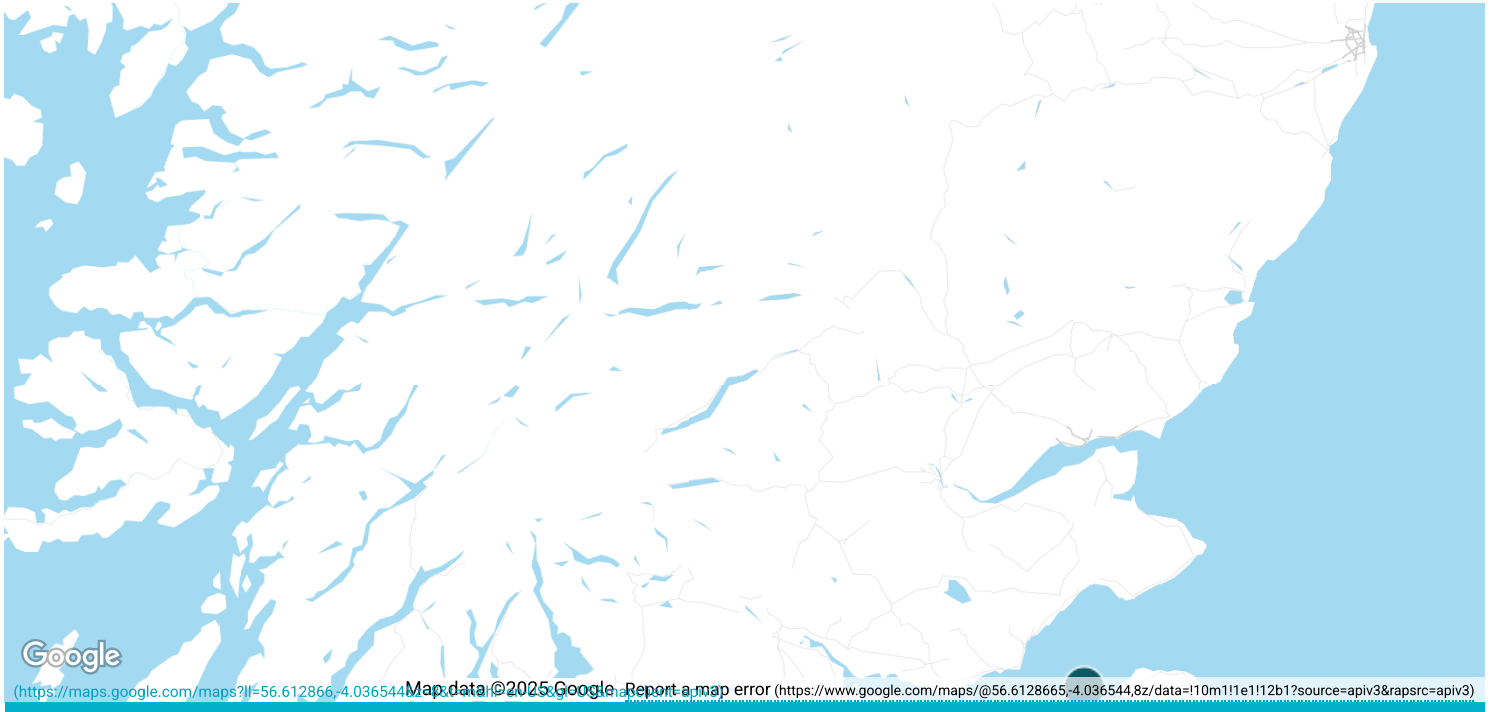




Boddam

Boddam is located in Aberdeenshire on the Buchan coast. It is best known for the granite which was quarried in the area and exported through the port at Boddam. This closed in the 1950s. RAF Buchan also used to operate in the area but likewise has closed. Peterhead power station is also close to Boddam. It was approved for a carbon capture scheme. Small scale lobster fishing is still carried out. Many residents commute to Peterhead or Aberdeen.

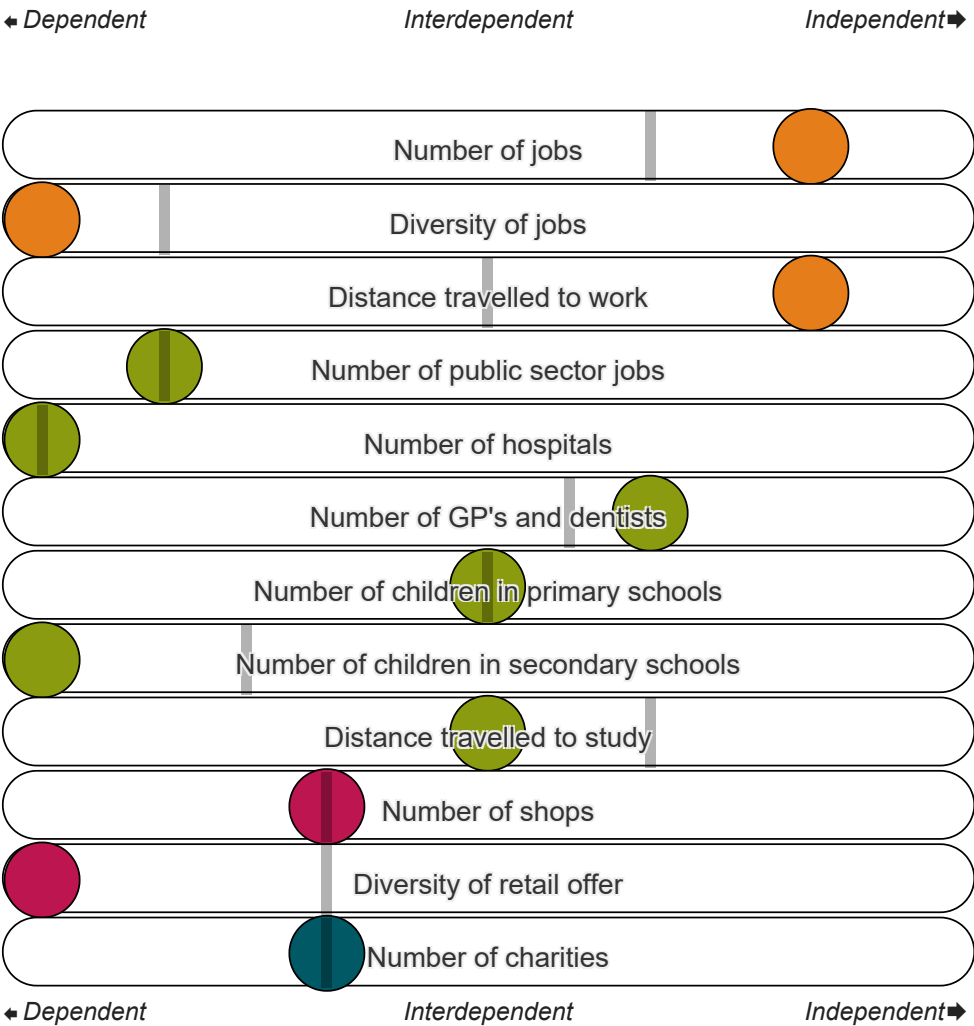
In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Boddam is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Boddam is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the distance travelled to work. Boddam differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools, and diversity of retail offer.

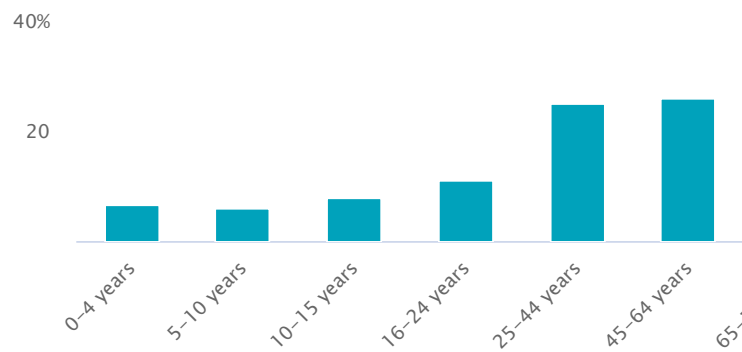

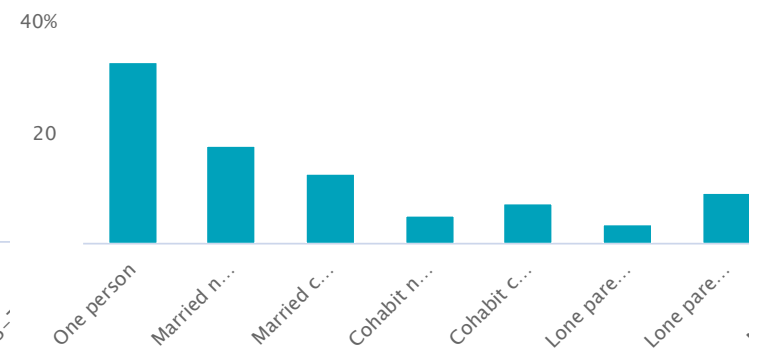

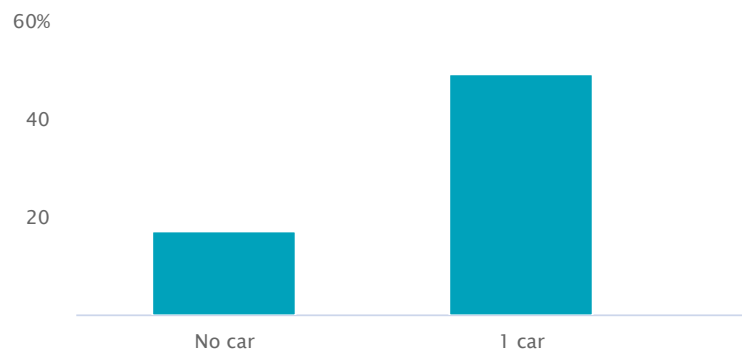

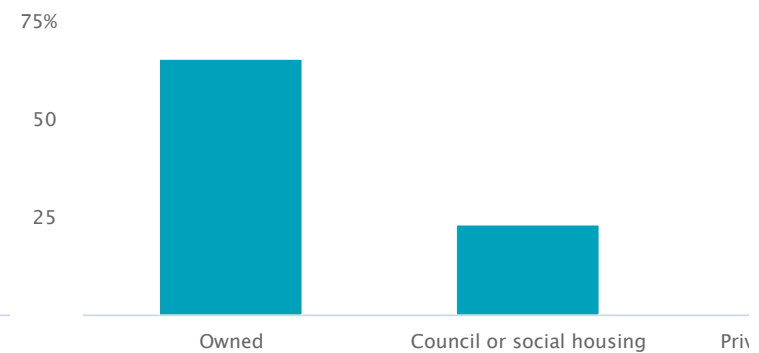
Household composition

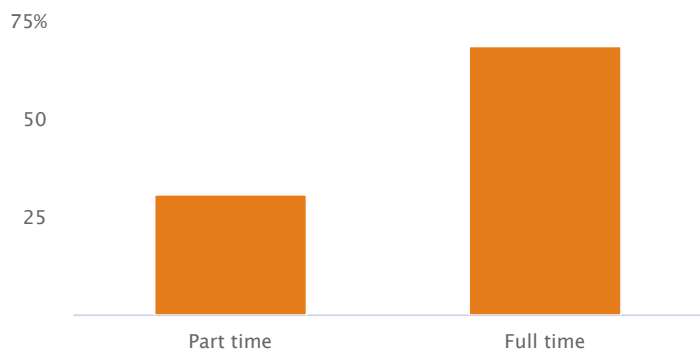

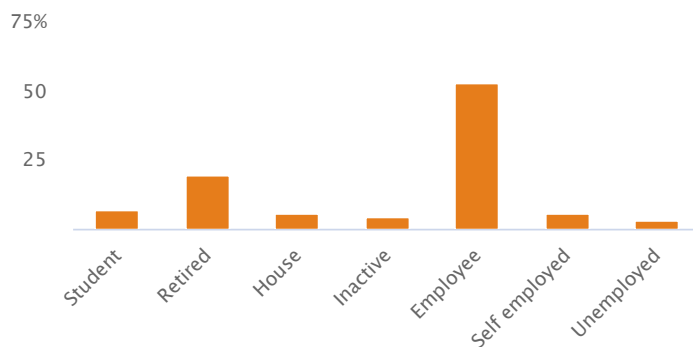
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



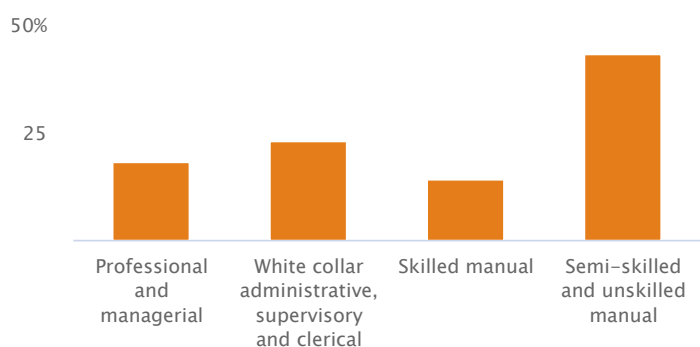
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

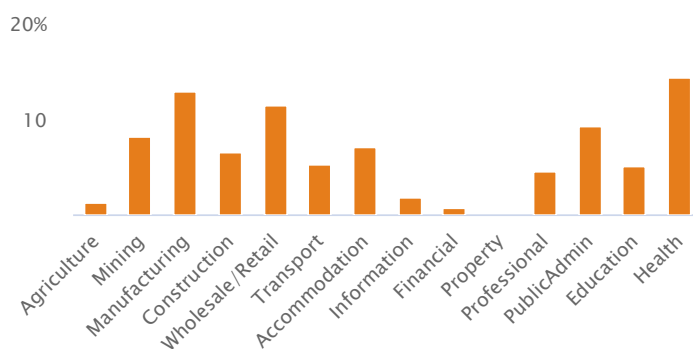


Social Grade

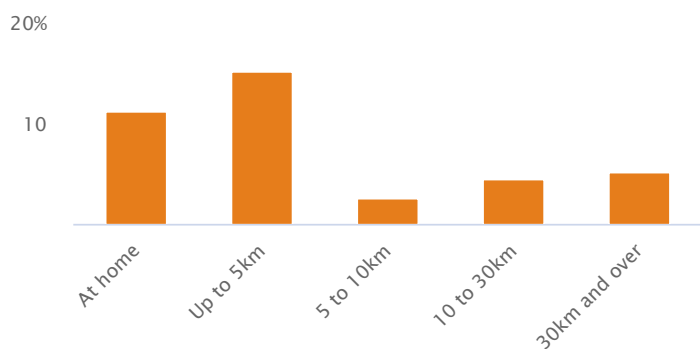
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

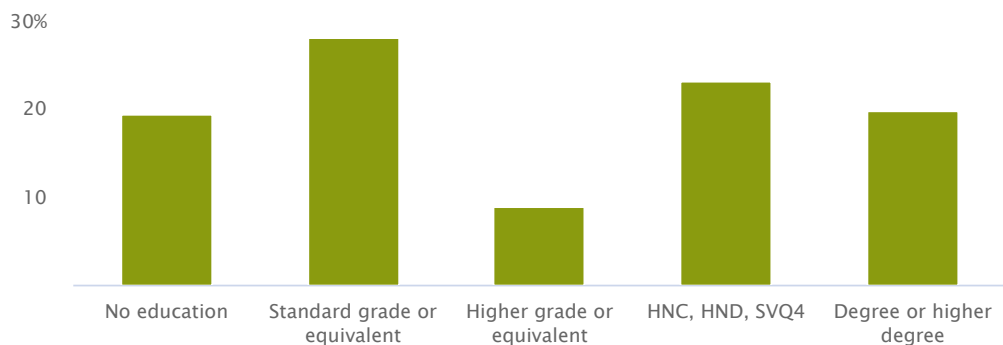


Distance travelled to work

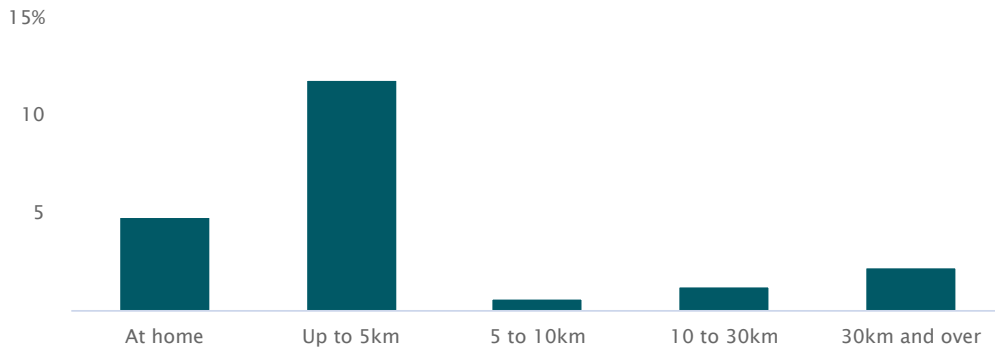
