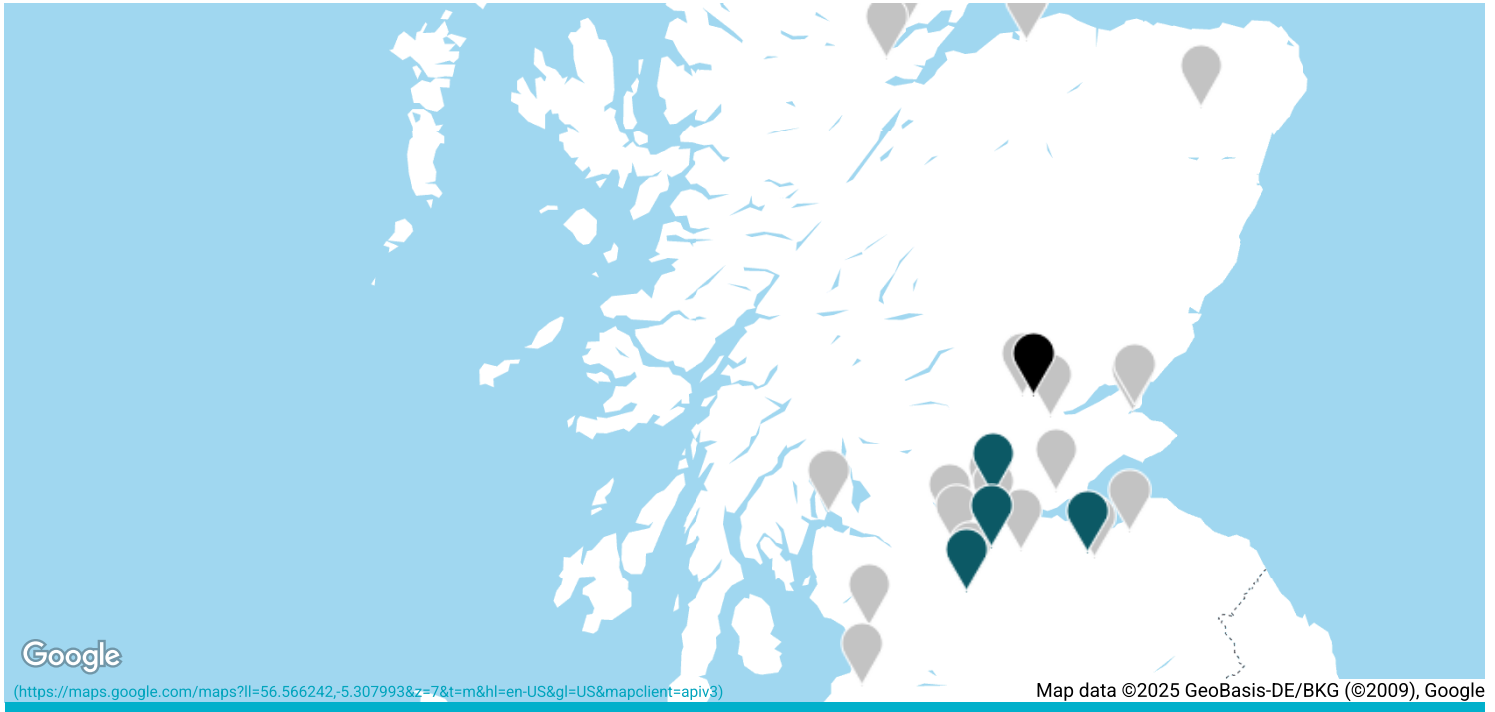




Almondbank

Almondbank in Perth and Kinross is located on the River Almond. Once a textile centre using the water from the river the town is now a suburb of Perth. It is home to the Defence Aviation Repair Agency.

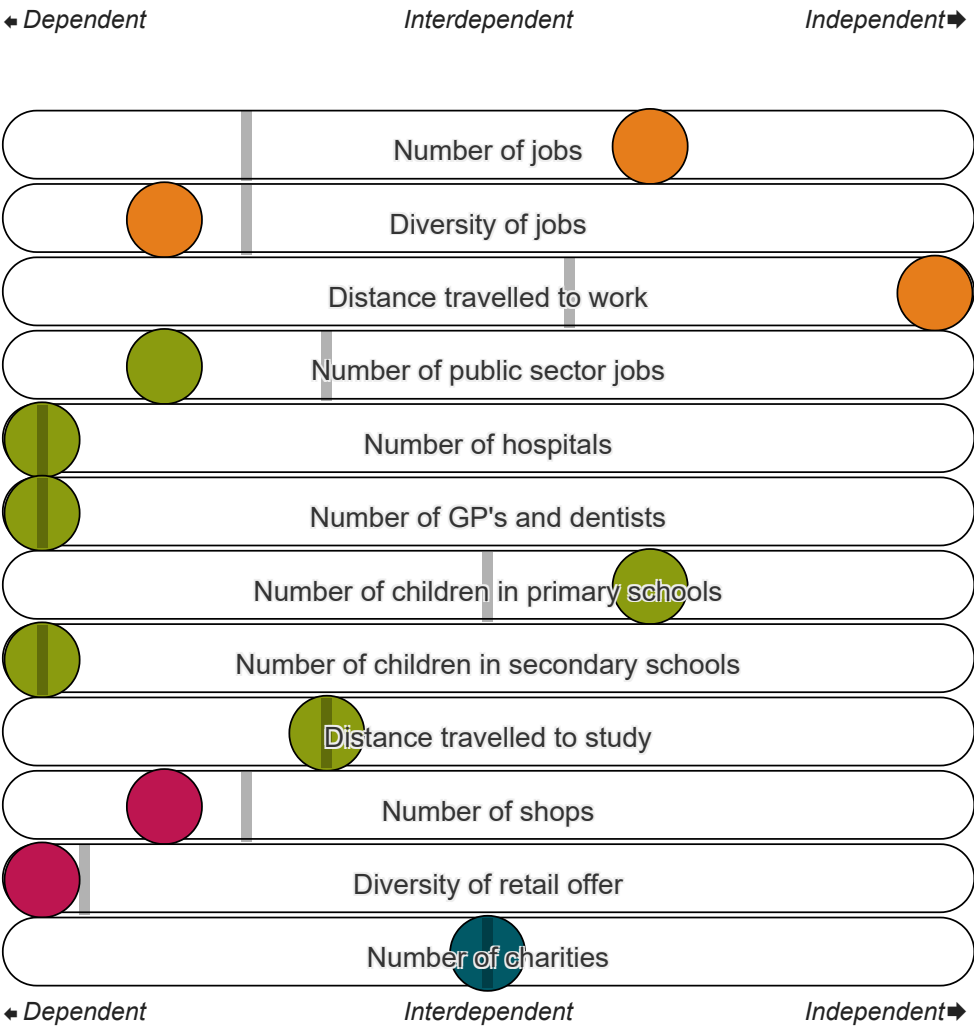
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Almondbank is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Almondbank is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the distance travelled to work. Almondbank differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

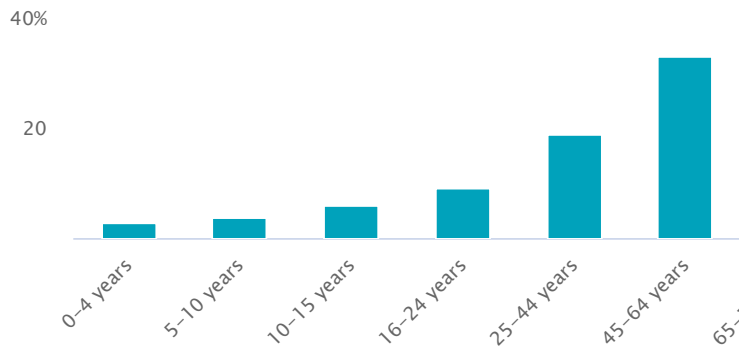

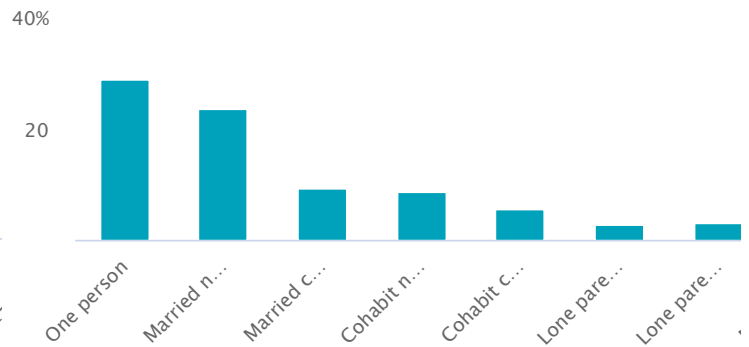

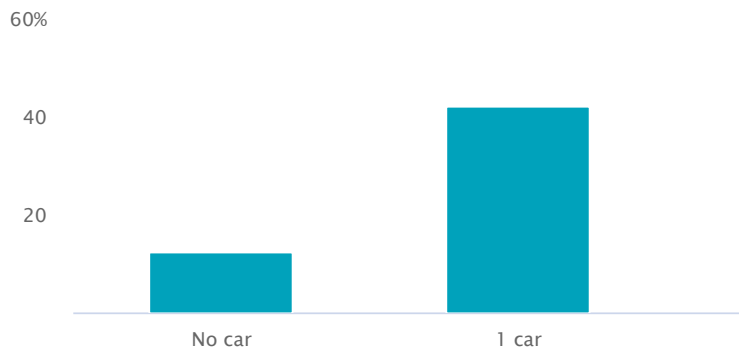

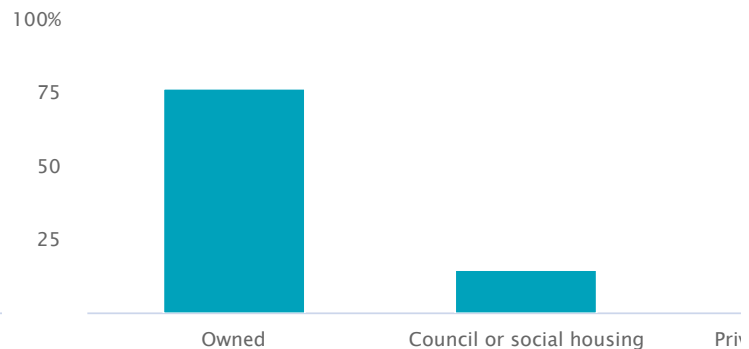
Household composition

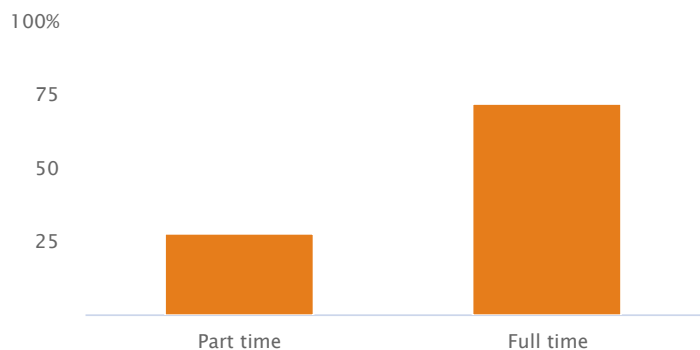

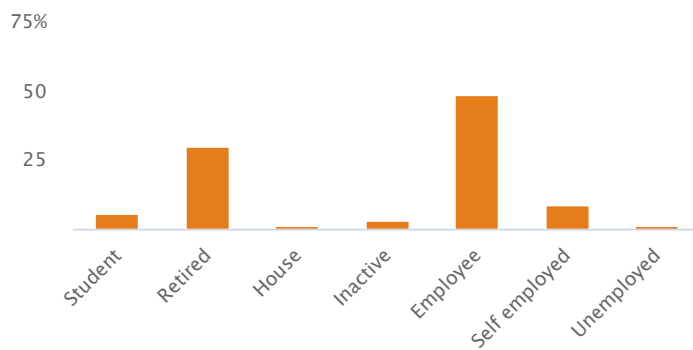
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



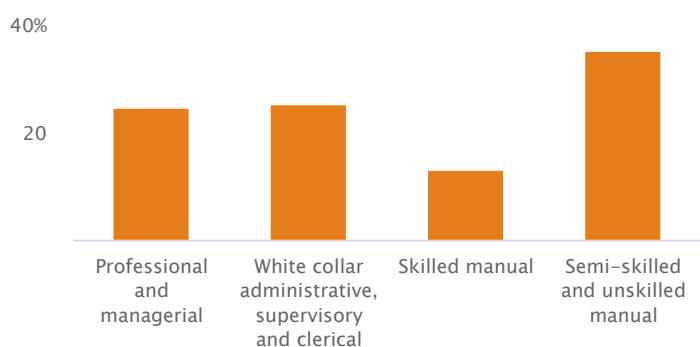
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

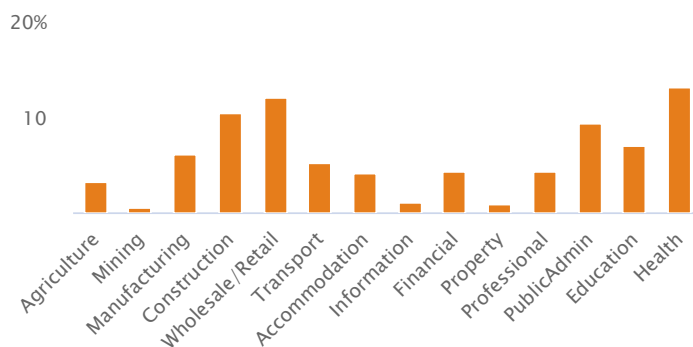


Social Grade

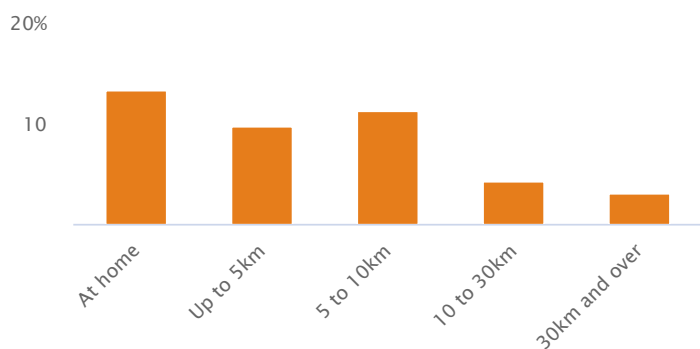
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

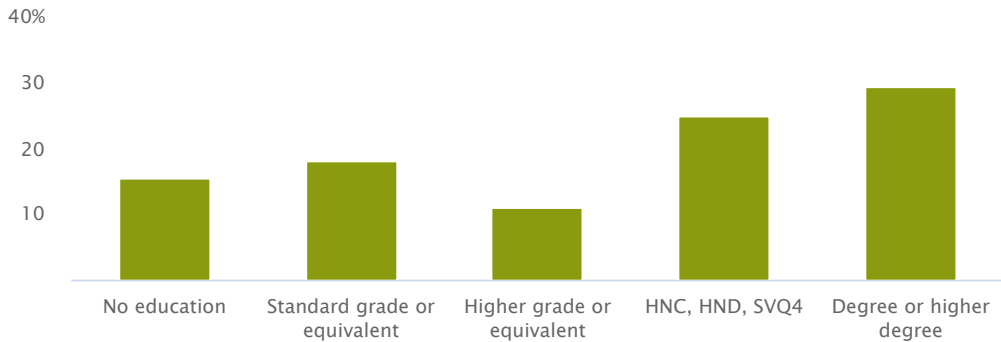


Distance travelled to work

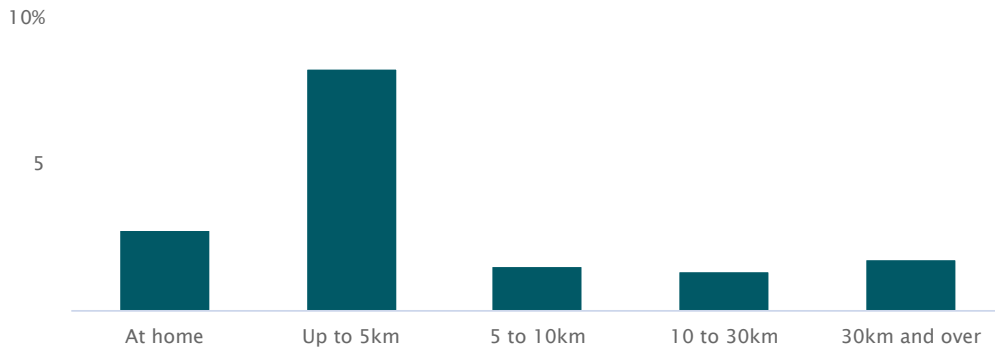
