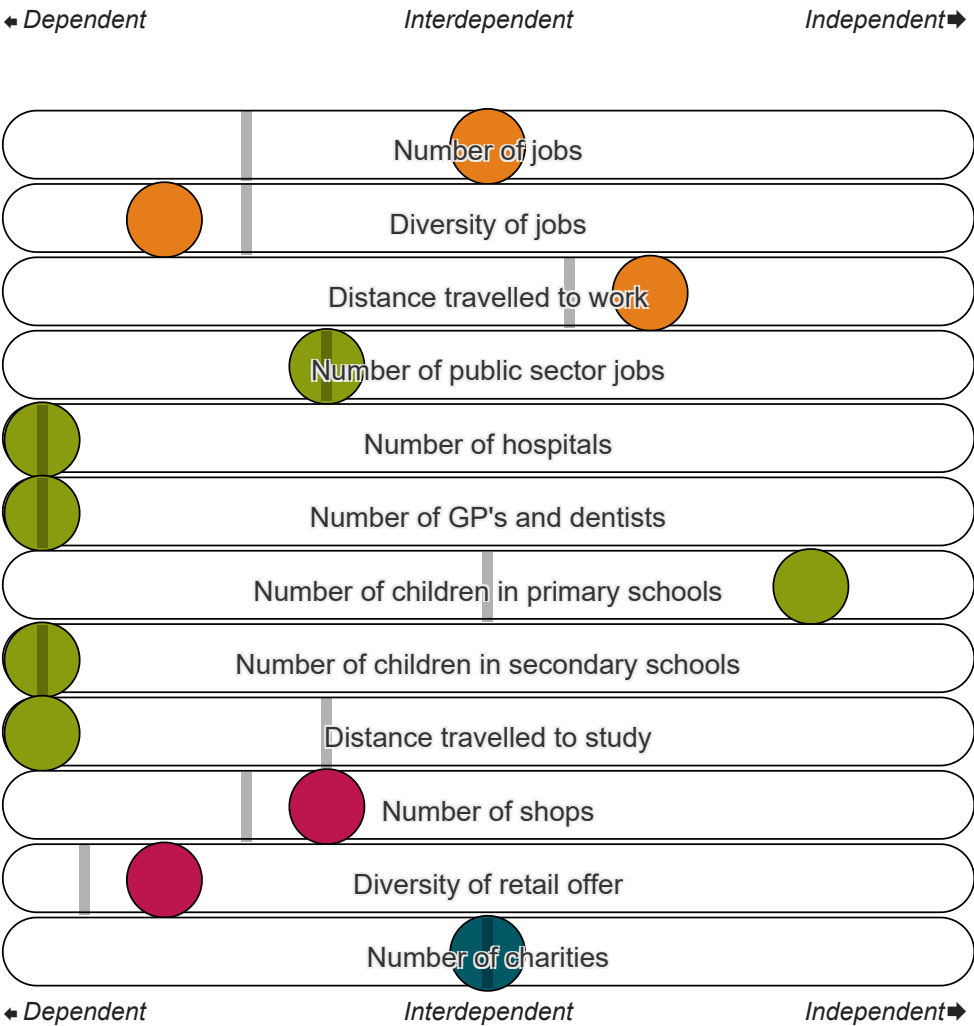
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Airth is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Airth is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Airth is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. Airth differs most from its group in the distance travelled to study.

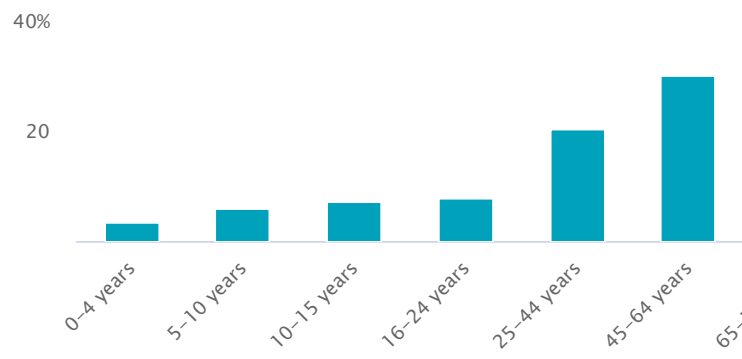

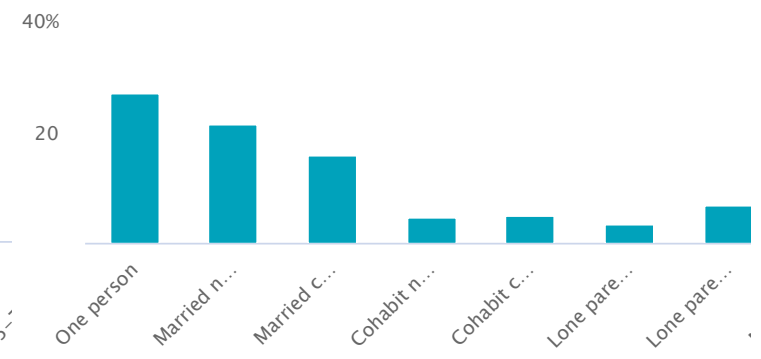

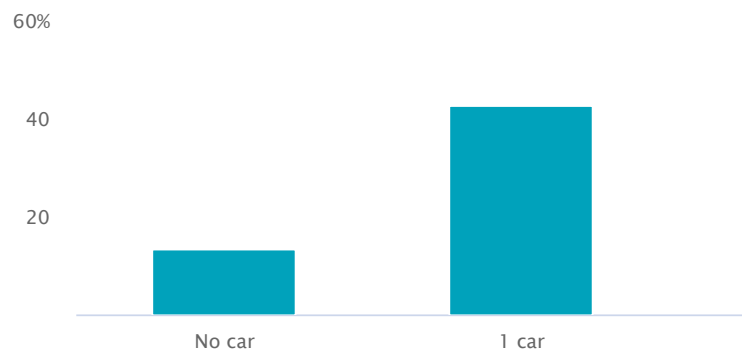

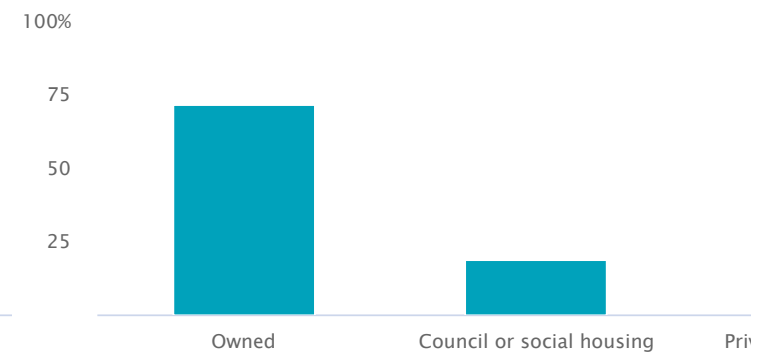

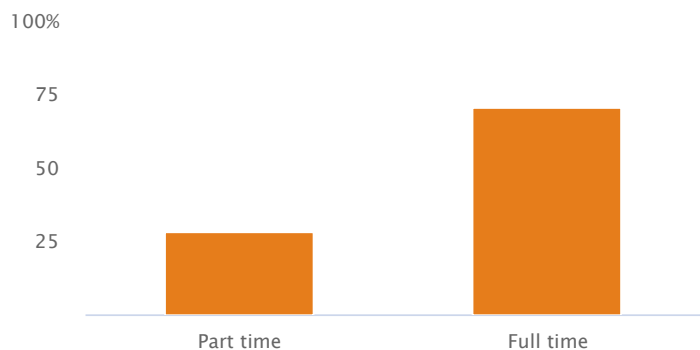

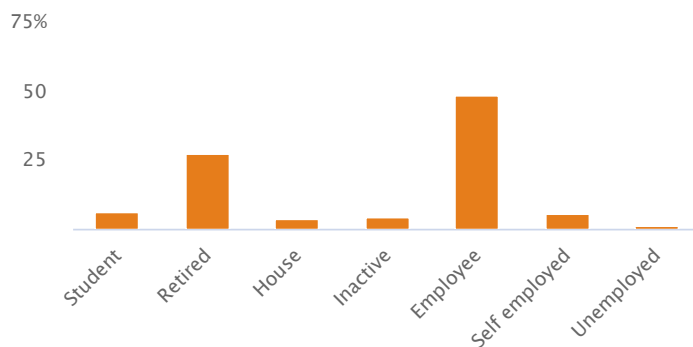
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



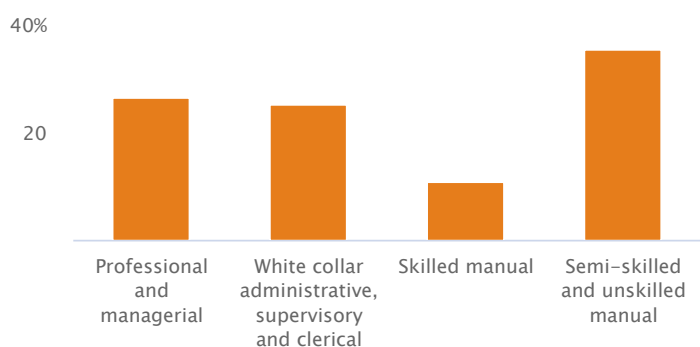
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

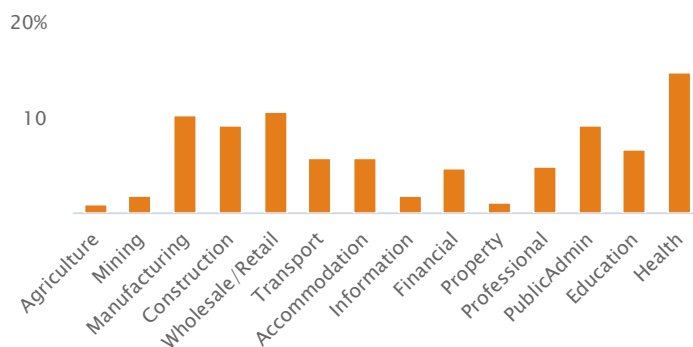

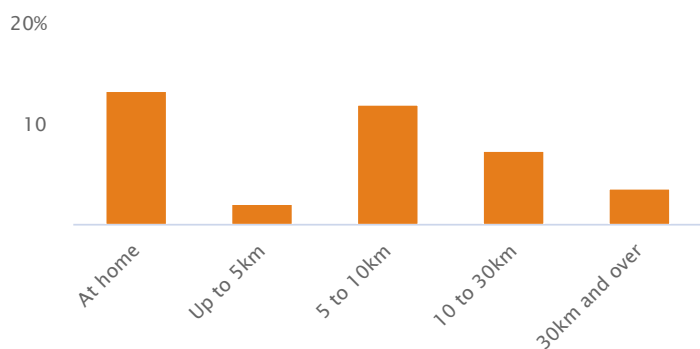
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

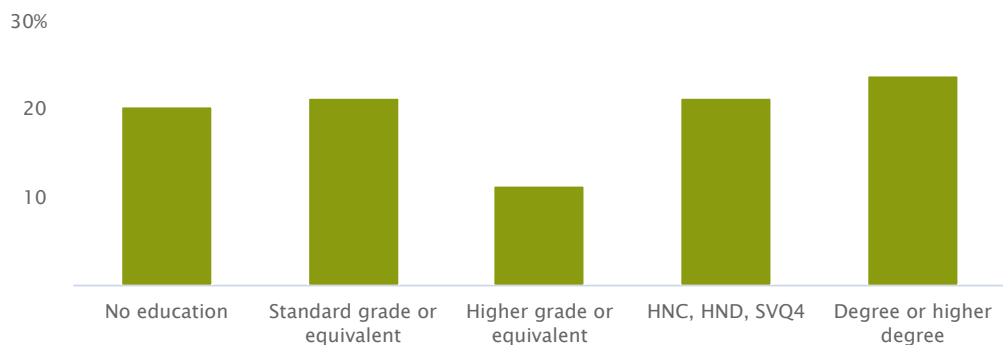


Distance travelled to work

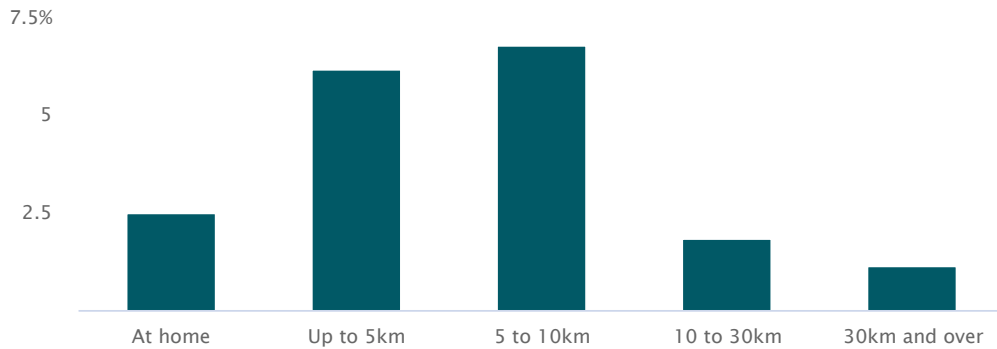
