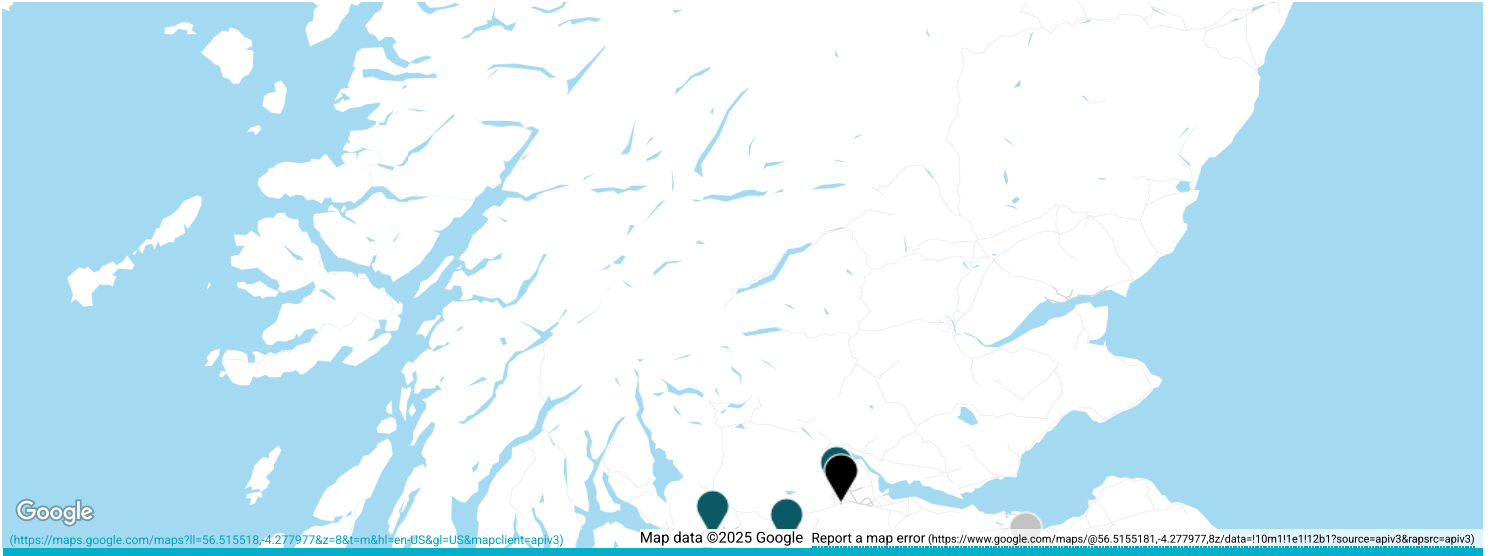




Bonnybridge

Bonnybridge in Falkirk Council was a 19th century industrial town with paper making, saw milling, a foundry and quarrying. Today industries include service activities such as catering supplies and storage and engineering industries such as prop shaft manufacturing,

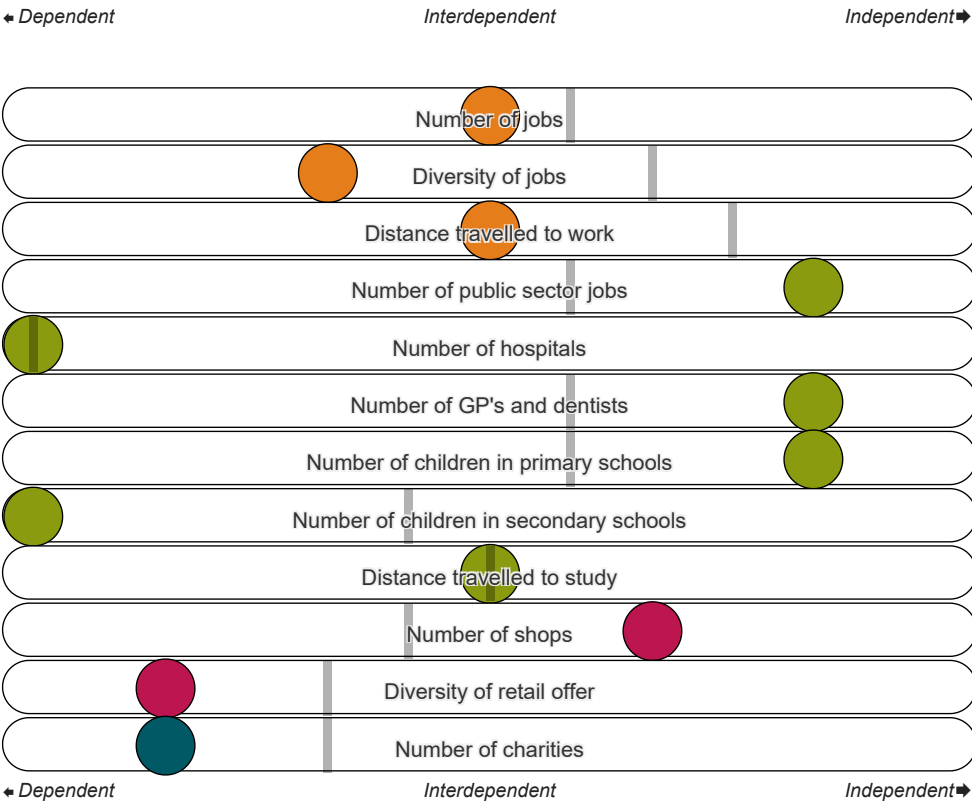
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

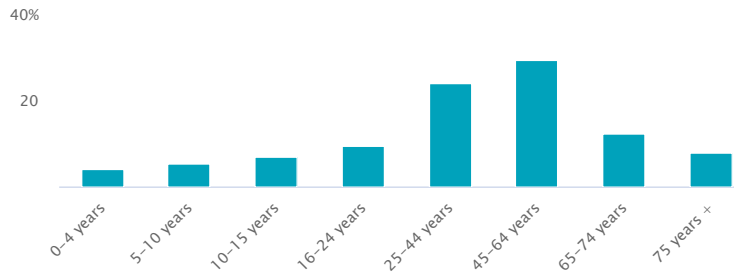

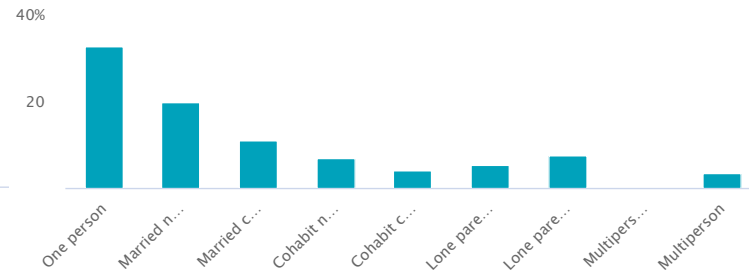

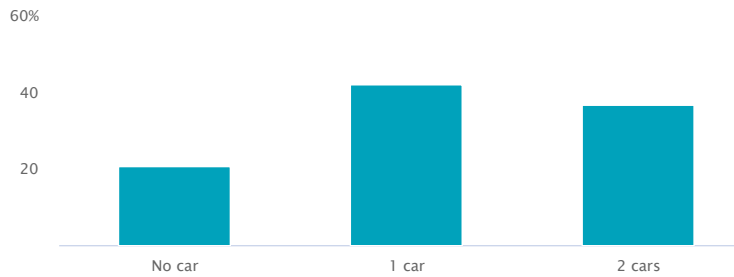

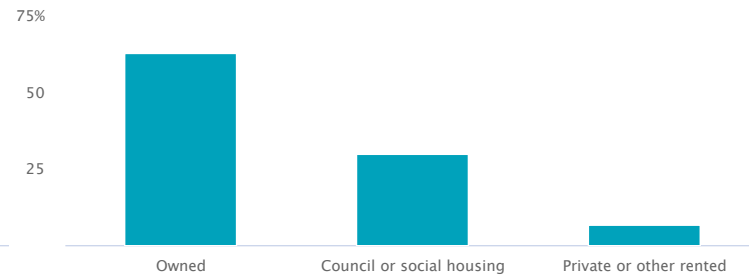

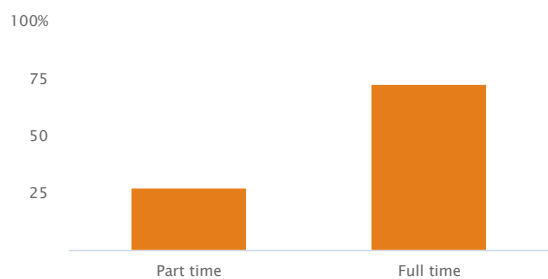

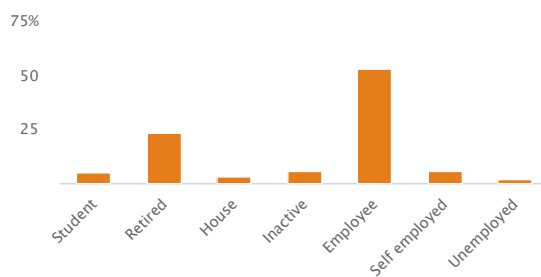
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



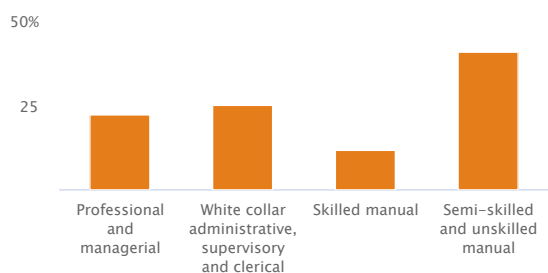
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

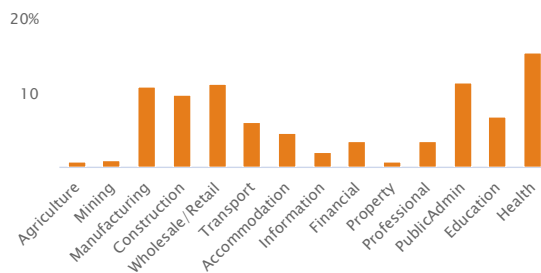

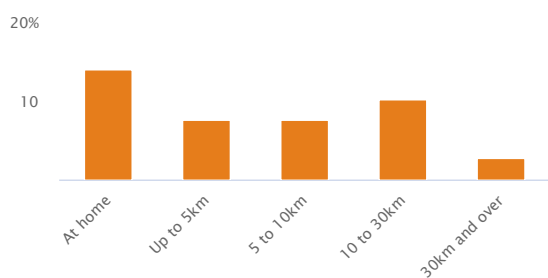
(% households aged 16-64)



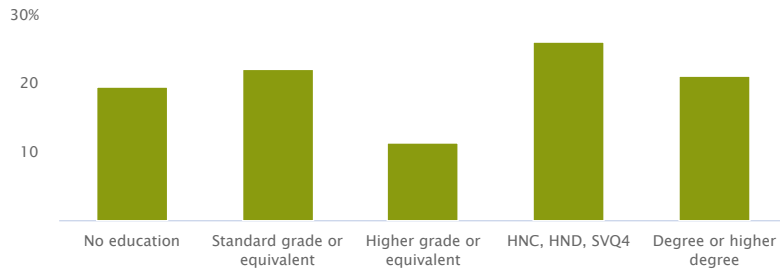
Sector Diversity

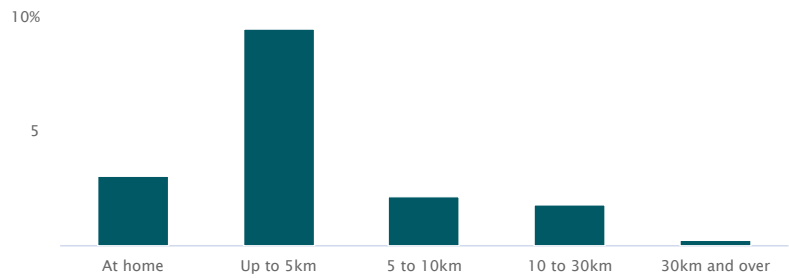
