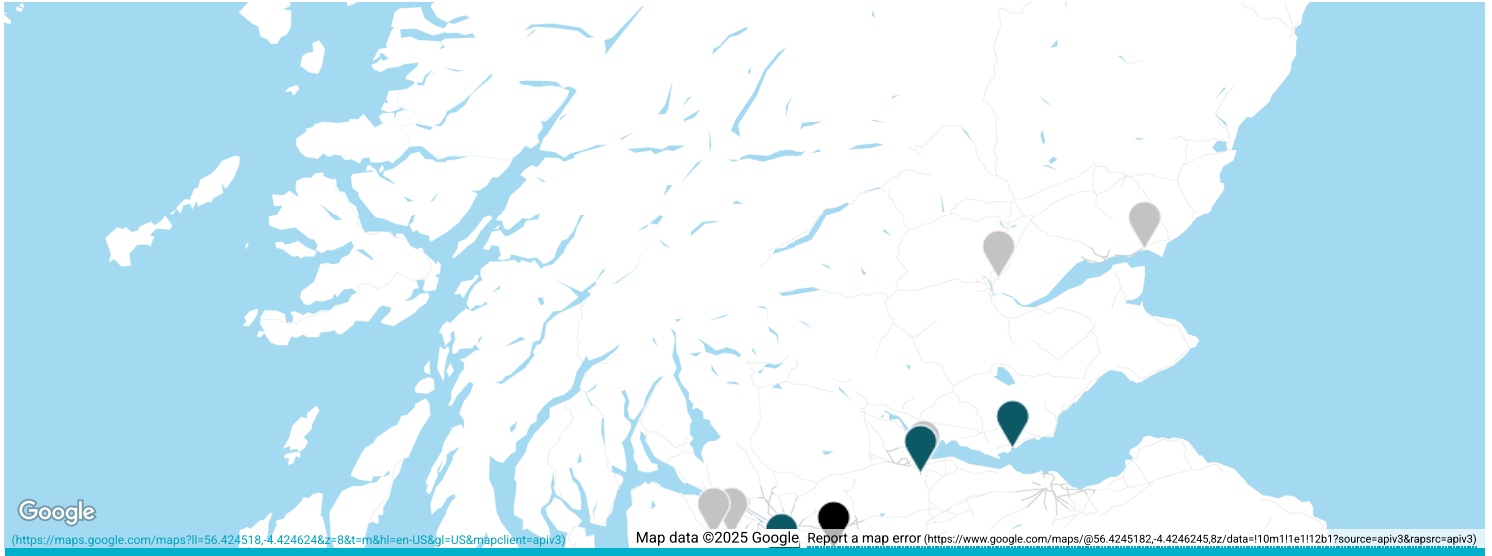




Bothwell

Bothwell in South Lanarkshire one time mining town is now a commuter town and the centre is a conservation area.

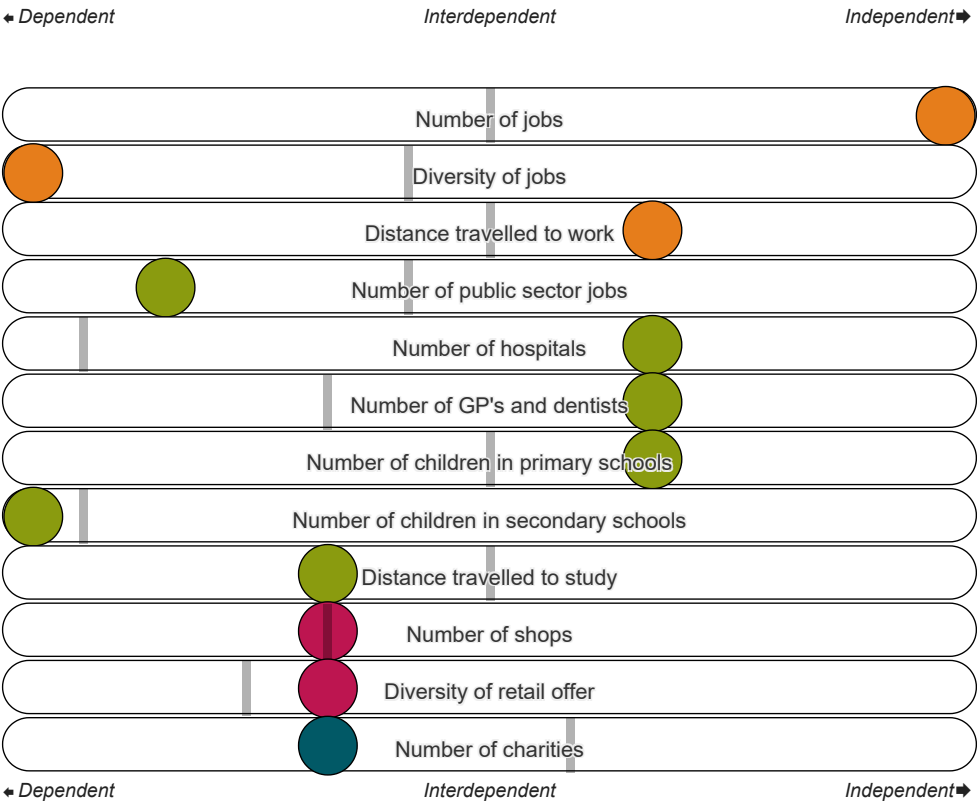
In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Bothwell is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Bothwell is grouped with 10 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals, jobs, and GP's and dentists. Bothwell differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

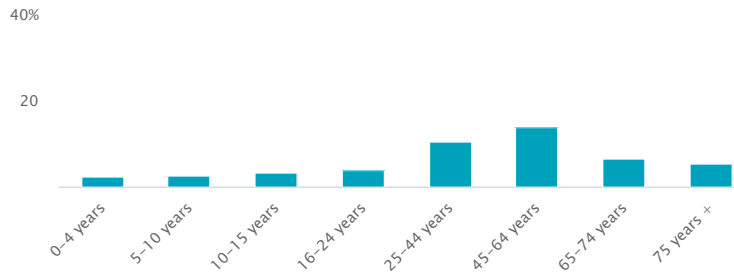

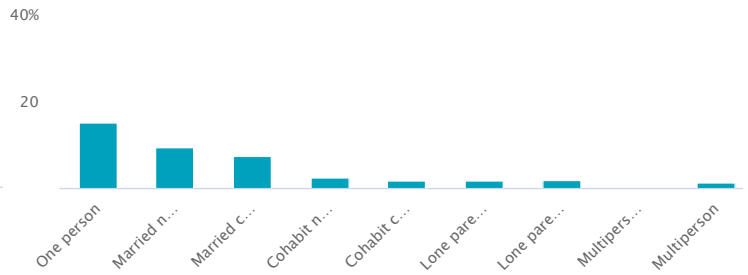

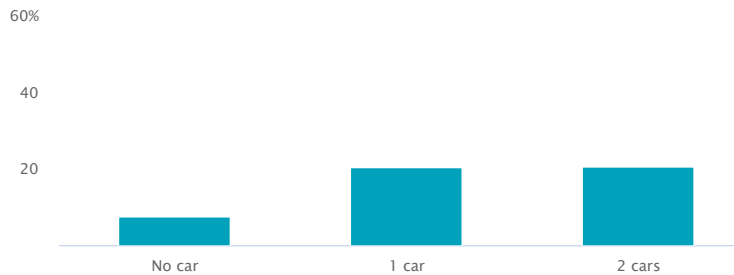

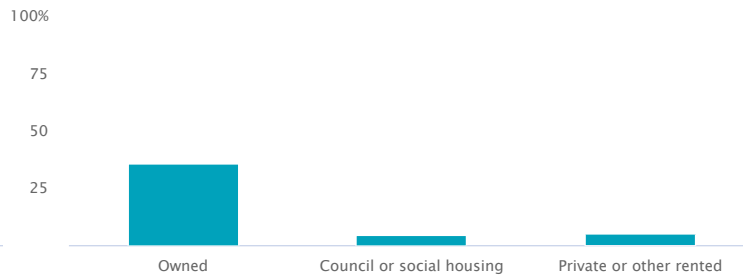

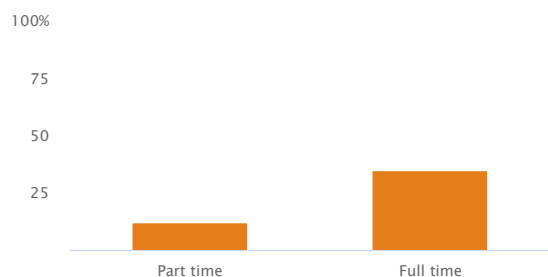

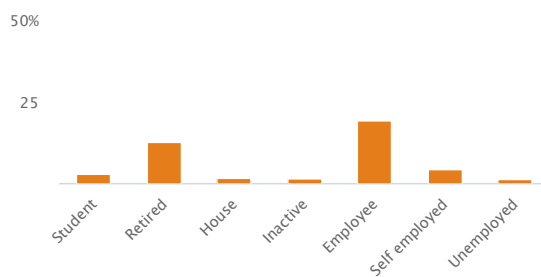
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



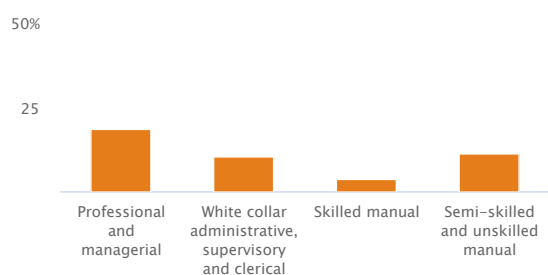
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

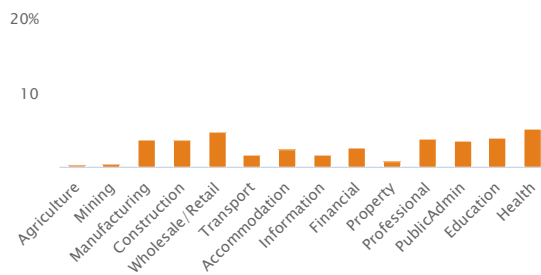

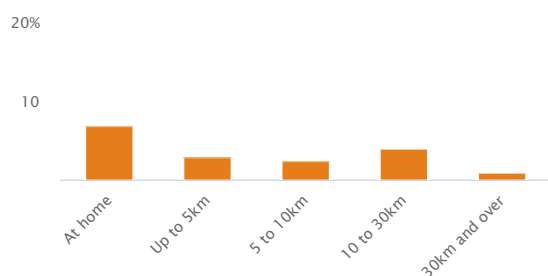
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

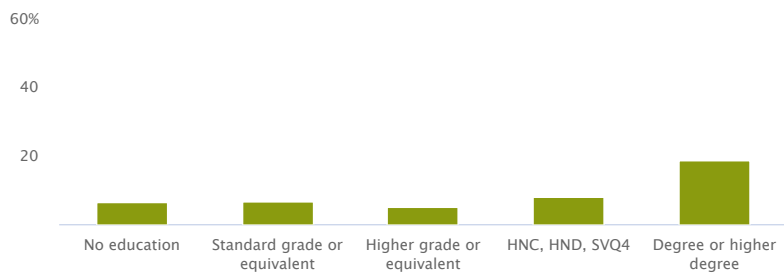


Distance travelled to work

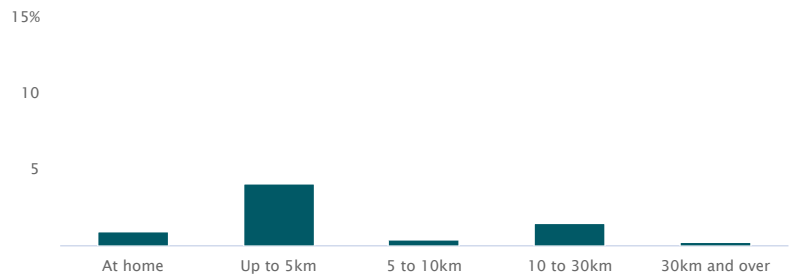
