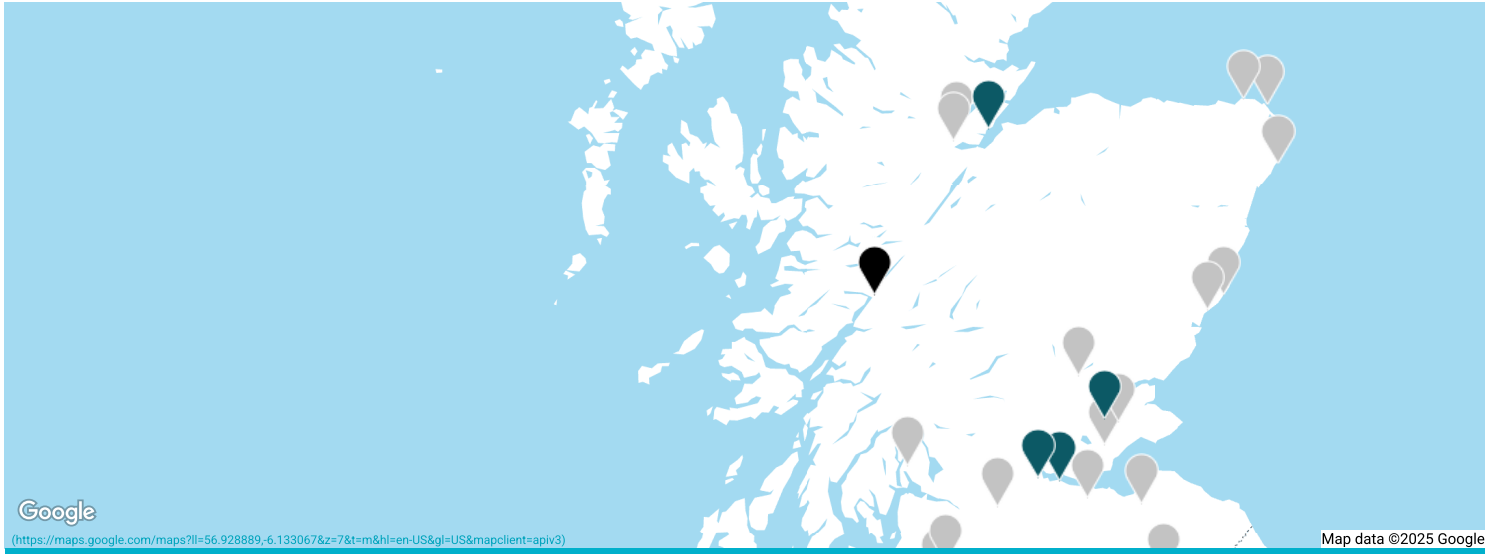




Banavie and Corpach

Banavie and Corpach in Highland are located at the western end of the Caledonian Canal. Corpach was the site of a major pulp mill development. Although the pulp and paper mill are now closed the site is now used for timber operations.

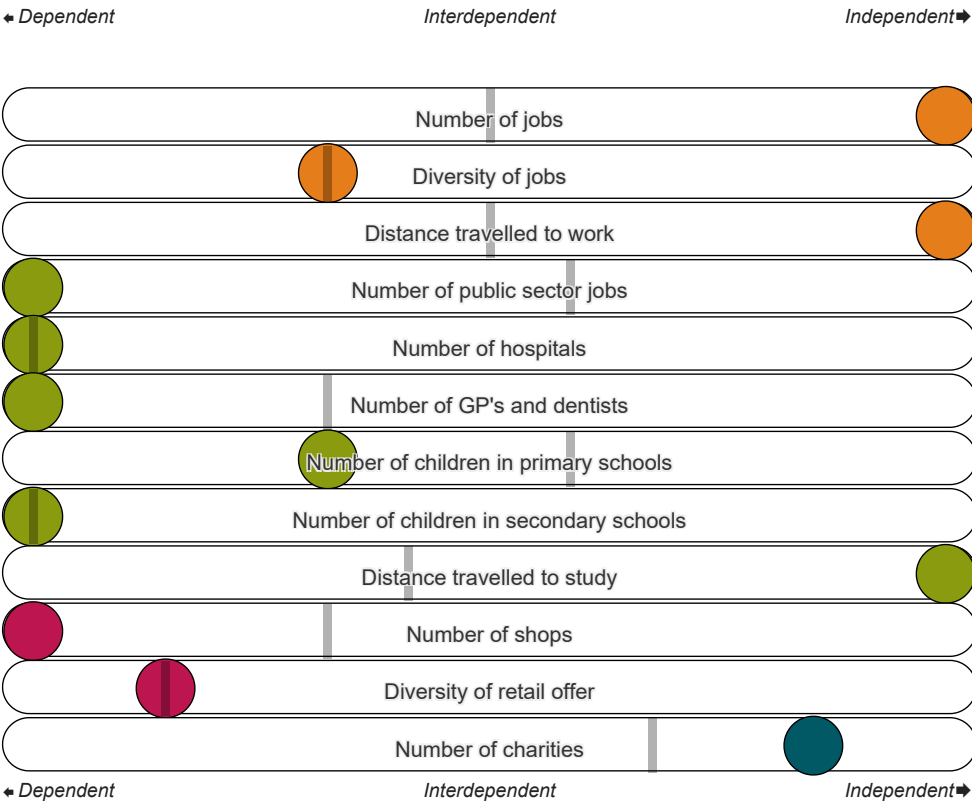
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Banavie and Corpach is an interdependent to dependent town.

Banavie and Corpach is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Banavie and Corpach is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Banavie and Corpach differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists.

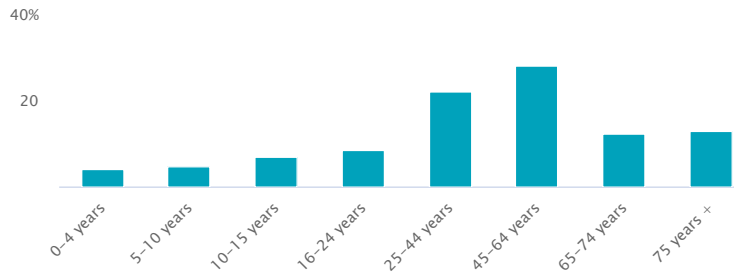

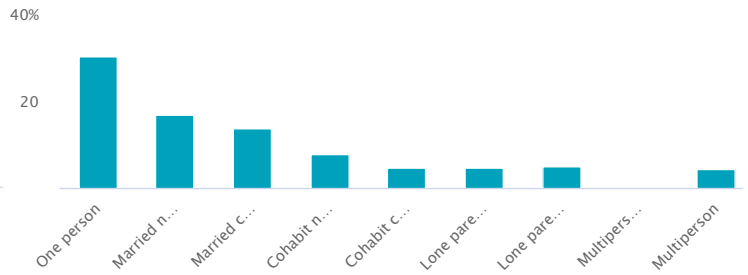

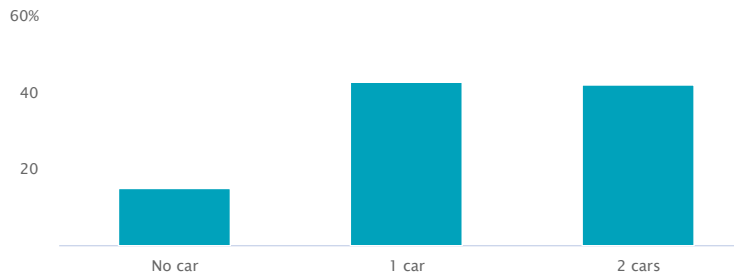

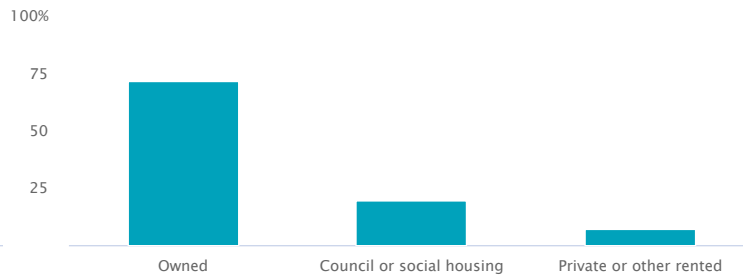

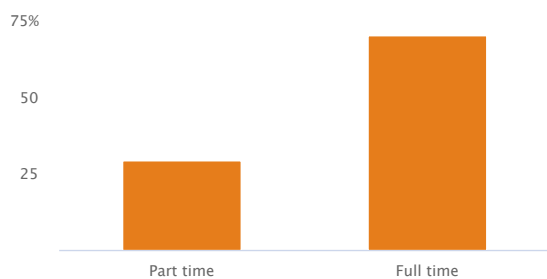

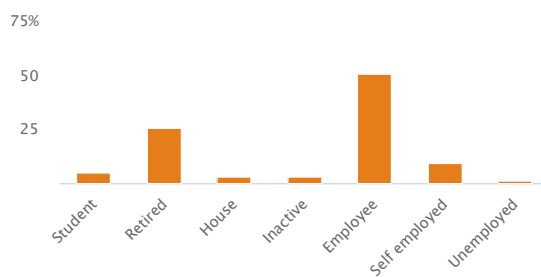
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



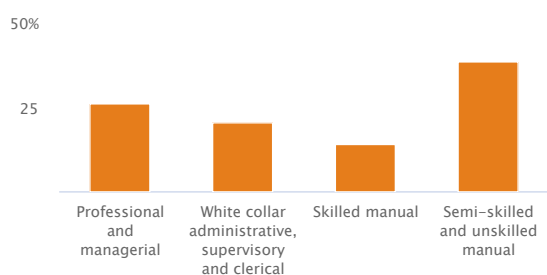
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

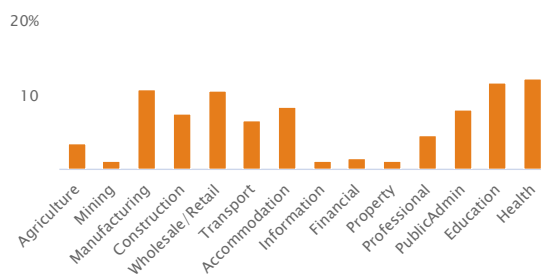


Social Grade

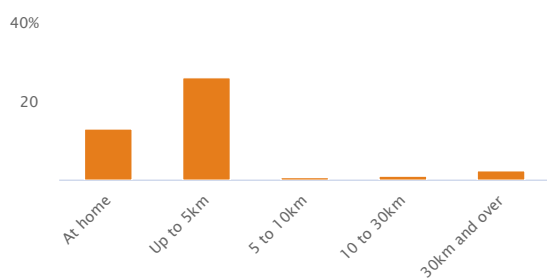
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

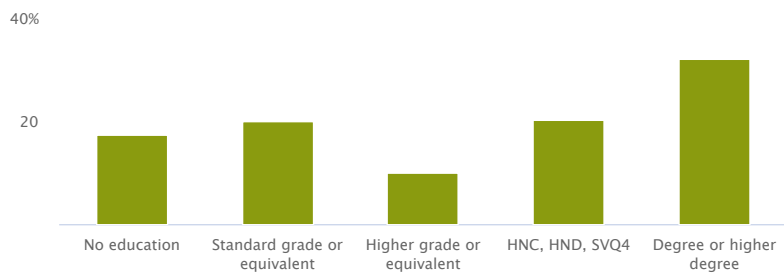


Distance travelled to work

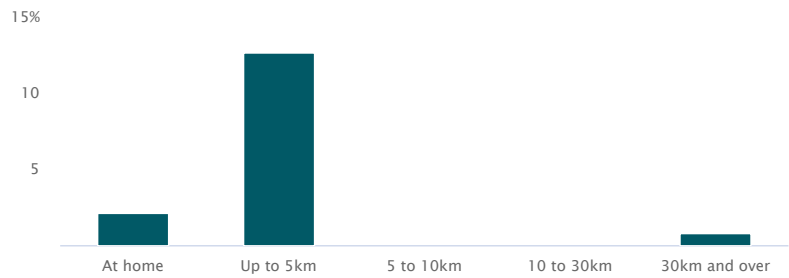
