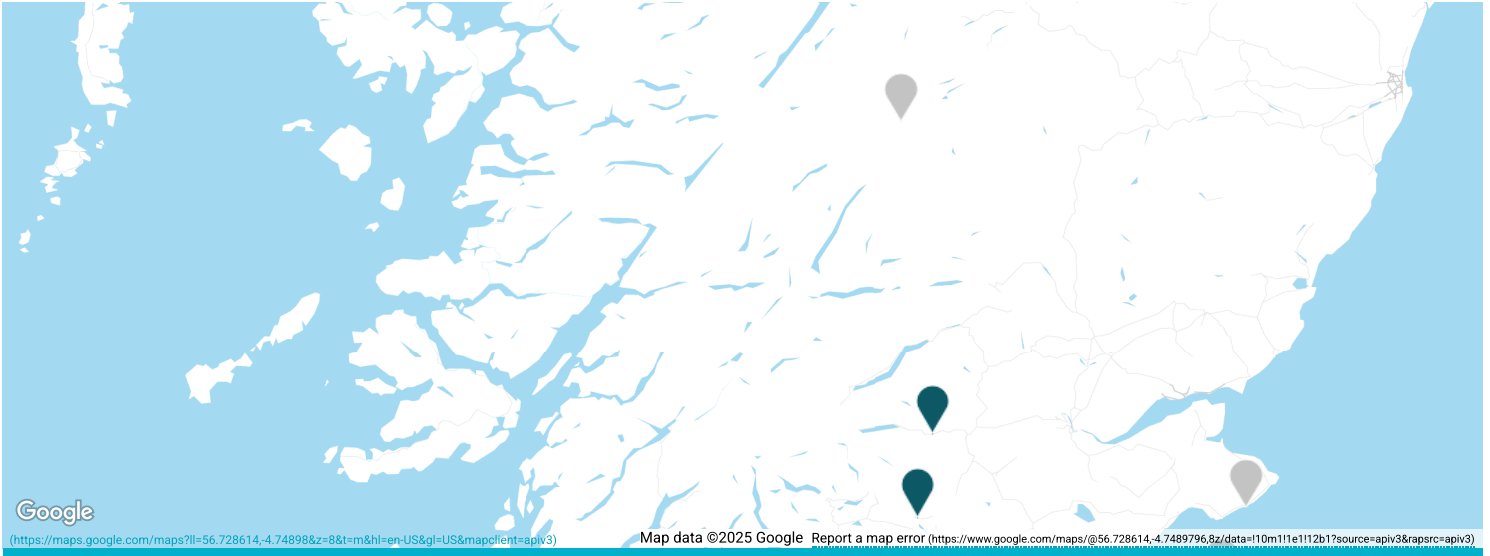




Balloch

Balloch is in Highland. It was a long established rural village near to Culloden. Today it houses the Scottish School of Forestry.

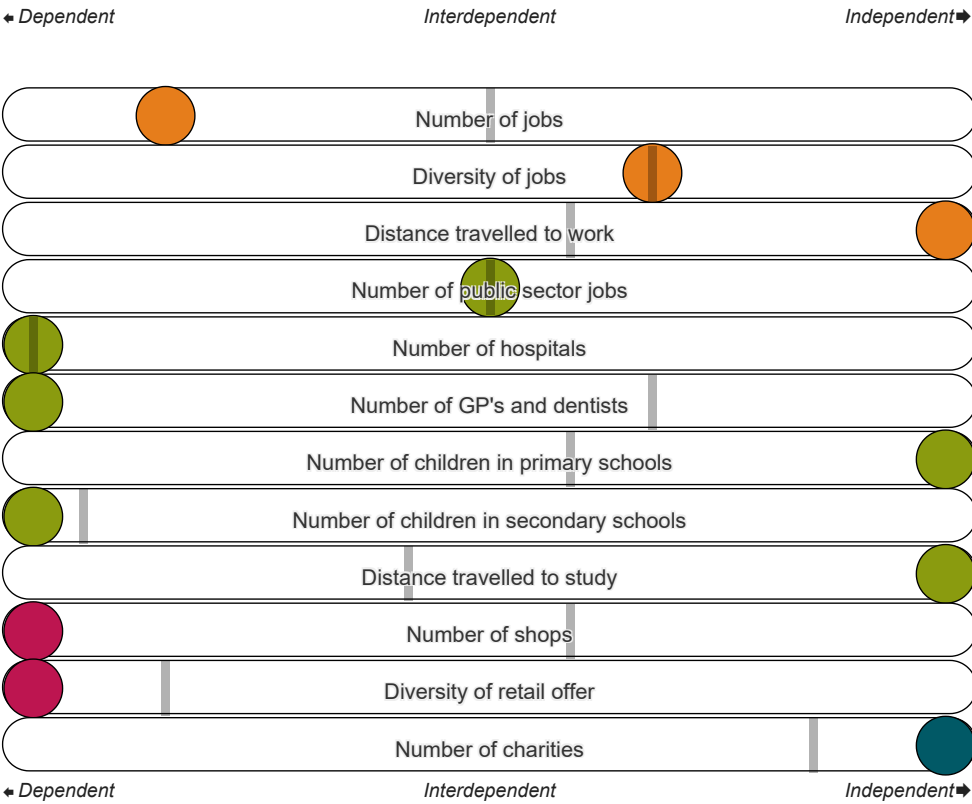
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Balloch is an interdependent town.

Balloch is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Balloch is grouped with 8 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Balloch differs most from its group in the number of shops, and GP's and dentists.

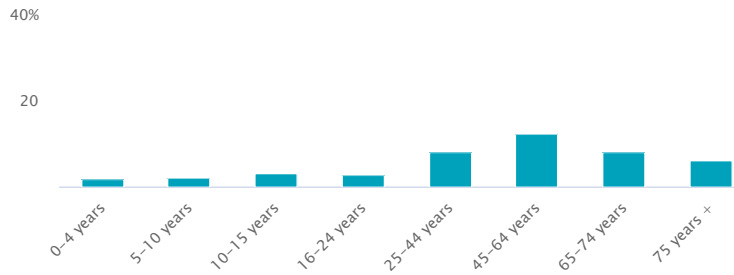

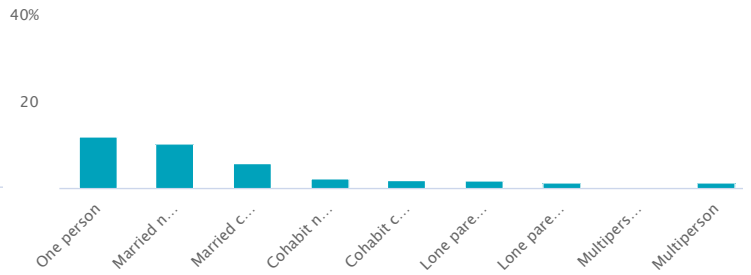

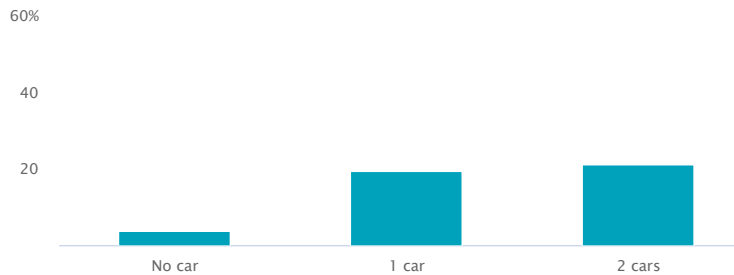

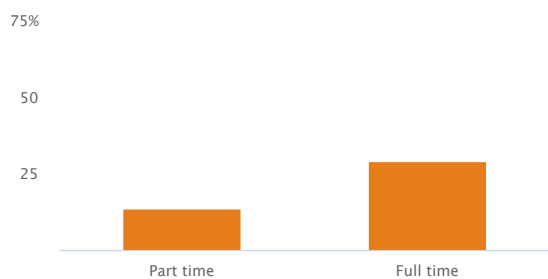

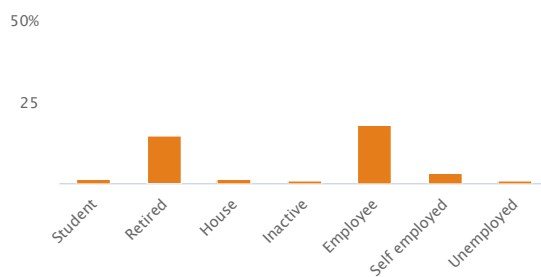
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



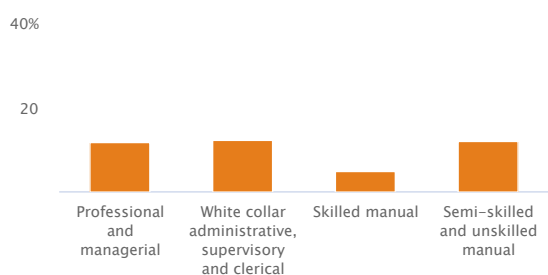
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

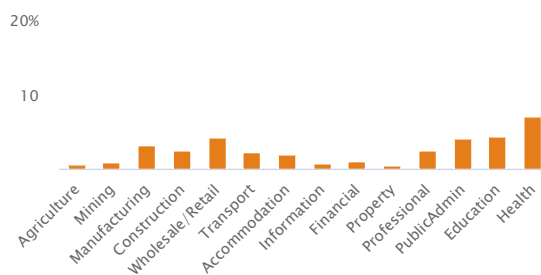


Social Grade

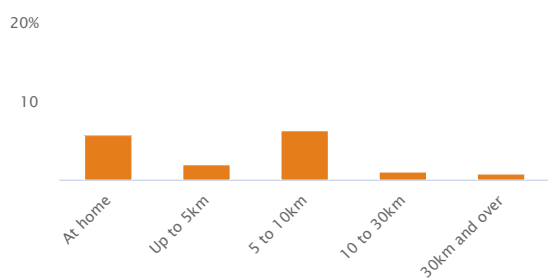
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

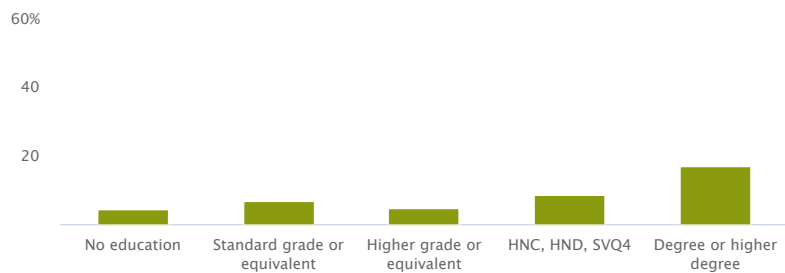


Distance travelled to work

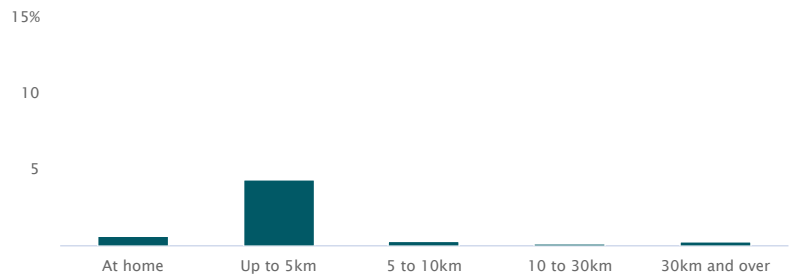
