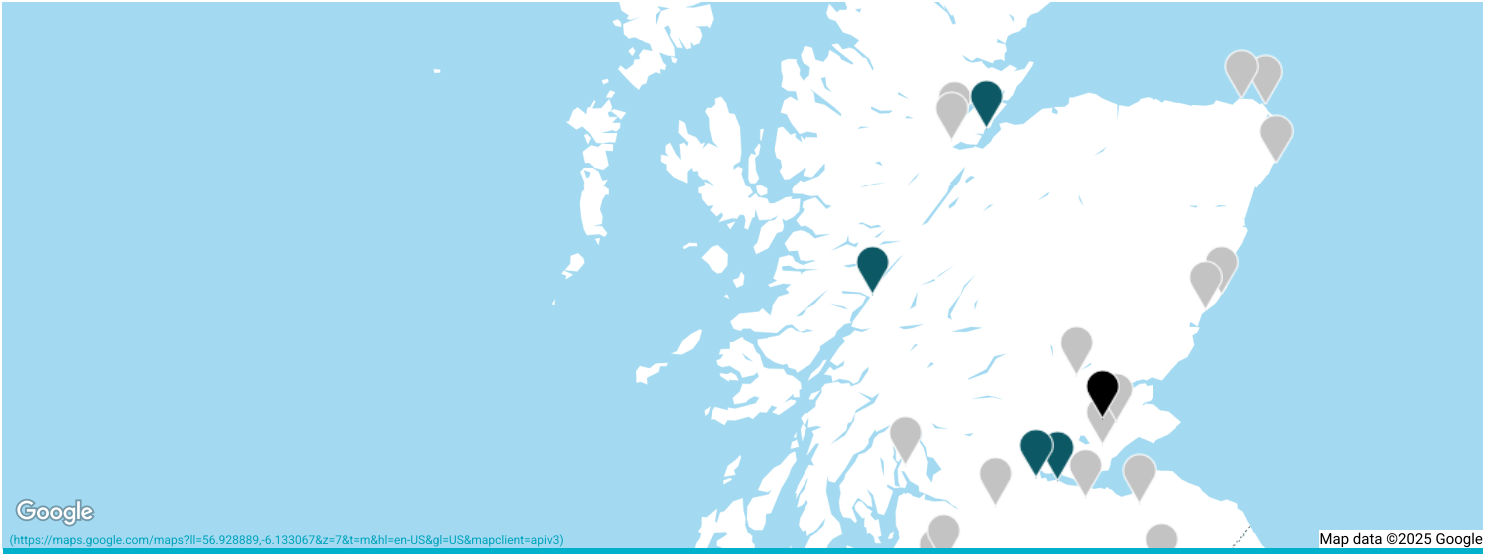




Auchtermuchty

Auchtermuchty in Fife dates from at least Roman times. Weaving, bleaching and distilling were the mainstay of the economy up until the 1700s when a foundry was opened. The town retains a number of local enterprises. It is also popular as a commuter village.

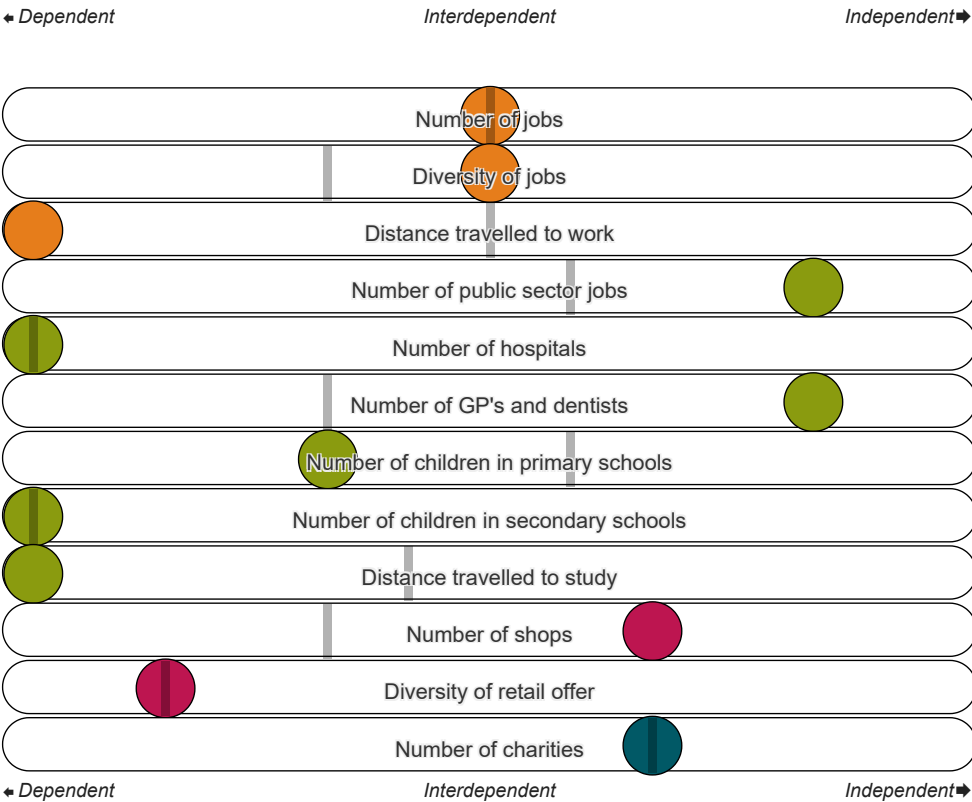
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Auchtermuchty is an interdependent to dependent town.

Auchtermuchty is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Auchtermuchty is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists. Auchtermuchty differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

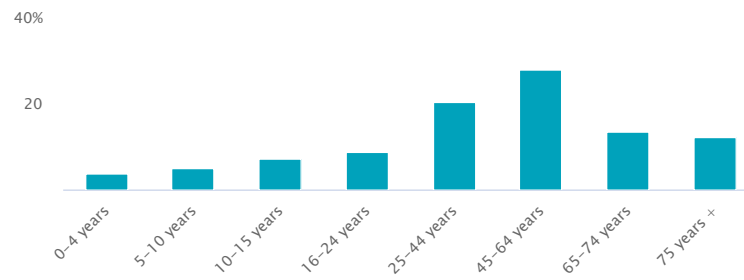

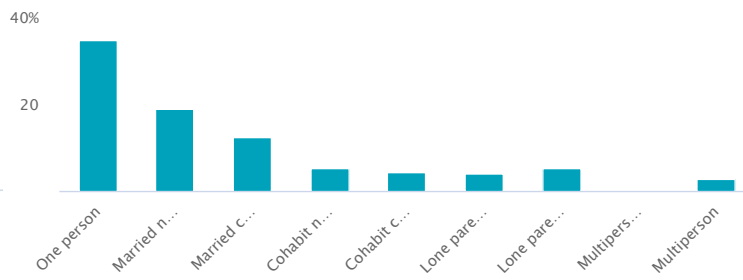

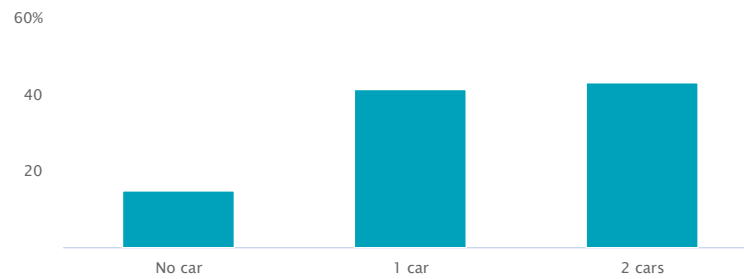

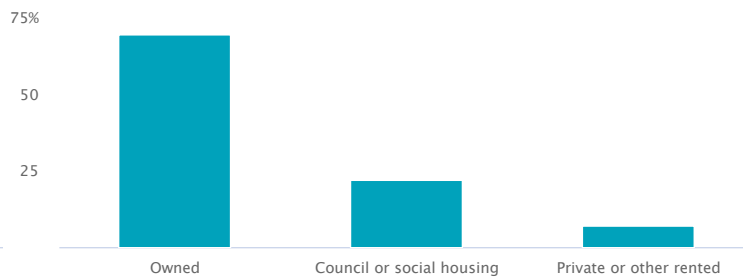

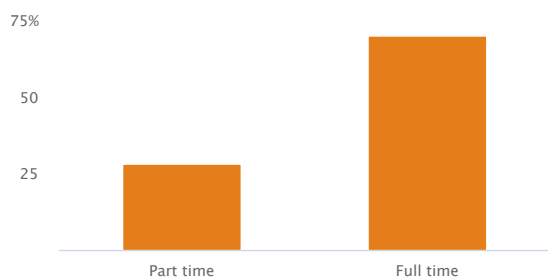

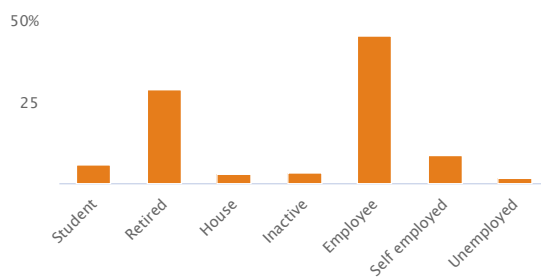
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



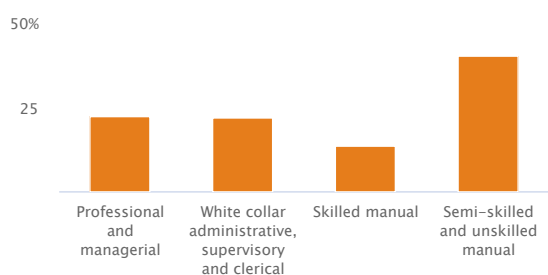
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

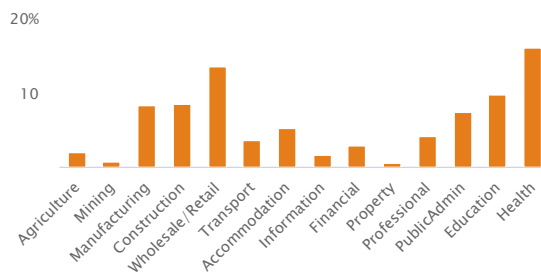

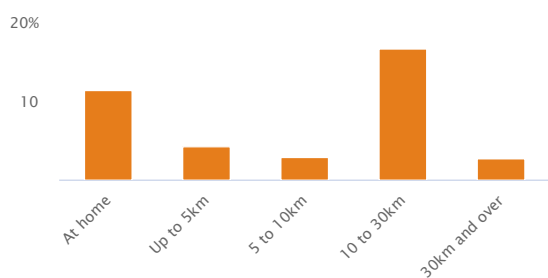
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

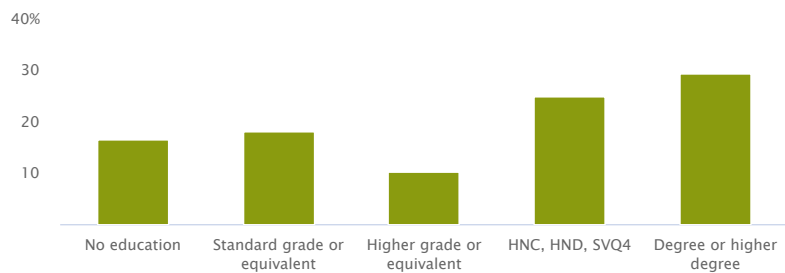


Distance travelled to work

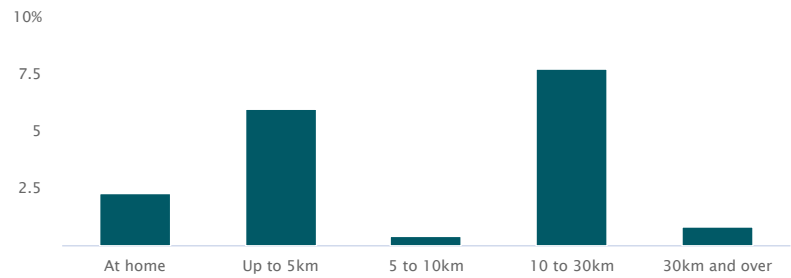
