





POPULATION 19,500

Bellshill in North Lanarkshire is an industrial town. Originally a weaving centre this trade declined with the commercialisation of the industry. Minning became important but has since closed. In the 19th century iron and steel were produced. There are still light industries and manufacturing in Bellshill with three industrial estates - Bellshill Industrial Estate, Righead Industrial Estate and Strathclyde Business Park.


In large towns, people in this group experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Bellshill is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Airdrie, Blantyre, Cowdenbeath and Lumphinnans, and Grangemouth.


Household change 2011 to 2022




Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






