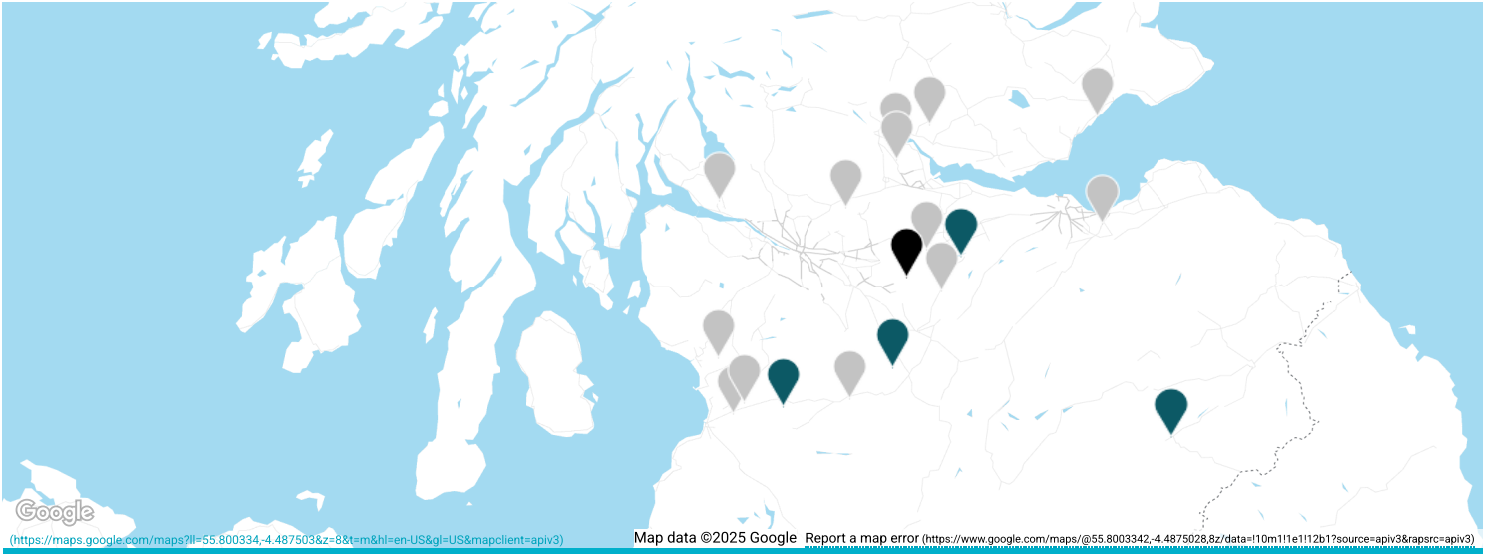




Allanton

Allanton is in South Lanarkshire. It developed in association with coal mining in the area, specifically the Kingshill Colliery. Whilst the mine is closed there is still open cast mining in the area.

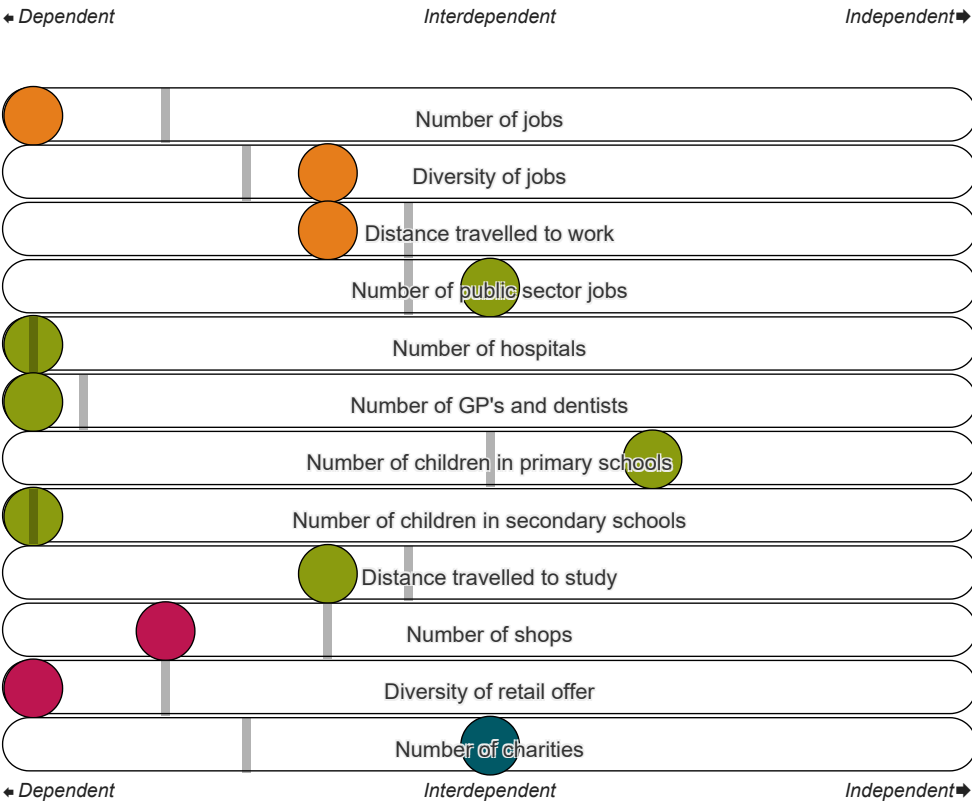
In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Allanton is a dependent to interdependent town.

Allanton is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Allanton is grouped with 17 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

Population change 2011 to 2022**-12%**

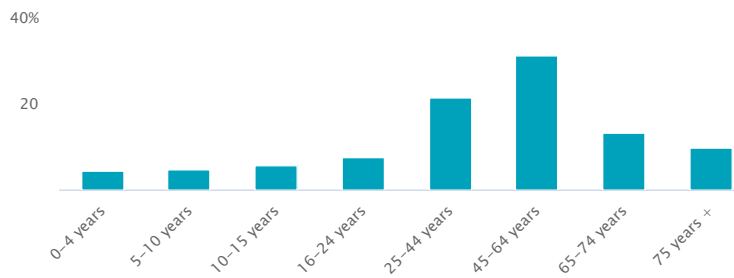

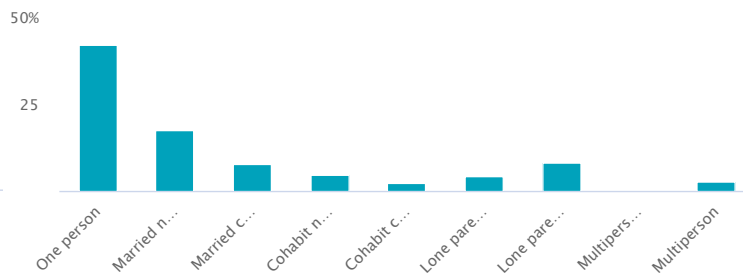

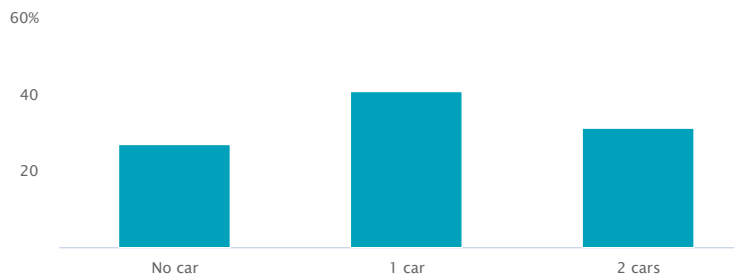

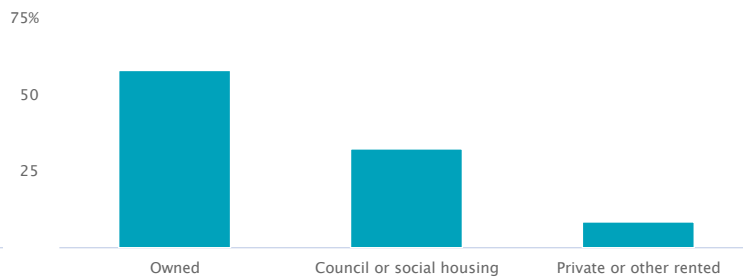
Household composition

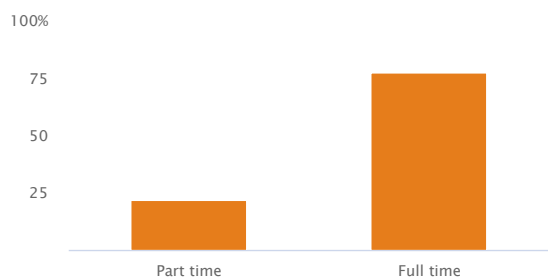

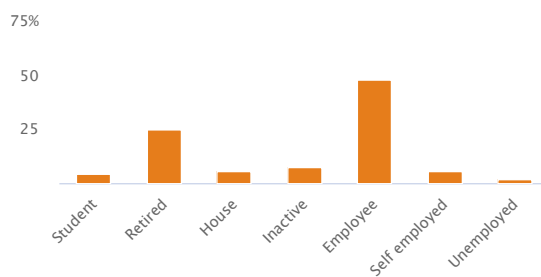
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



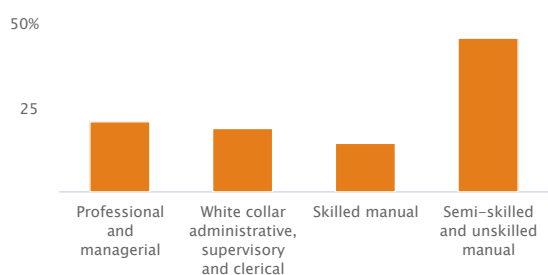
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

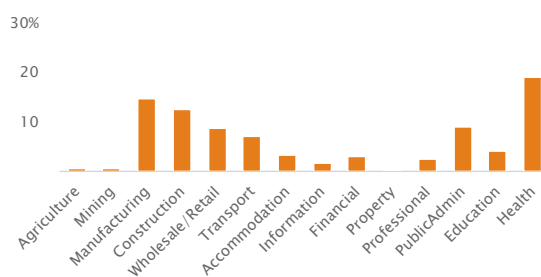


Social Grade

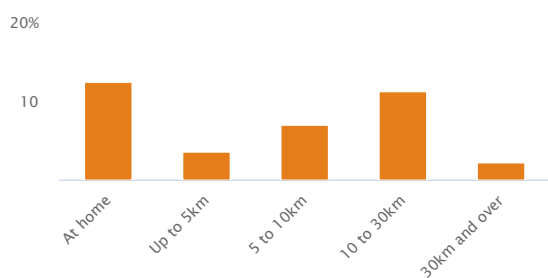
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

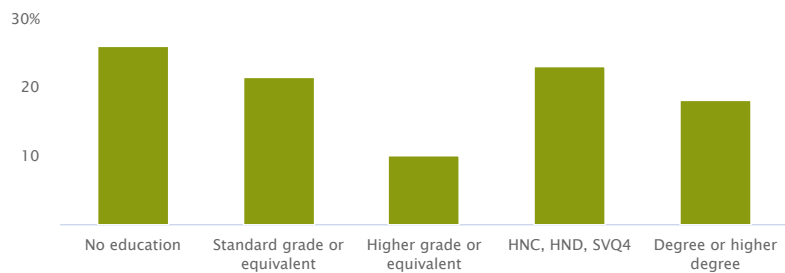


Distance travelled to work

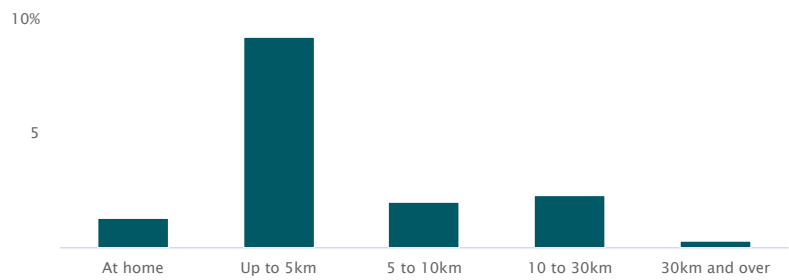
