Cairneyhill in Fife was originally a weaving village. Today it is largely a commuter settlement.

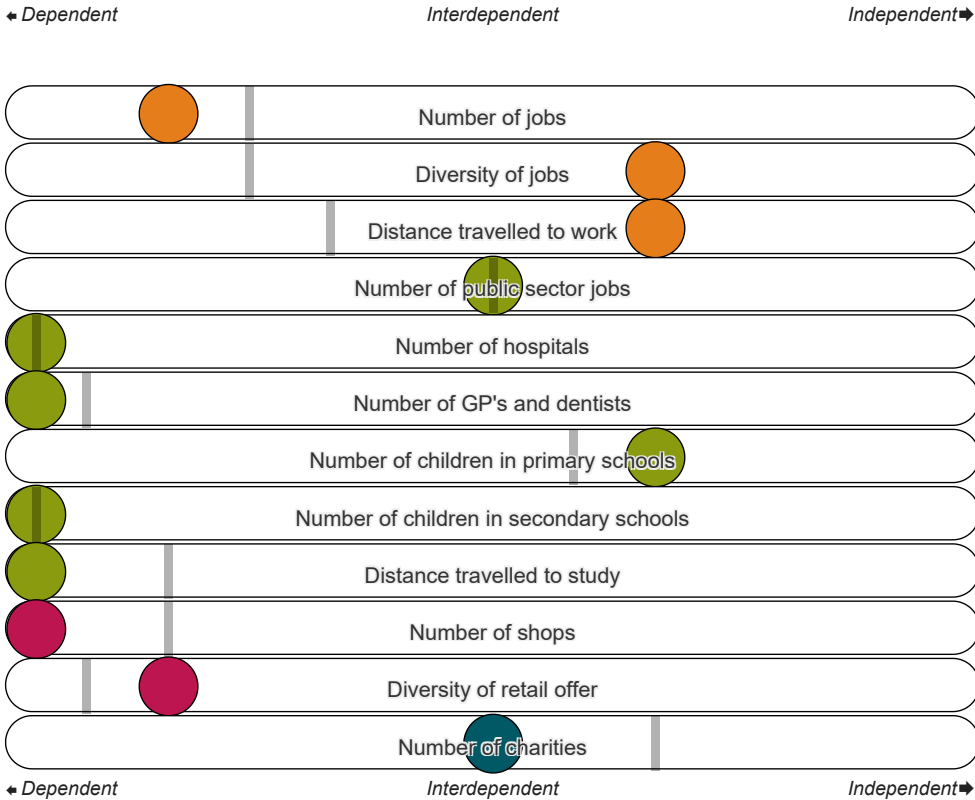
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Cairneyhill is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aberlady](#), [Balmullo](#), [Bankfoot](#), and [Crail](#).

Inter-relationships



Cairneyhill is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Cairneyhill is grouped with 19 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

Cairneyhill differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

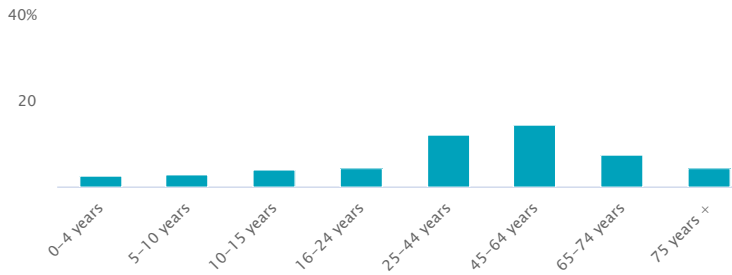

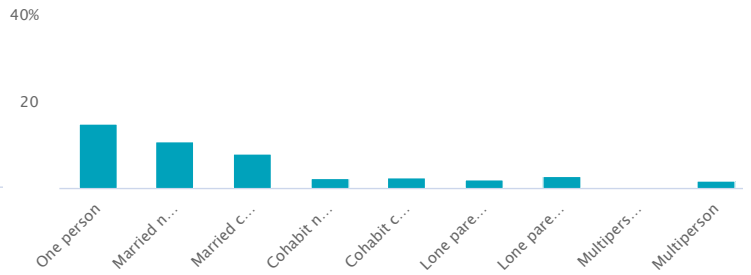

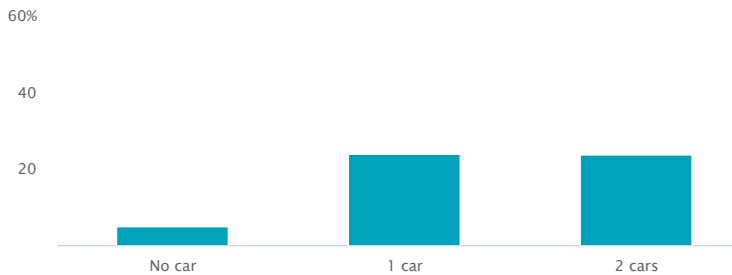

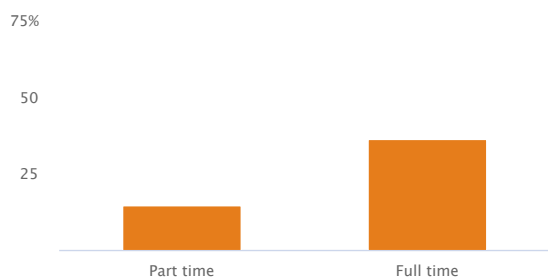

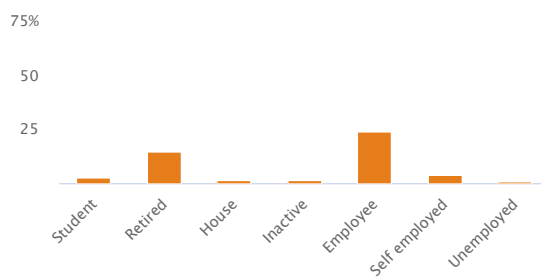
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



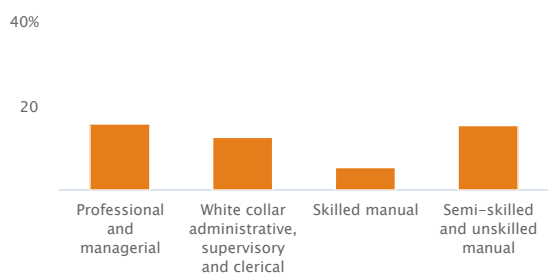
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

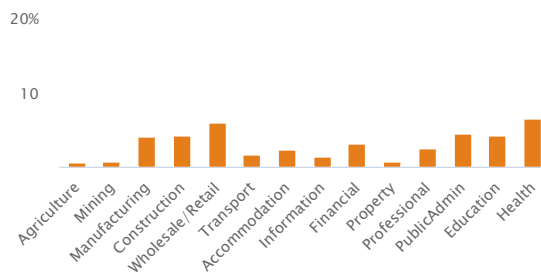

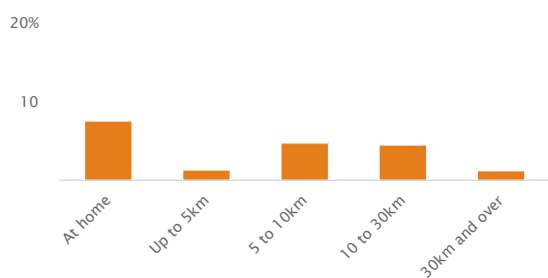
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

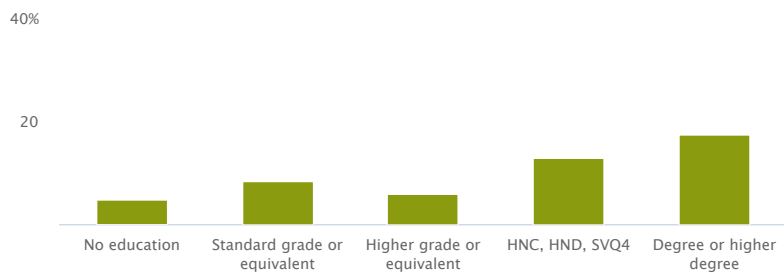


Distance travelled to work

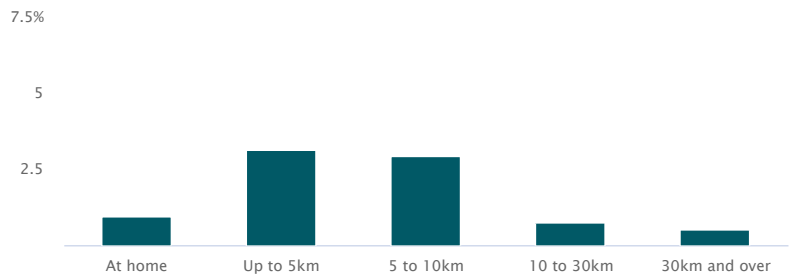
