Balmullo in Fife was a weaving town but today it is a commuter settlement. Quarrying takes place at the adjacent Lucklaw quarry (red path chippings and chips for harling) and at the nearby sand and gravel pits.

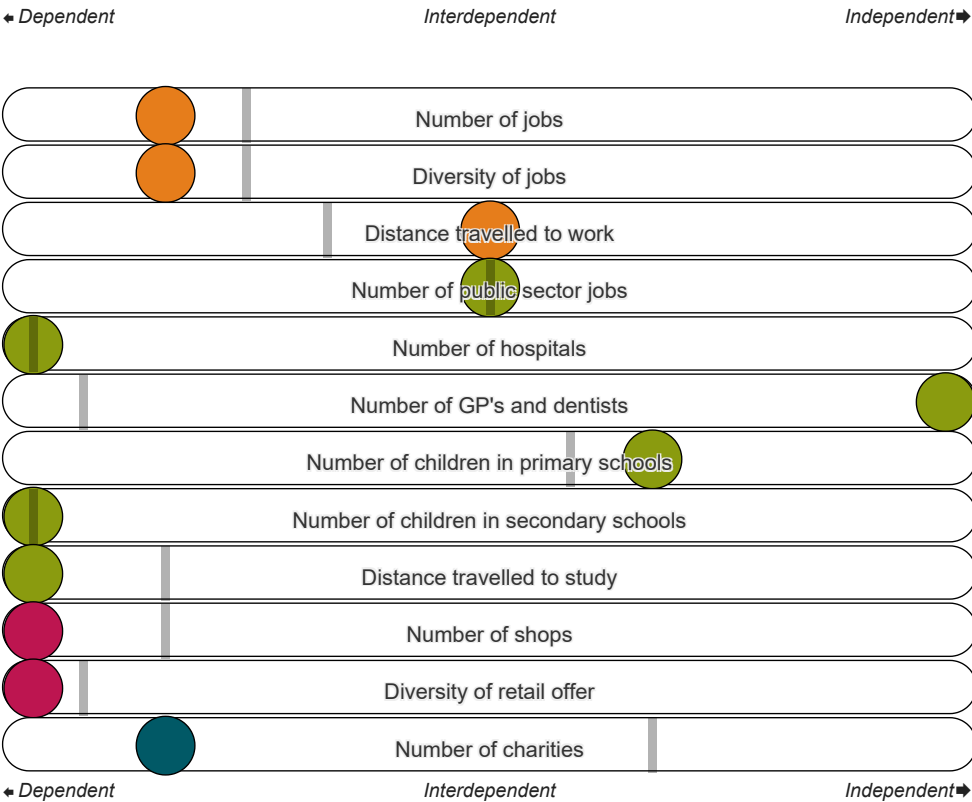
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Balmullo is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aberlady](#), [Bankfoot](#), [Cairneyhill](#), and [Crail](#).

# Inter-relationships



Balmullo is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Balmullo is grouped with 19 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of GP's and dentists. Balmullo differs most from its group in the number of charities.

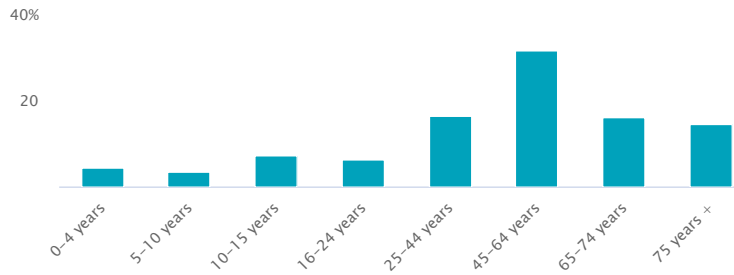

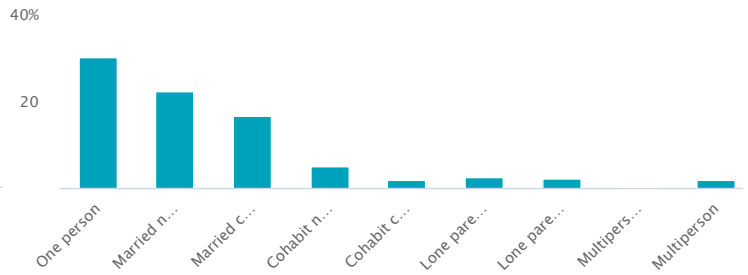

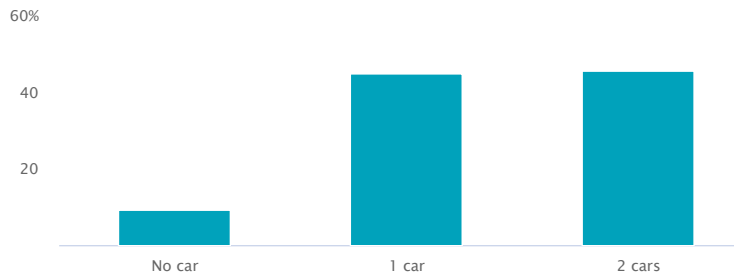

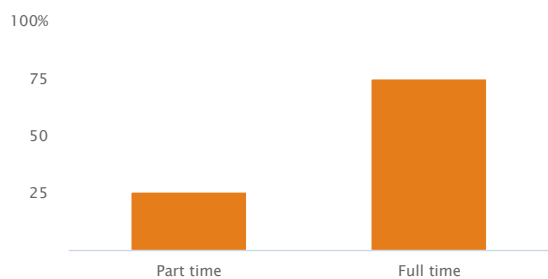

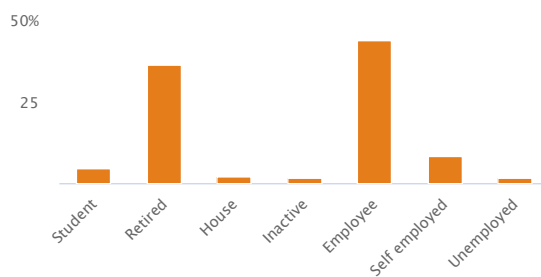
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



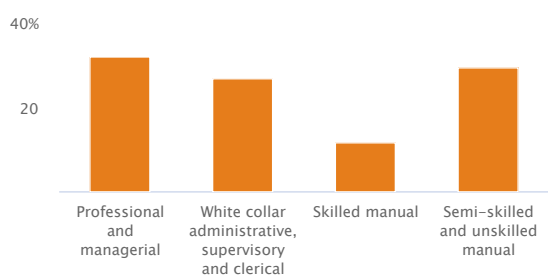
## Occupation

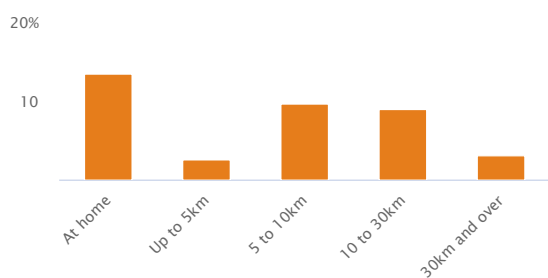

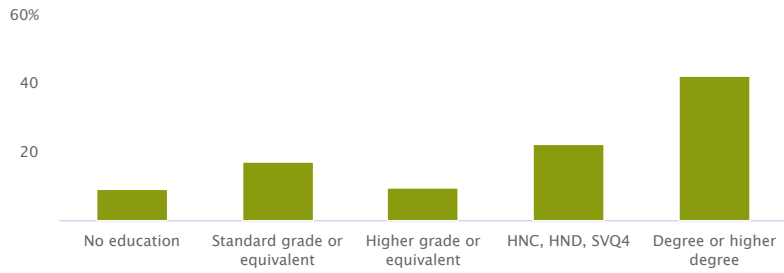

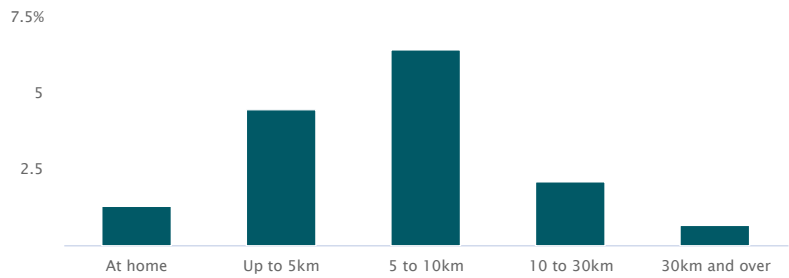
