Blairhall is in Fife. It was a colliery village established in early 20th century. New affordable public housing has seen the village become a town.

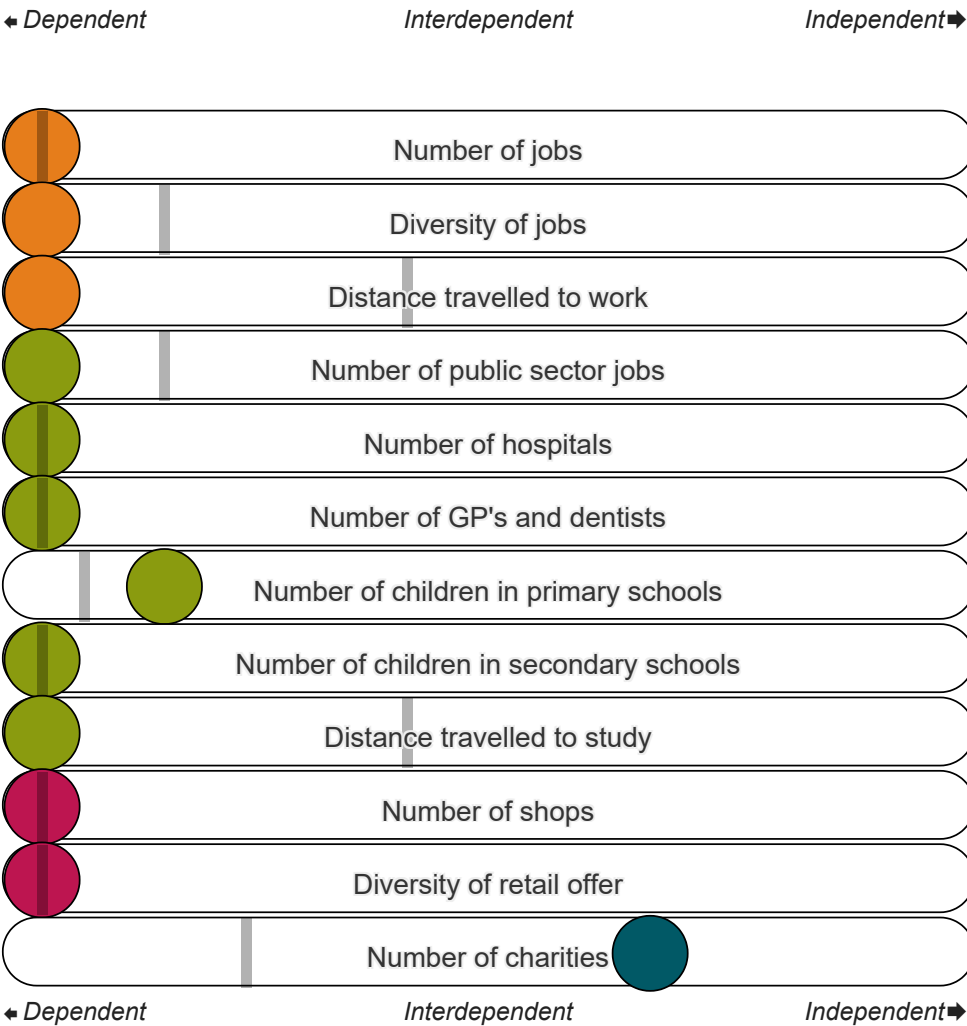
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Blairhall is a **dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Blairhall is grouped with 5 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of charities. Blairhall differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

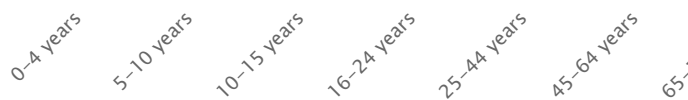

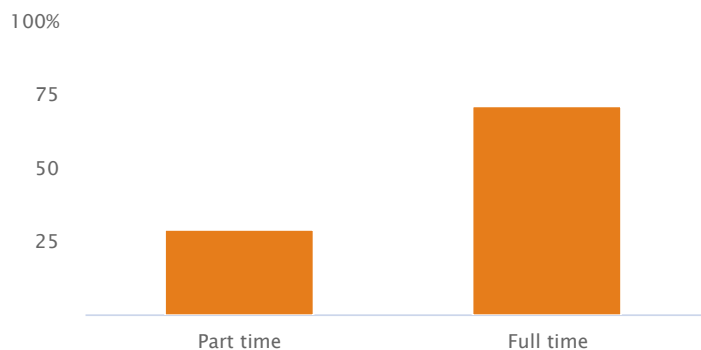

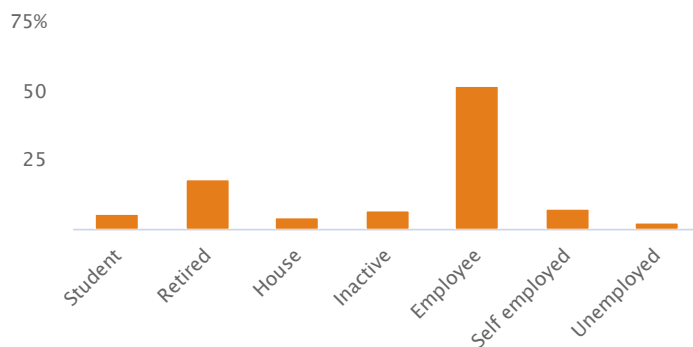
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



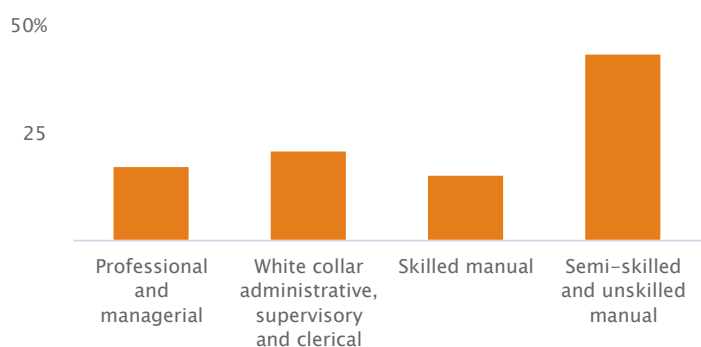
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

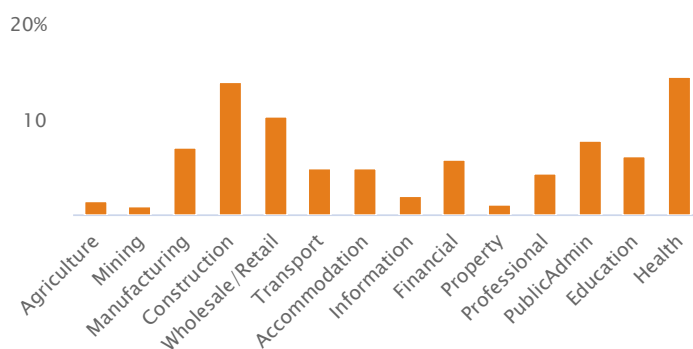

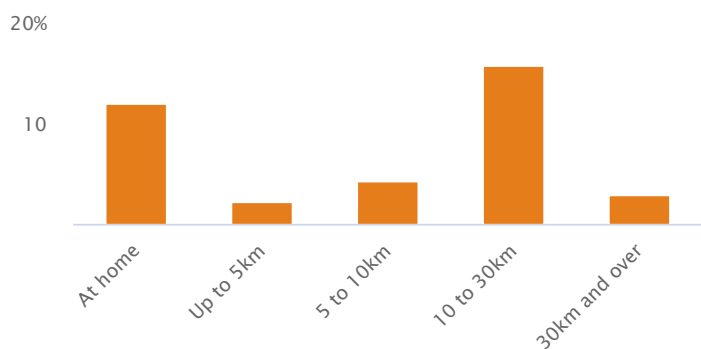
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

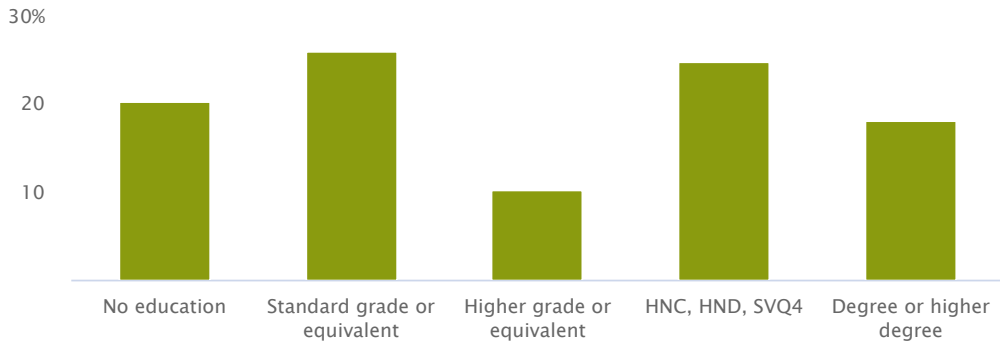


Distance travelled to work

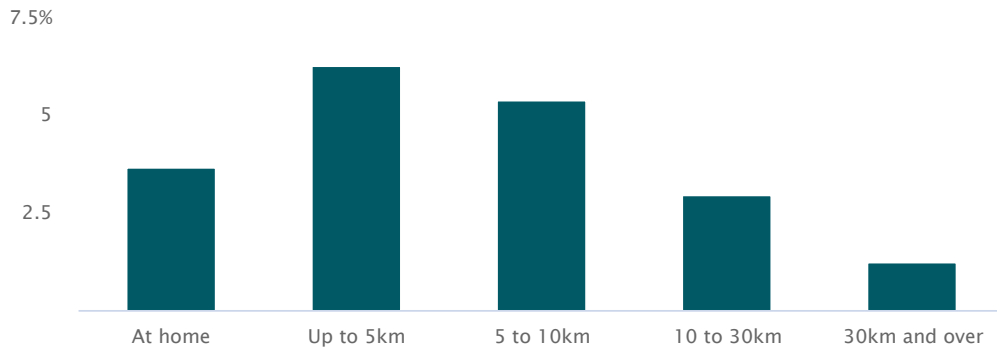
