Brora in Highland was a comparatively industrial place in historic times with coal mining, salt panning and brick making. In the 20th century the woollen trade was important (Hunters of Brora). It is now a local service centre.


In small towns like this one, and similar, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Brora is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Alyth, Ardrishaig, Broadford, and Coldstream.

Brora is an interdependent town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Brora is grouped with 11 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of GP's and dentists.It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Brora differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.


Household change 2011 to 2022




Employment type

(% households aged 16-64)










