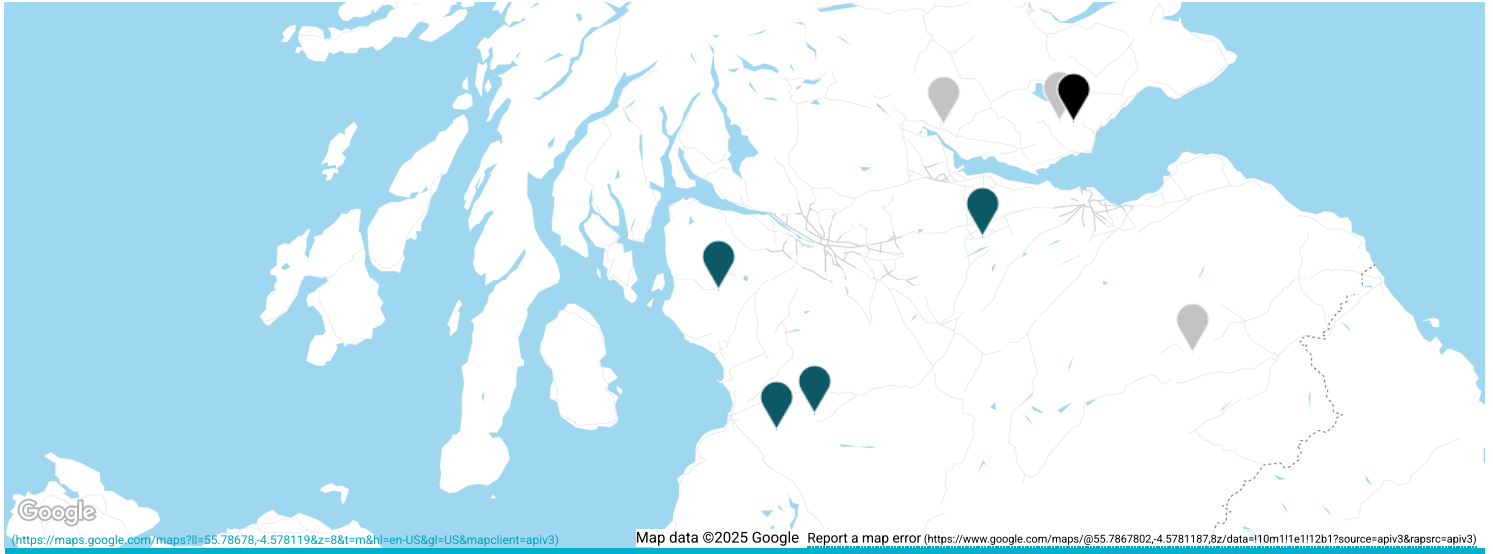




Cardenden and Auchterderran

Cardenden and Dundonald are an industrial settlement associated traditionally with mining. There is still manufacturing in the area.

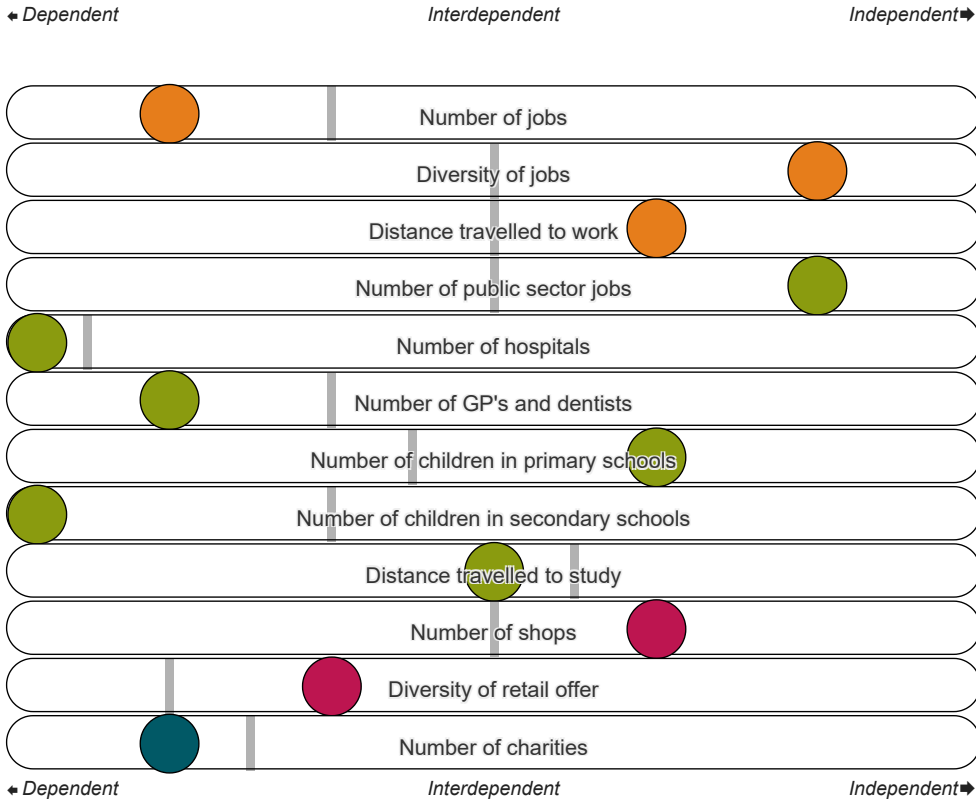
In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Inter-relationships



Cardenden and Auchterderran is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Cardenden and Auchterderran is grouped with 7 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Cardenden and Auchterderran differs most from its group in the number of children in secondary schools.

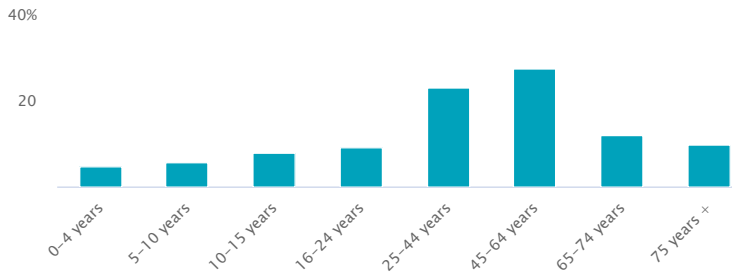

Population change 2011 to 2022**-5%**

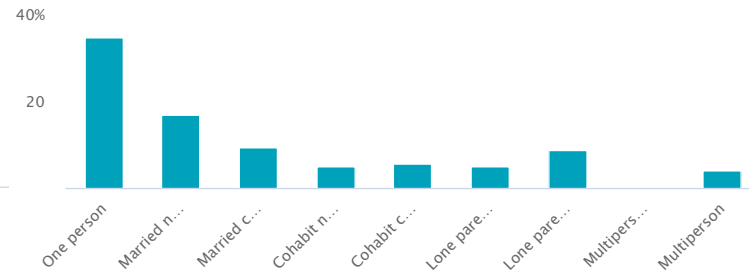

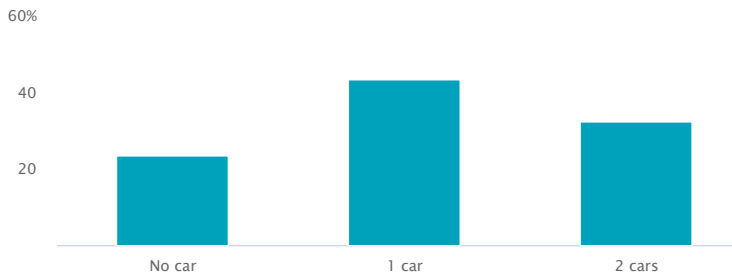

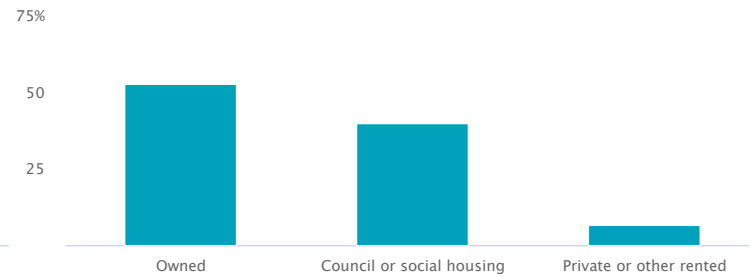

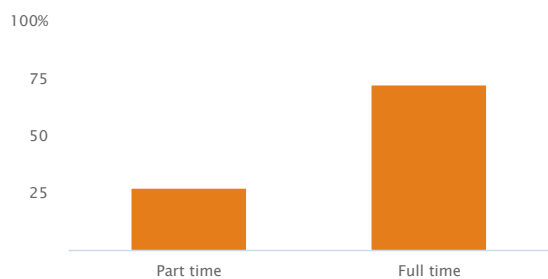

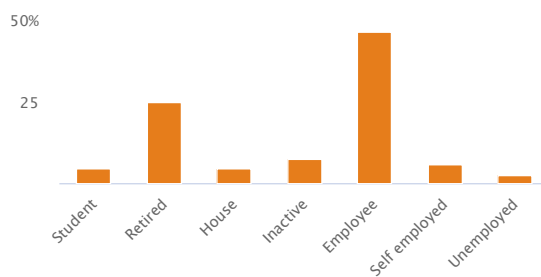
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



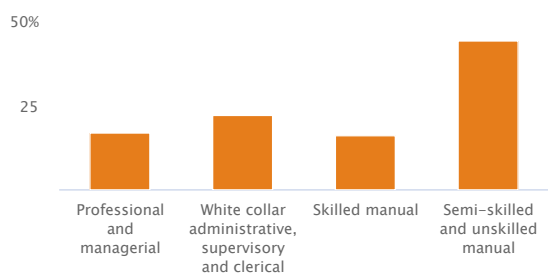
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

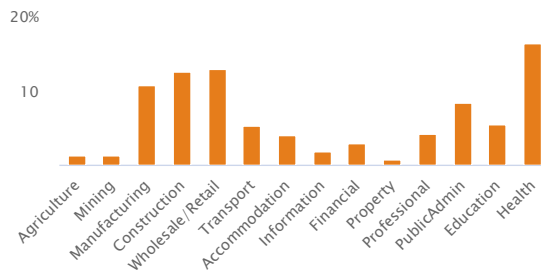

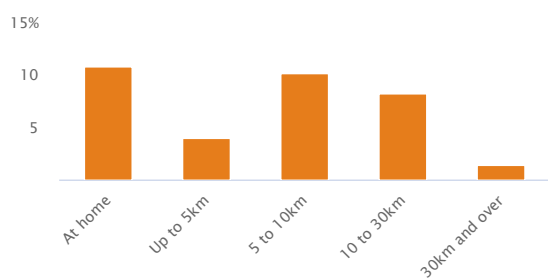
(% households aged 16-64)



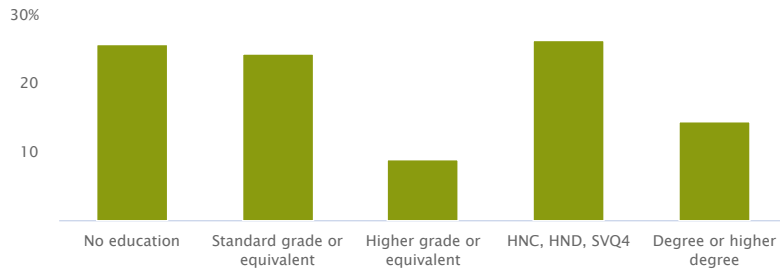
Sector Diversity

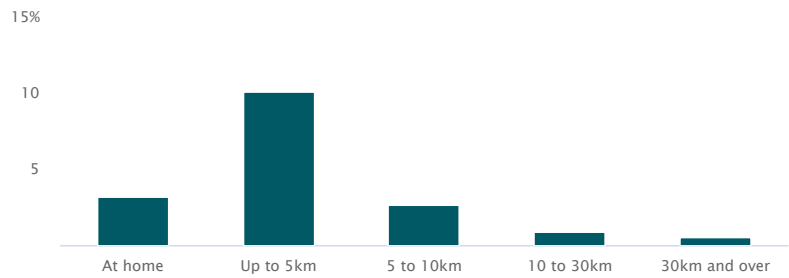
