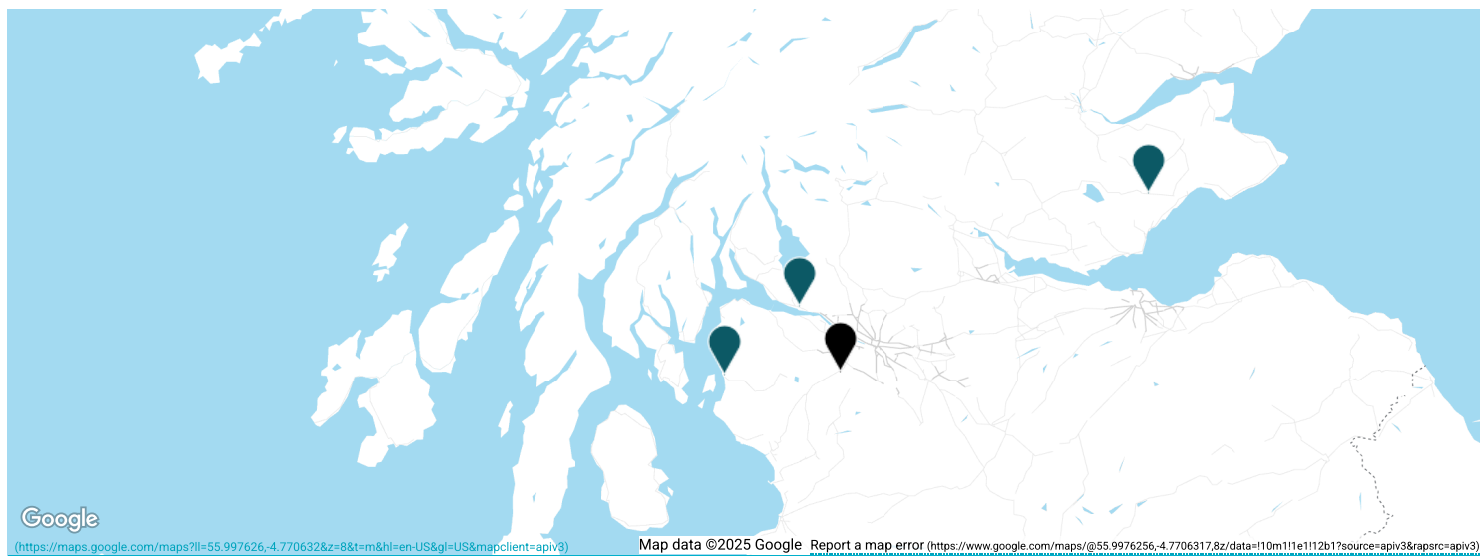




# Barrhead

EAST RENFREWSHIRE

POPULATION **17,586**

Barrhead in East Renfrewshire is a town with an industrial heritage including textile manufacturing, Armitage Shanks porcelain ware, Gaskell's carpet factory and copper mining. Increasingly, as industries have closed, it is becoming a commuter town. It has administrative role in East Renfrewshire. Other industries include brewing and smaller enterprises.

In large towns such as this, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

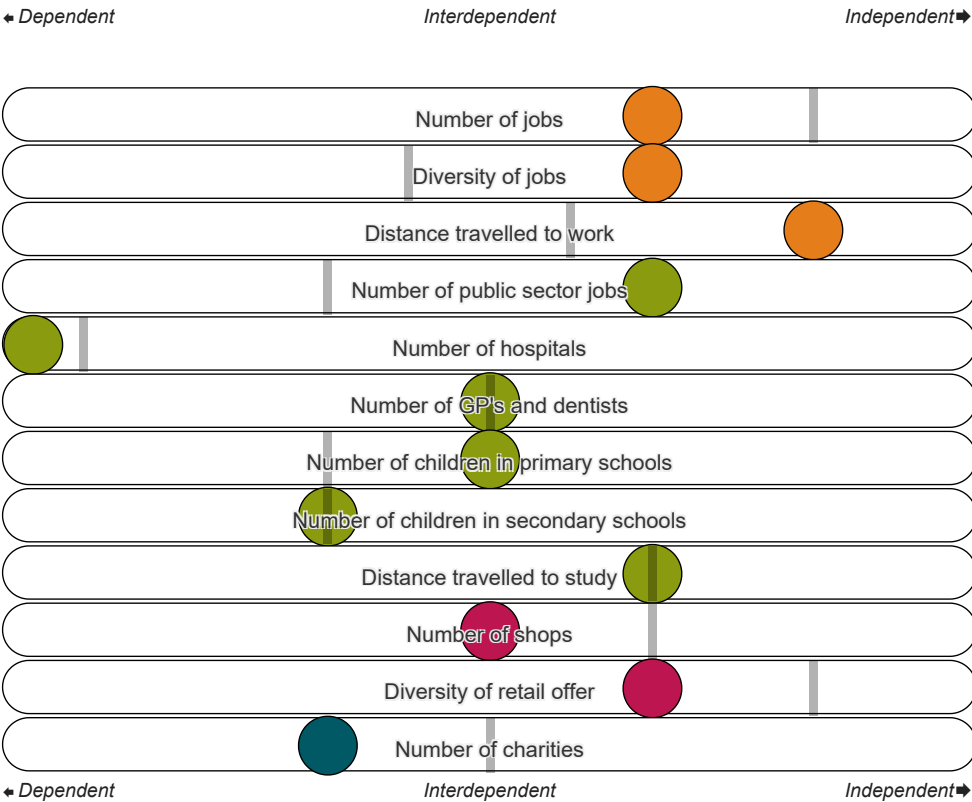
Barrhead is an interdependent town.

# Inter-relationships



Barrhead is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Barrhead is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the distance travelled to work. Barrhead differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

**Population change 2011 to 2022****1%**

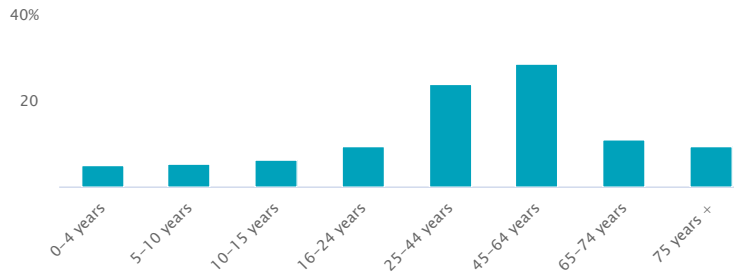

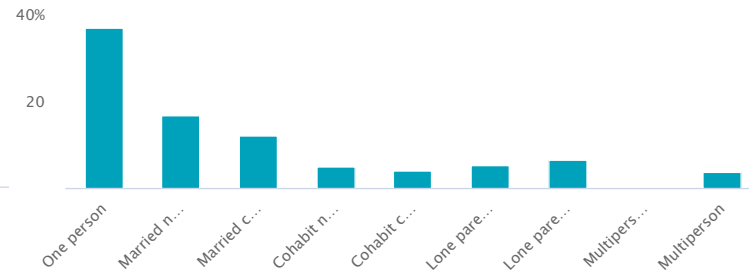

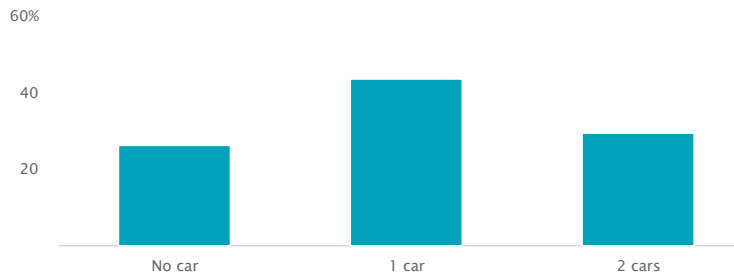

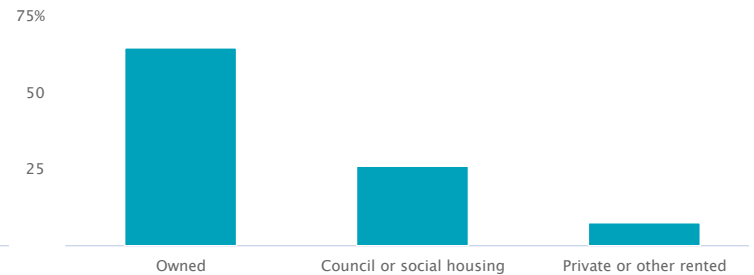

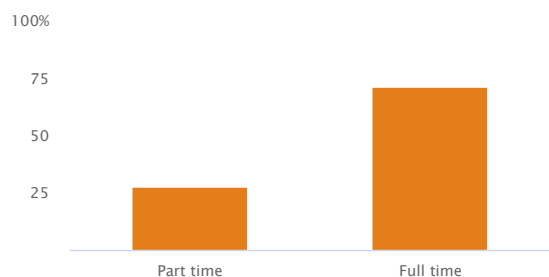

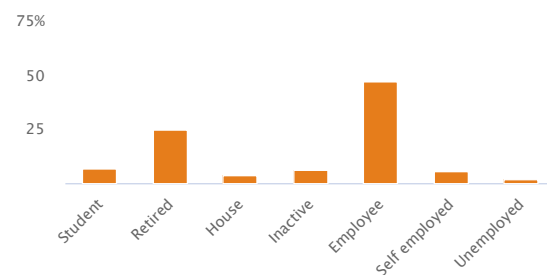
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



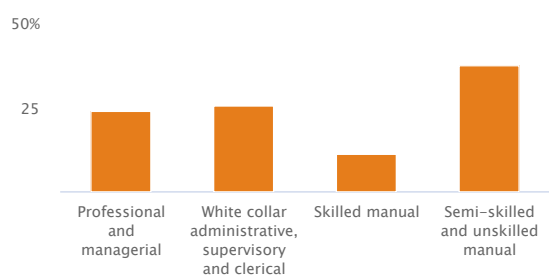
## Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

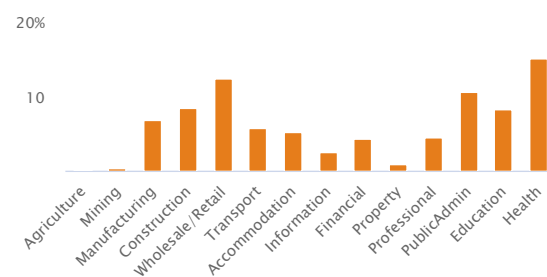

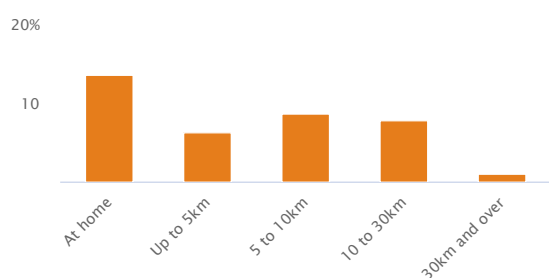
(% households aged 16-64)

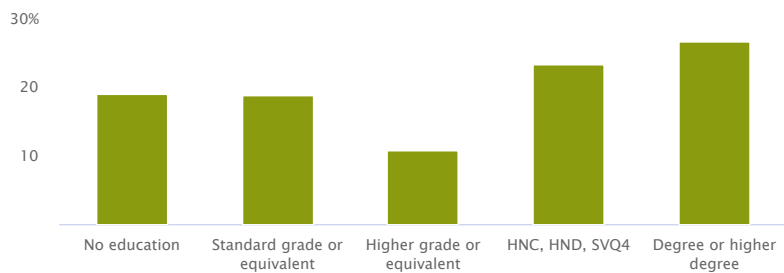

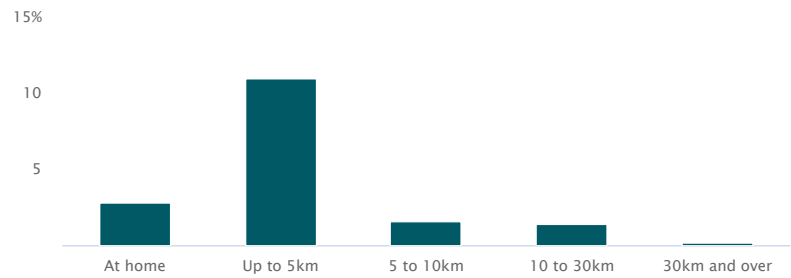
