Blantyre in South Lanarkshire was an early priory. The main development of the town came when houses were built for workers at the cotton mills in the 19th century. Quarry and mining followed. Today there are several industrial parks. One of which houses offices for Scottish Power.


In large towns, people in this group experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Blantyre is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Airdrie, Bellshill, Cowdenbeath and Lumphinnans, and Grangemouth.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






