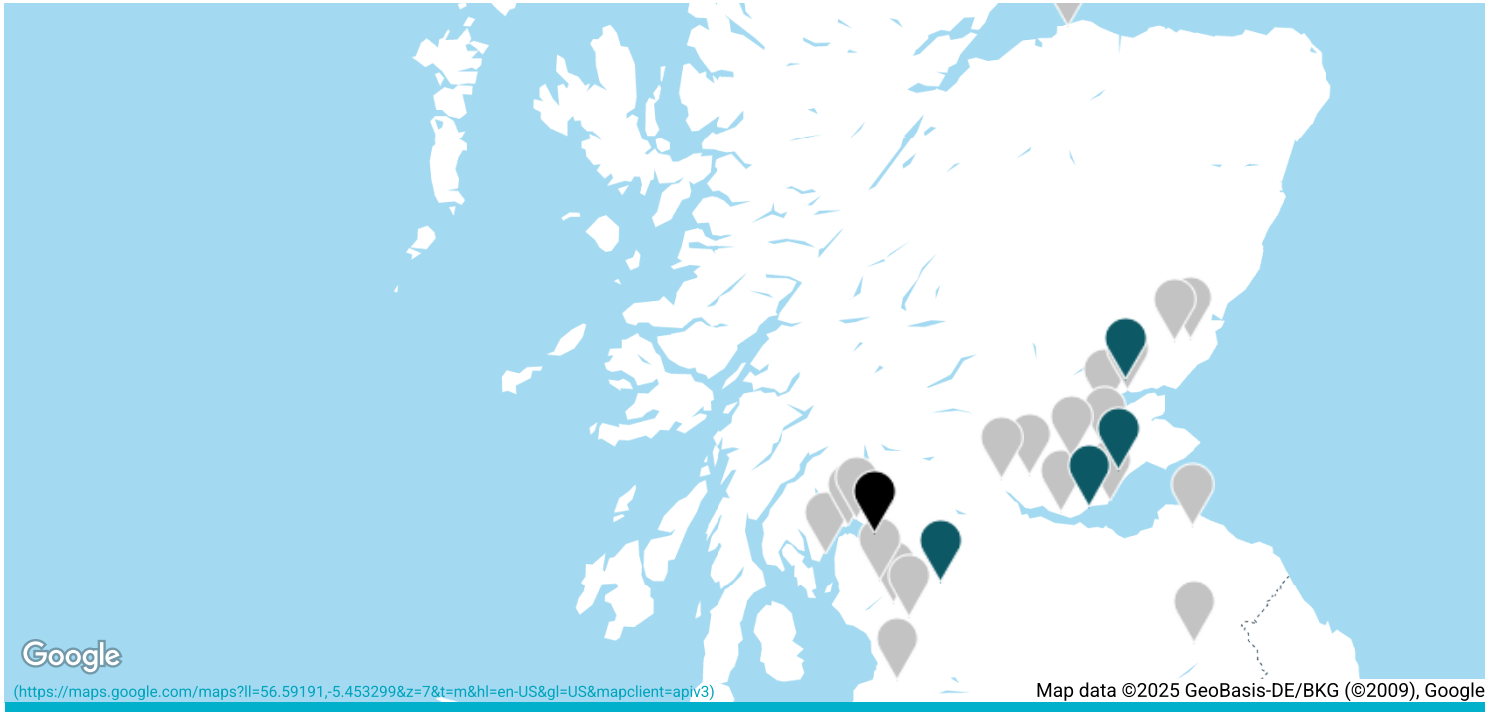




Cardross

Cardross is located in Argyll and Bute. Built on land originally owned by Robert the Bruce the town is primarily residential.

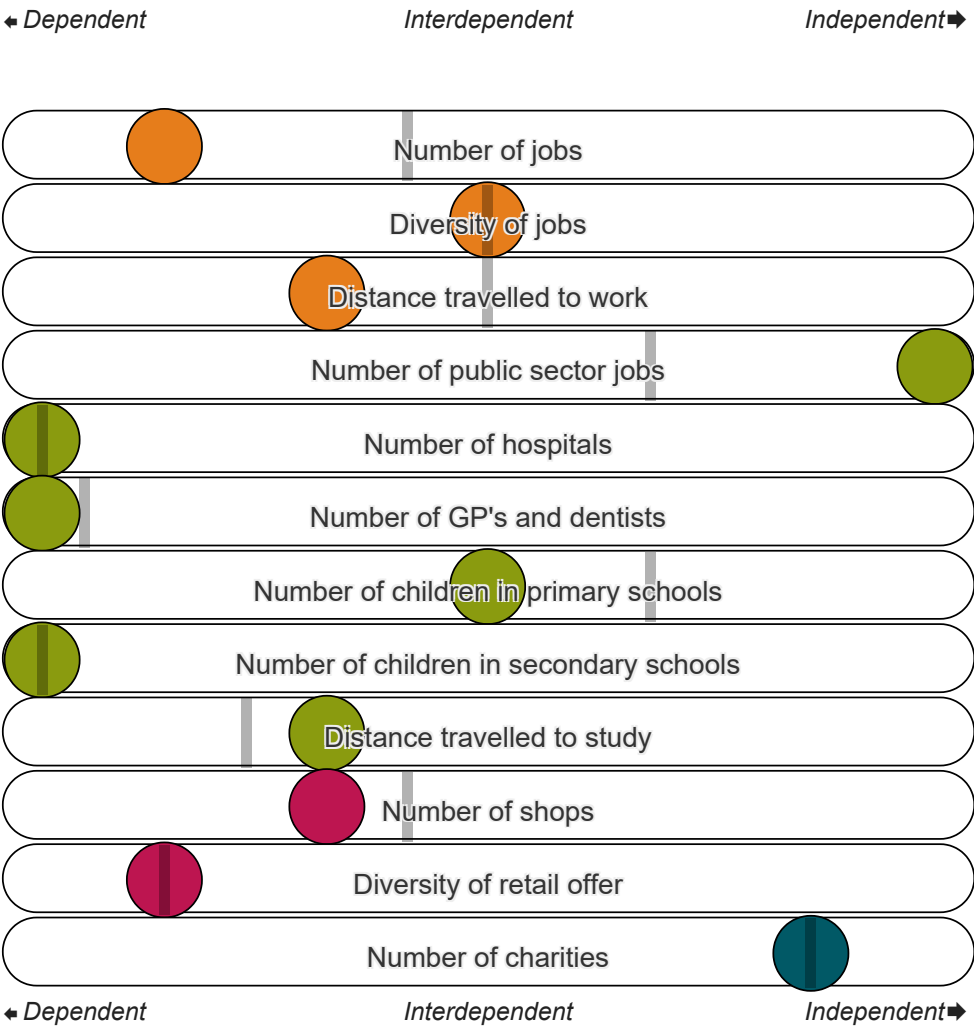
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Cardross is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Cardross is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

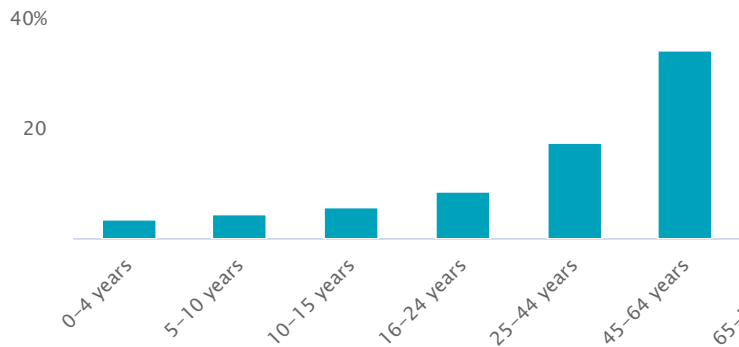

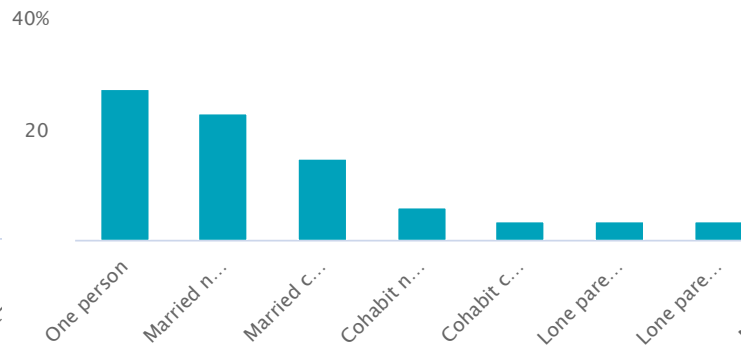

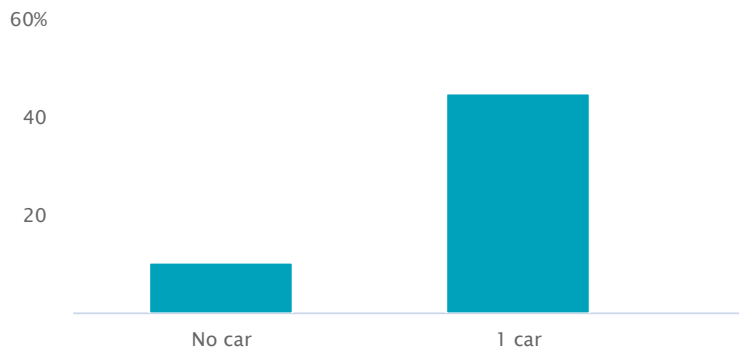

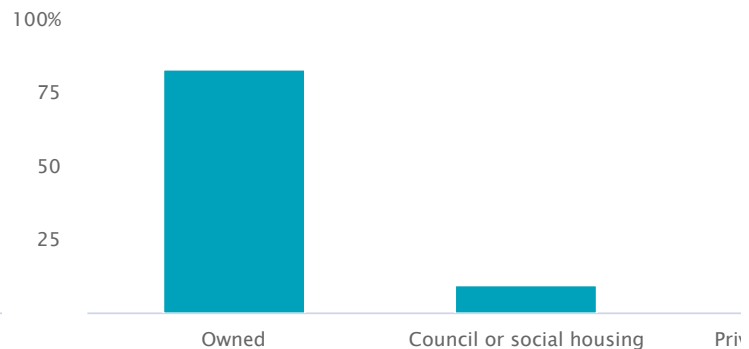
Household composition

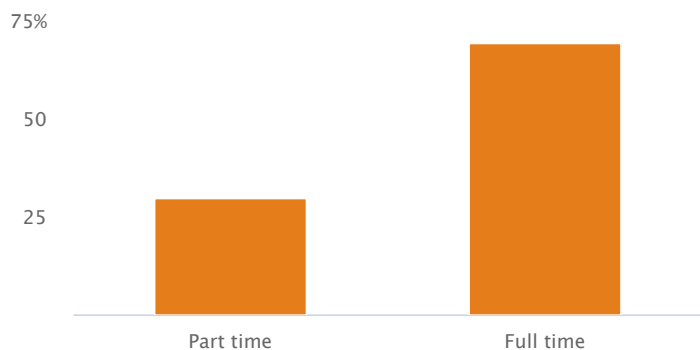

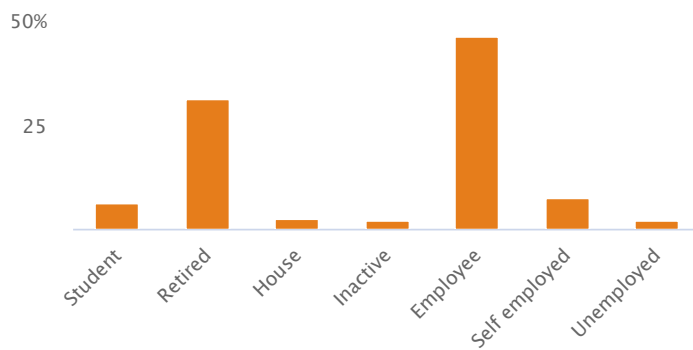
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



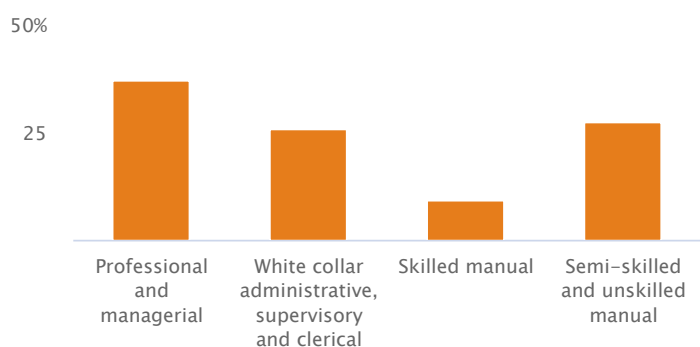
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

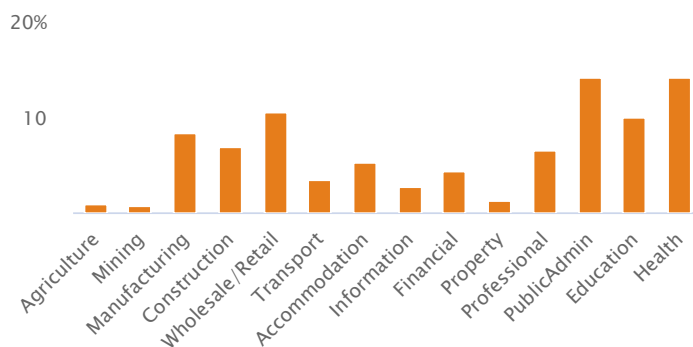


Social Grade

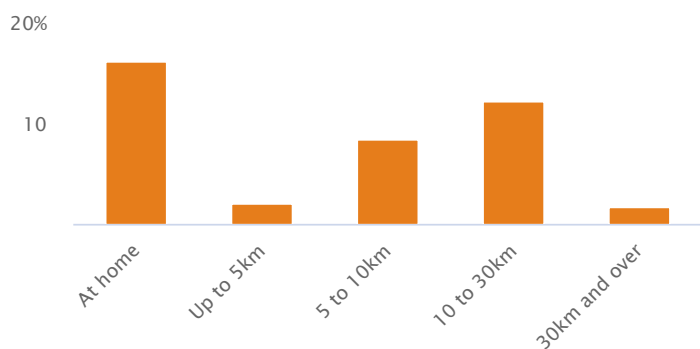
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

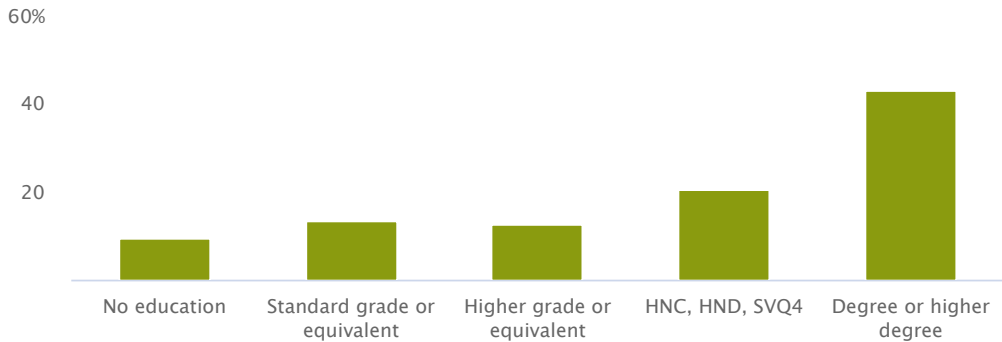


Distance travelled to work

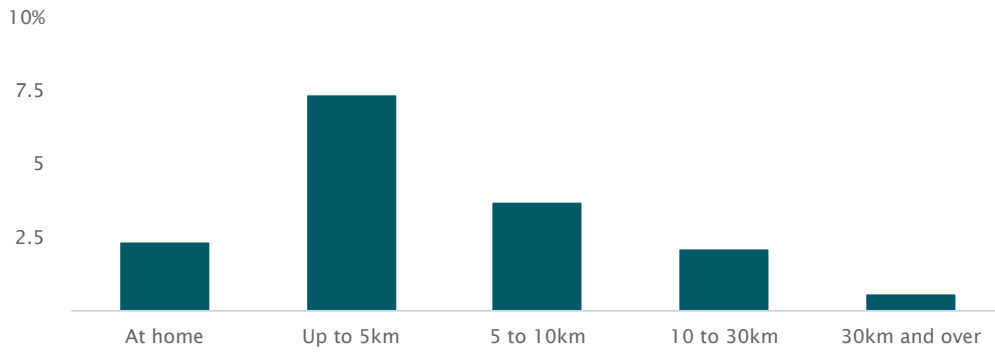
