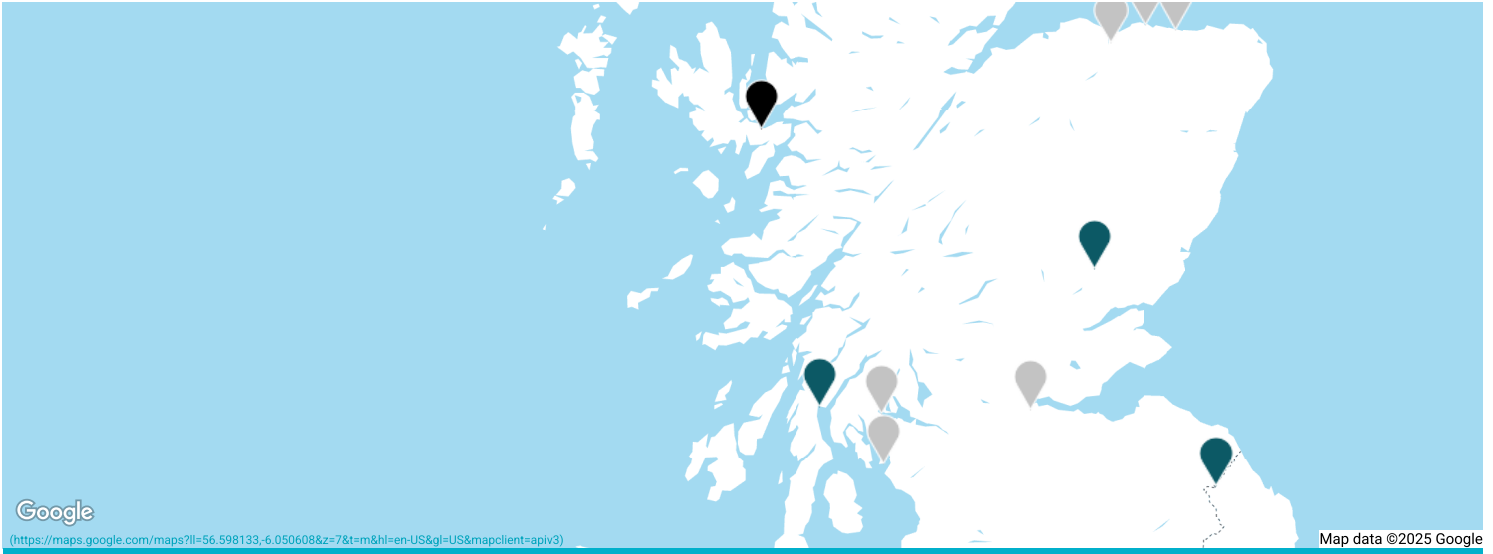




Broadford

Broadford is in Highland. It is the first town after the Skye Bridge. Previously a scattered township there has been investment in new housing on a priority purchase scheme. It is a service and tourist town. It is the location of the hospital for Skye.

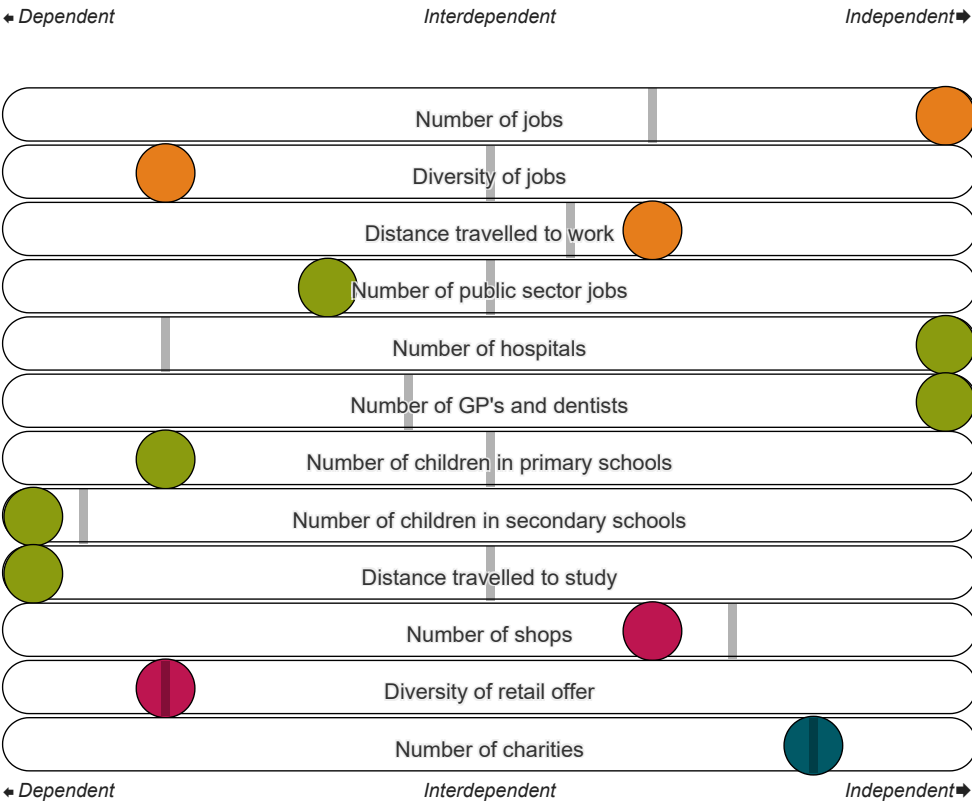
In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Broadford is an interdependent town.

Broadford is an **interdependent** town.

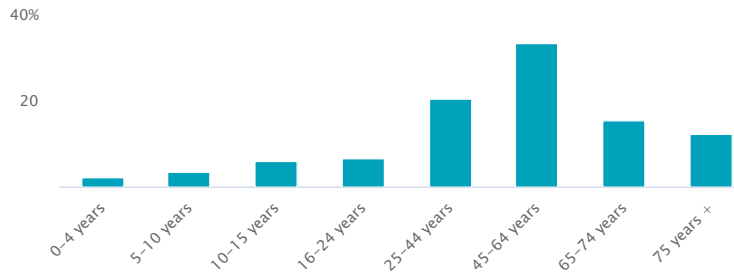
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Broadford is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to work.

It differs in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, jobs, and GP's and dentists. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Broadford differs most from its group in the distance travelled to study.

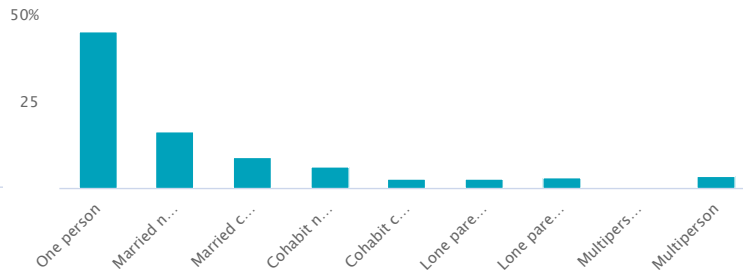

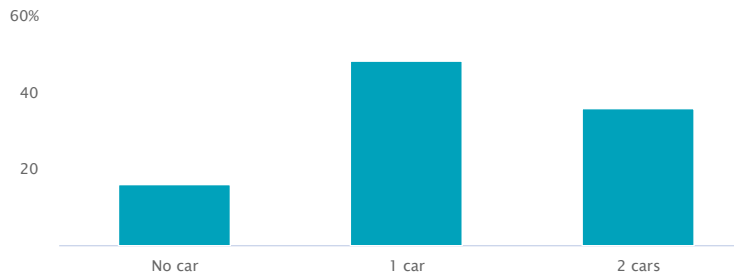
Age



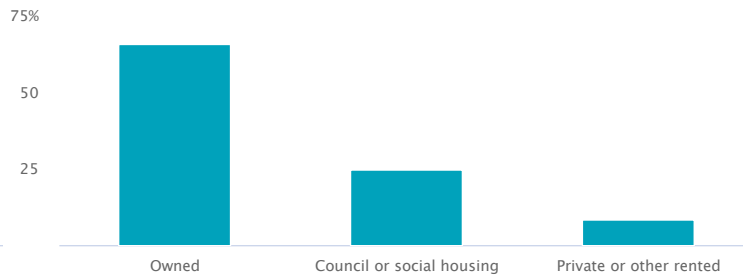
Household composition

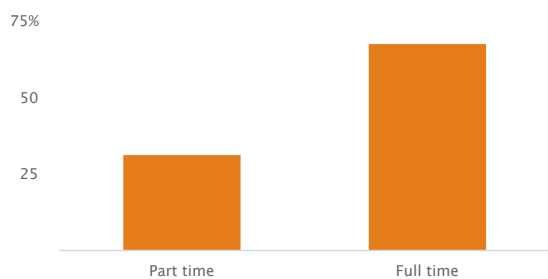

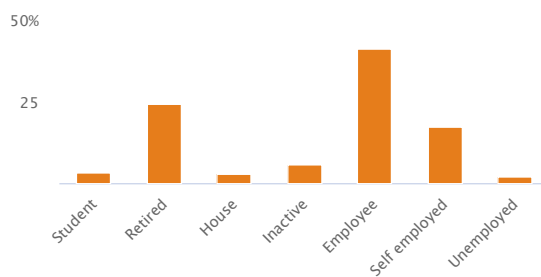
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



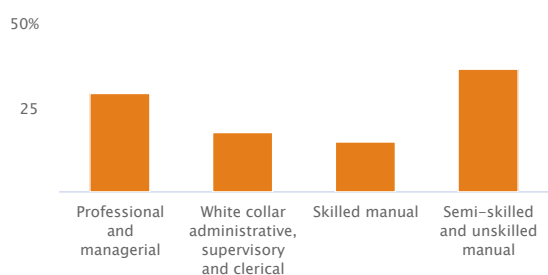
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

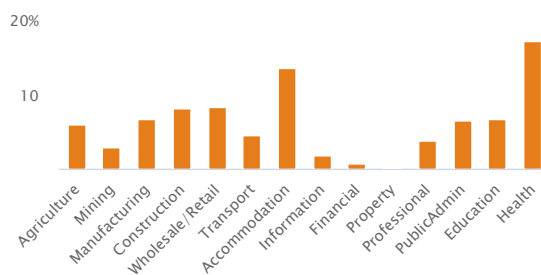

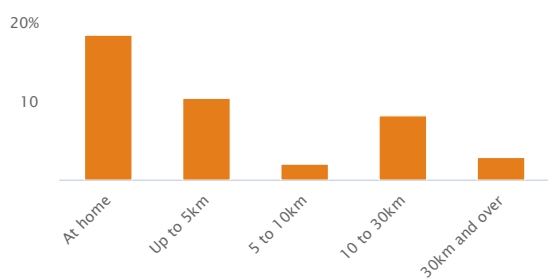
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

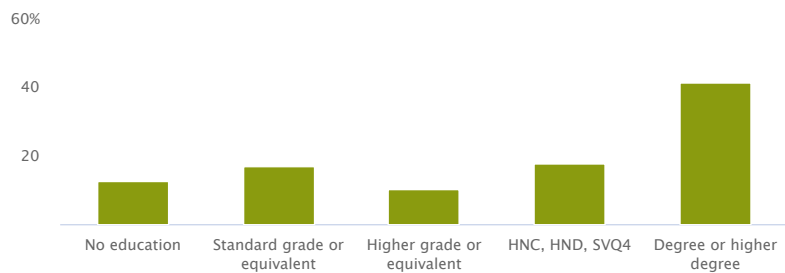


Distance travelled to work

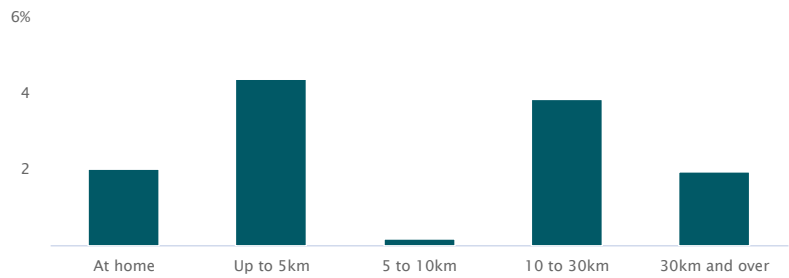
