





Bowling and Old Kilpatrick

WEST DUNBARTONSHIRE

POPULATION 4,763

Bowling and Old Kilpatrick is in West Dunbartonshire. Originally a Roman Fort at the end of the Antonine Wall it would be later ocated on the Forth and Clyde Canal and be at the end of the Erskine Bridge. In the 18th century it was sustained by spinning and weaving. In the early 1990s it saw further expansion with new housing. The town is highly accessible by train to Glasgow and Clydebank as well as to Renfrewshire.


In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Its most similar towns are Mid Calder, and West Kilbride.










Social Grade


(% households aged 16-64)




Sector Diversity




