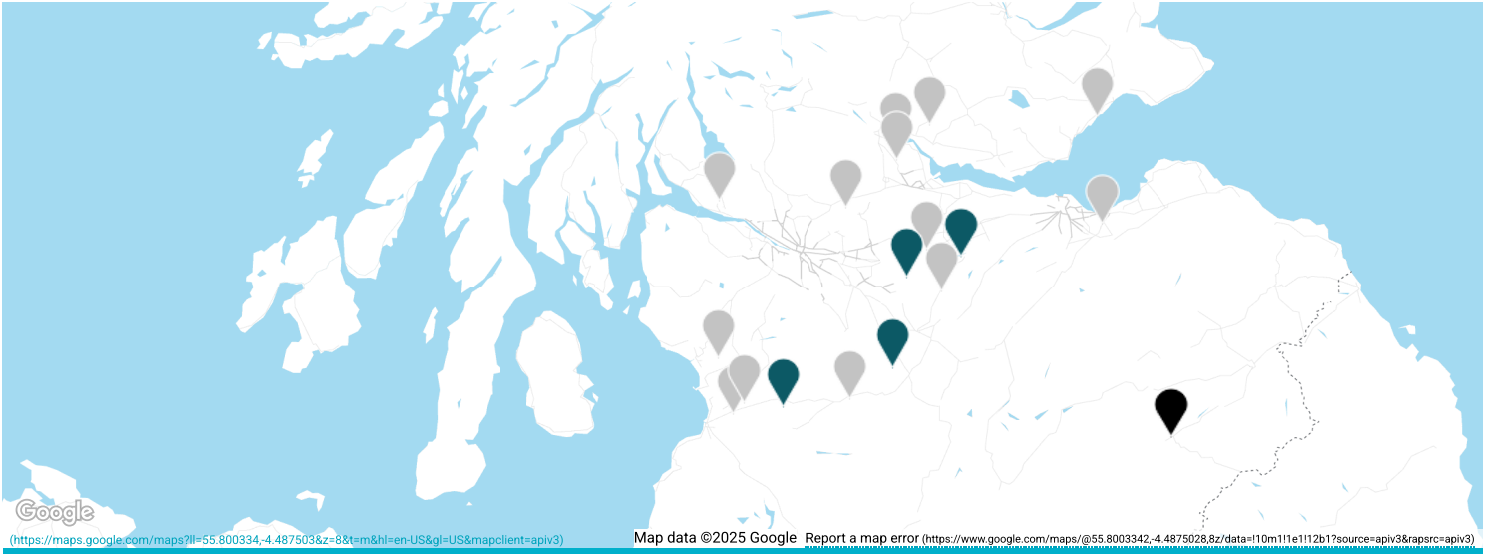




Burnfoot

Burnfoot is in Scottish Borders. It is a mid 20th century housing estate by origin. New social housing is being built in an effort to improve the area. It is essentially a suburb of Hawick. Local employment includes an industrial estate and knitwear factory.

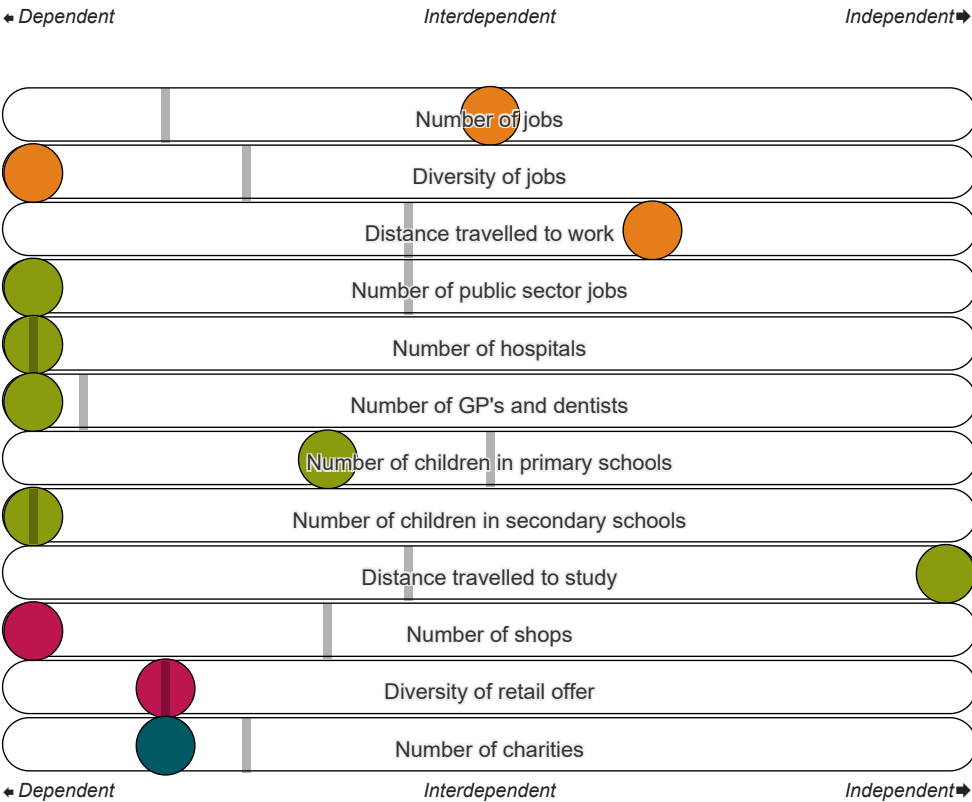
In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Burnfoot is a dependent to interdependent town.

Burnfoot is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

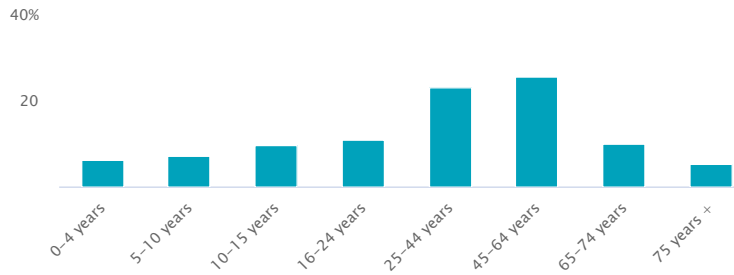
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Burnfoot is grouped with 17 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to study. Burnfoot differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs, and shops.

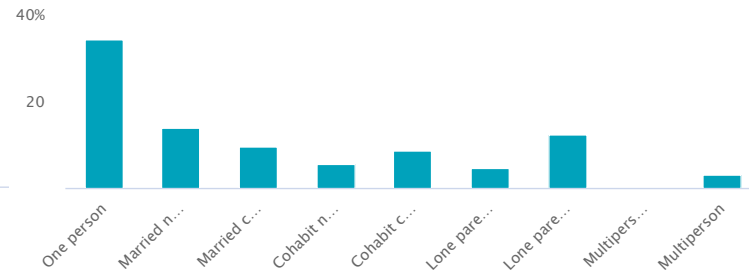

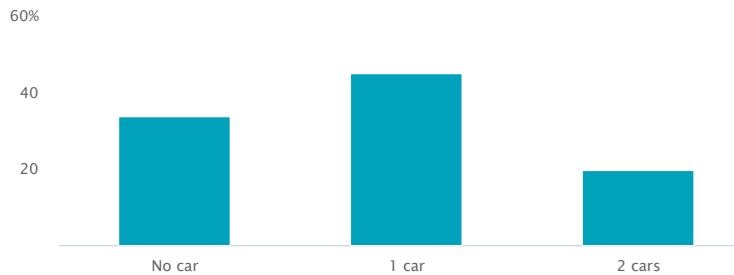

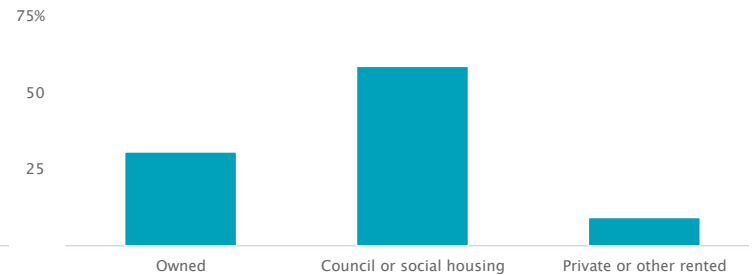
Household composition

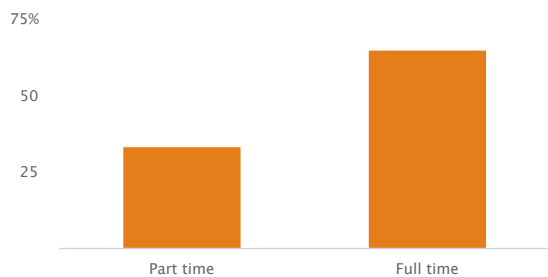

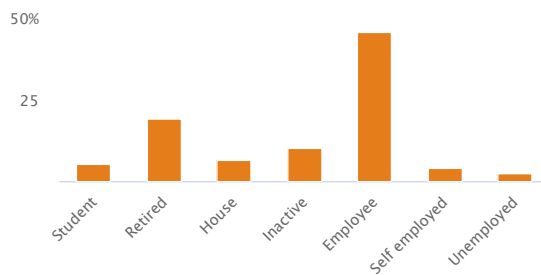
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



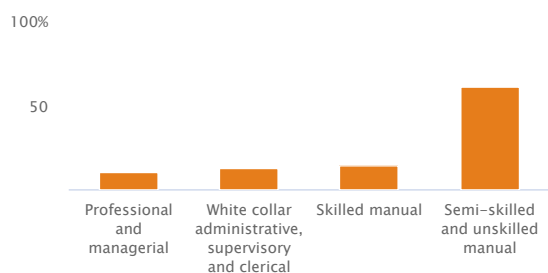
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

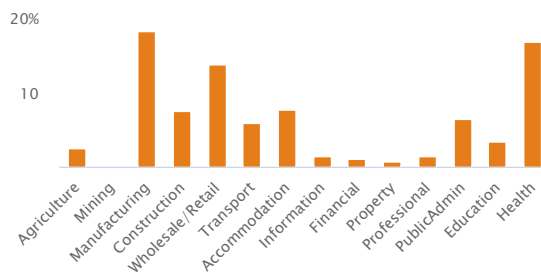


Social Grade

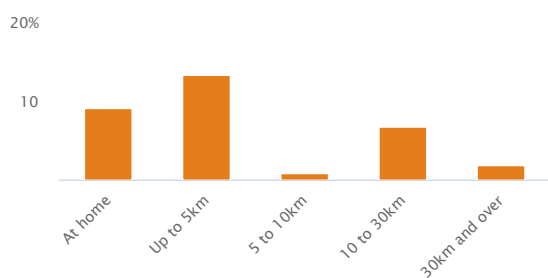
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

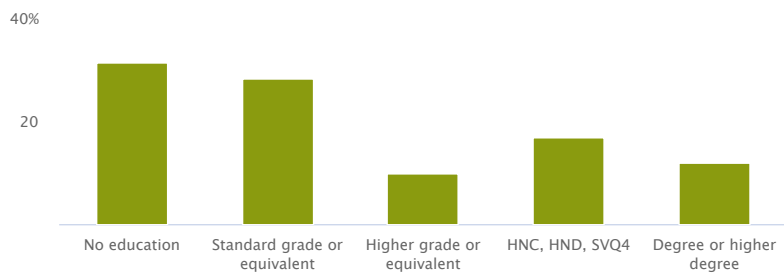


Distance travelled to work

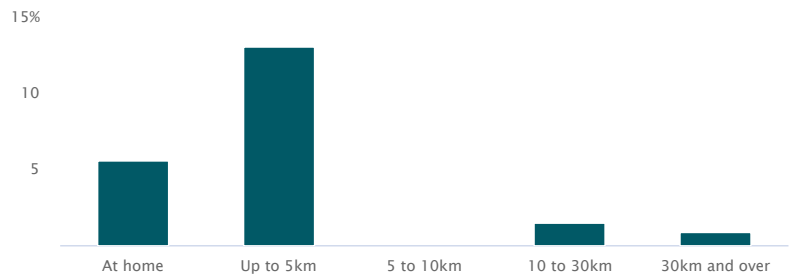
