Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill in Fife are located on the Fife coalfield and developed as mining towns in the 19th century. When the pits closed open cast mining continued at Westfield but is now closed.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Faifley, Fauldhouse, Hallglen, and Hurlford and Crookedholm.

Inter-relationships



Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill is a **dependent** to interdependent town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill is grouped with 8 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

Ballingry, Lochore and Crosshill differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






