Brightons in Falkirk Council developed as a quarrying town. Sandstone was produced. Its very accessible location has given it a new role as a commuter town


In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






