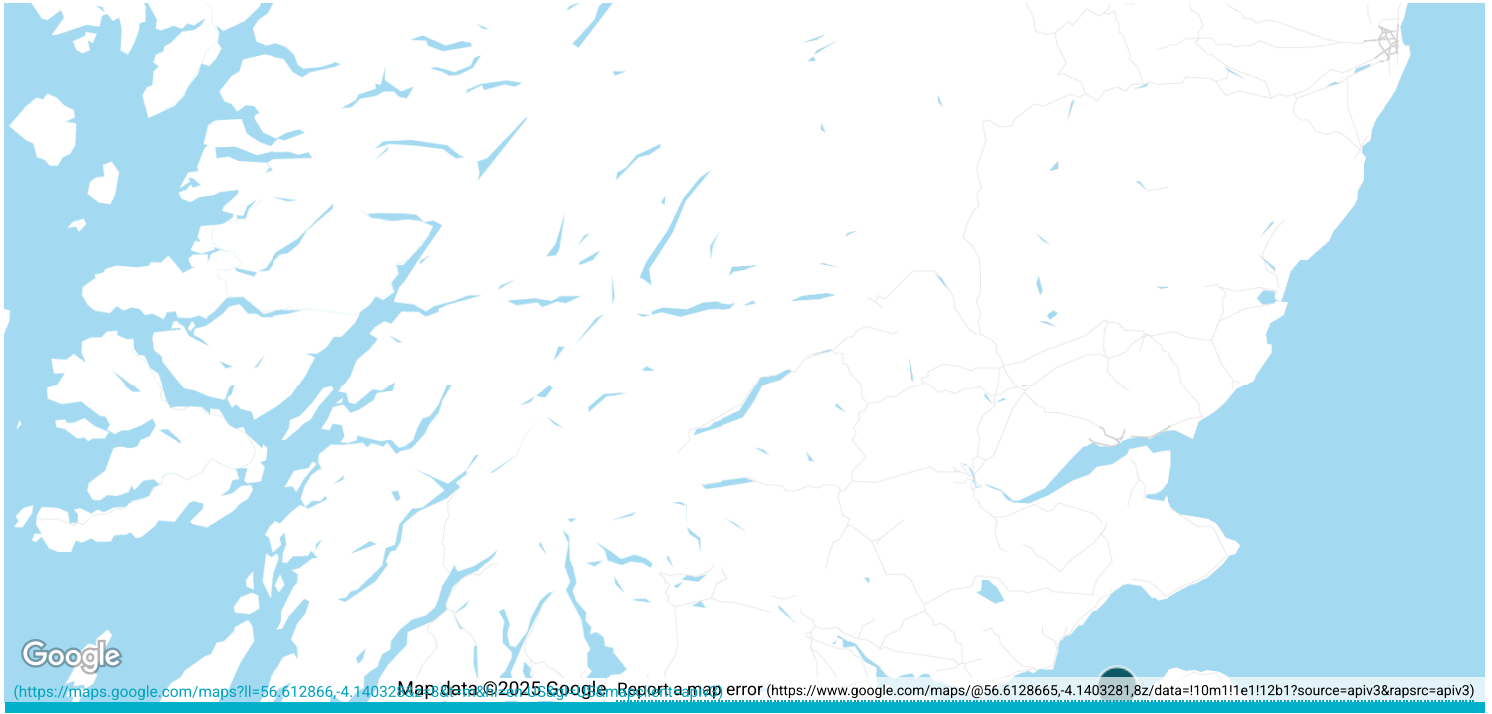




Carluke

Carluke is in South Lanarkshire. It was located on the old Roman road. It was the birthplace of General Roy, mapmaker and surveyor. Later it became the location of Carstairs railway junction and today it is has an important park and ride facility. It is known for its jam.

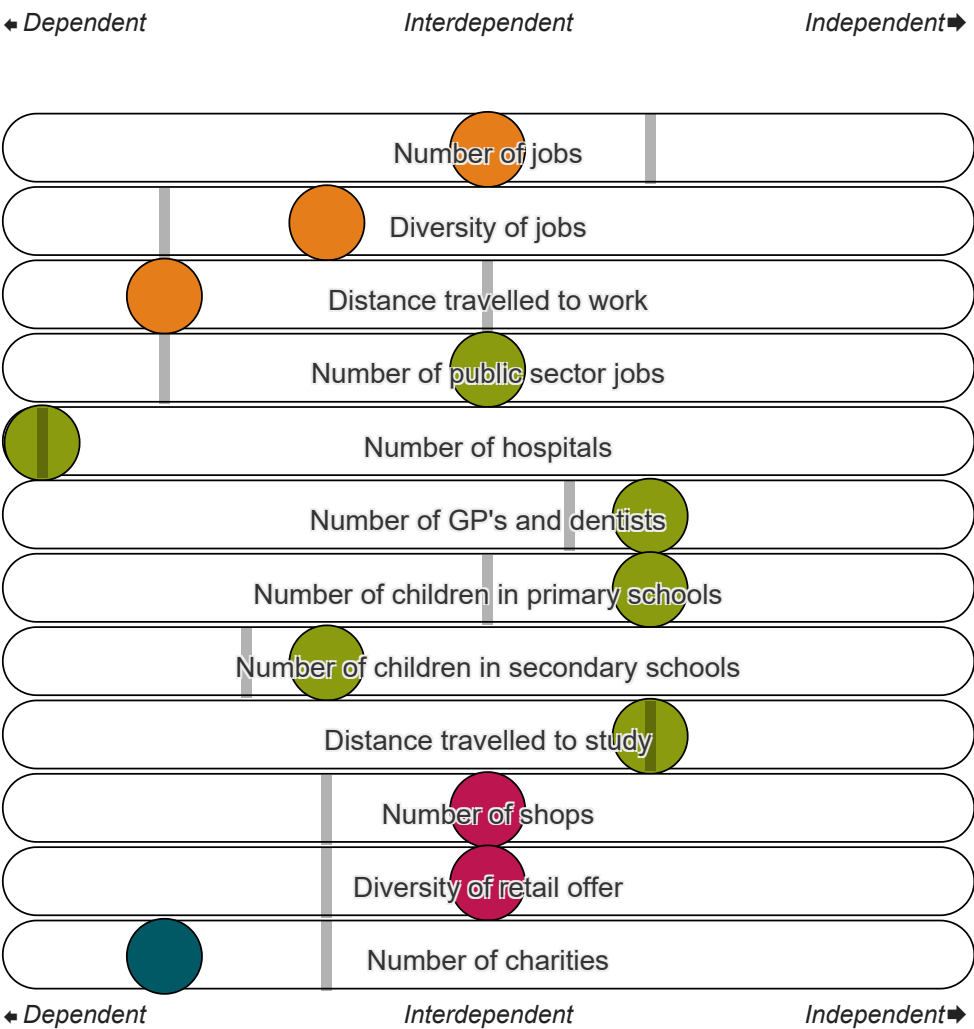
In large towns, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Carlake is grouped with 3 other towns. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. Carlake differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

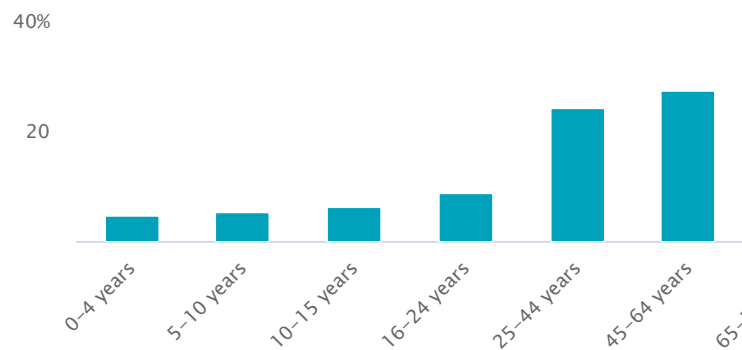

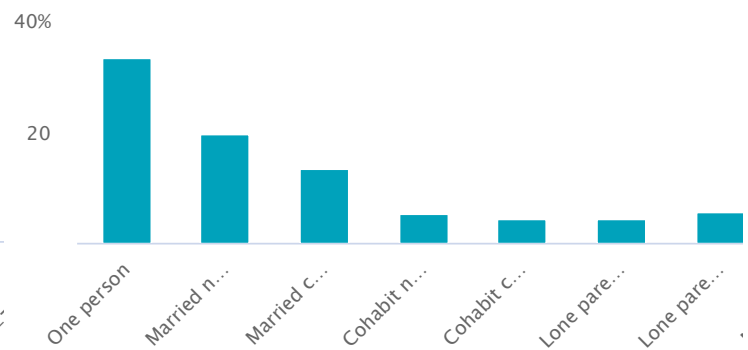

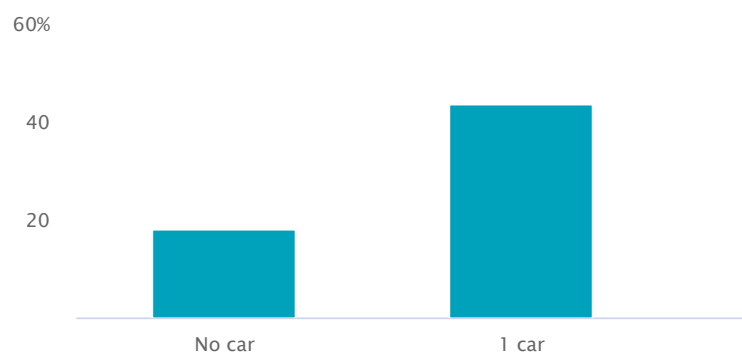

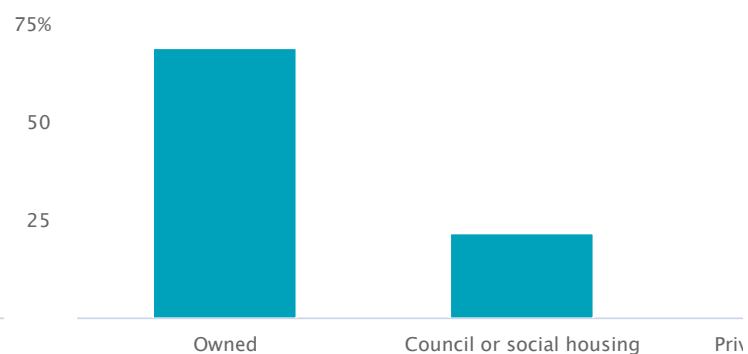

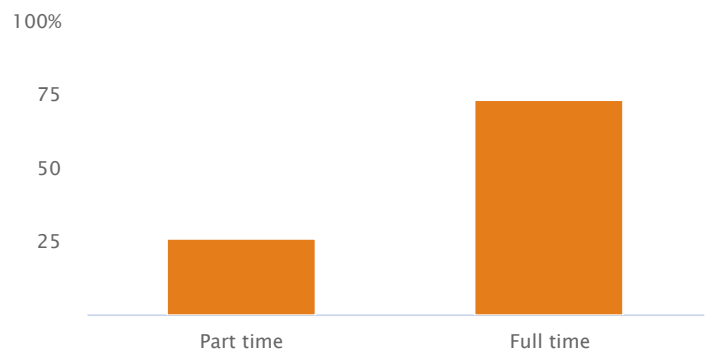

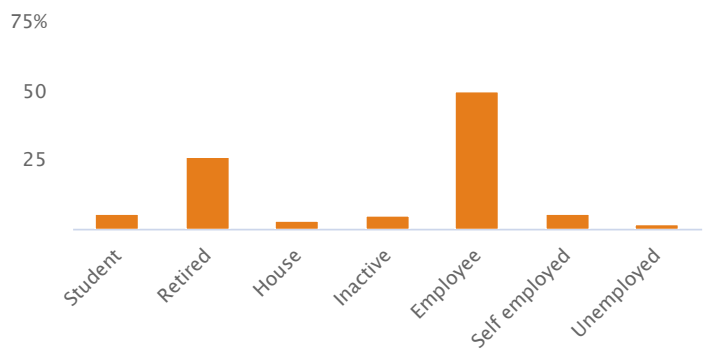
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



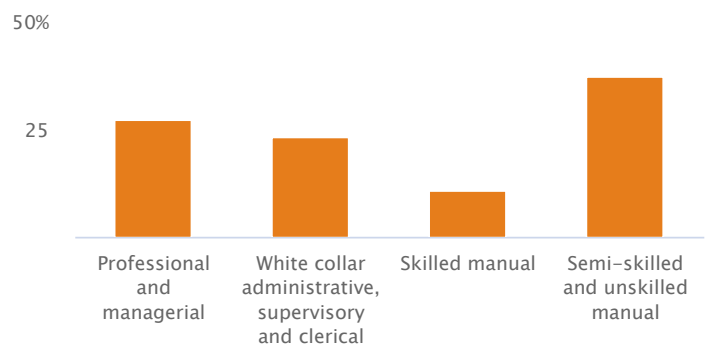
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

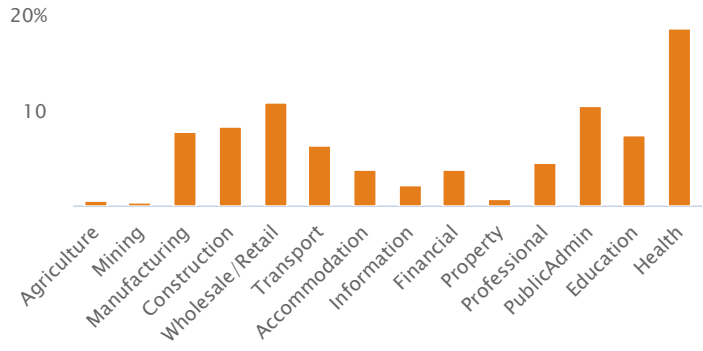

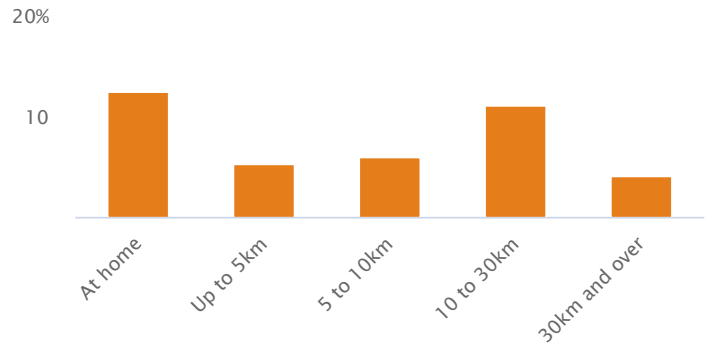
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

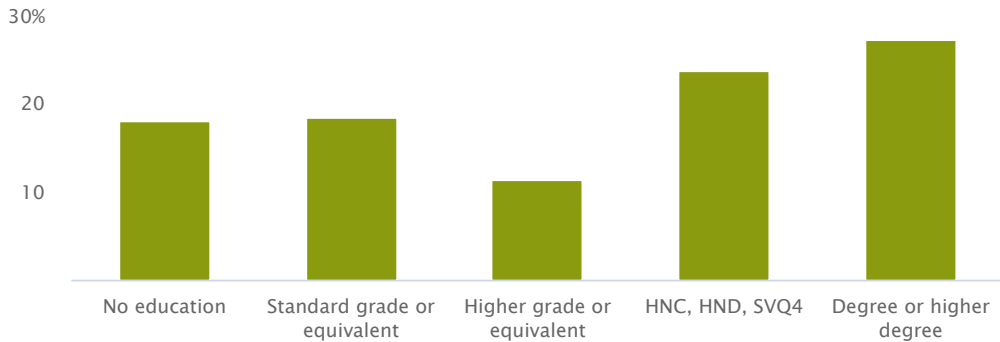


Distance travelled to work

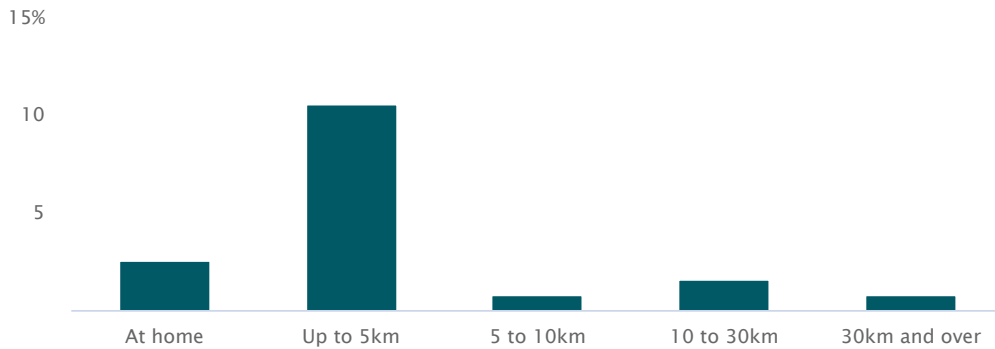
