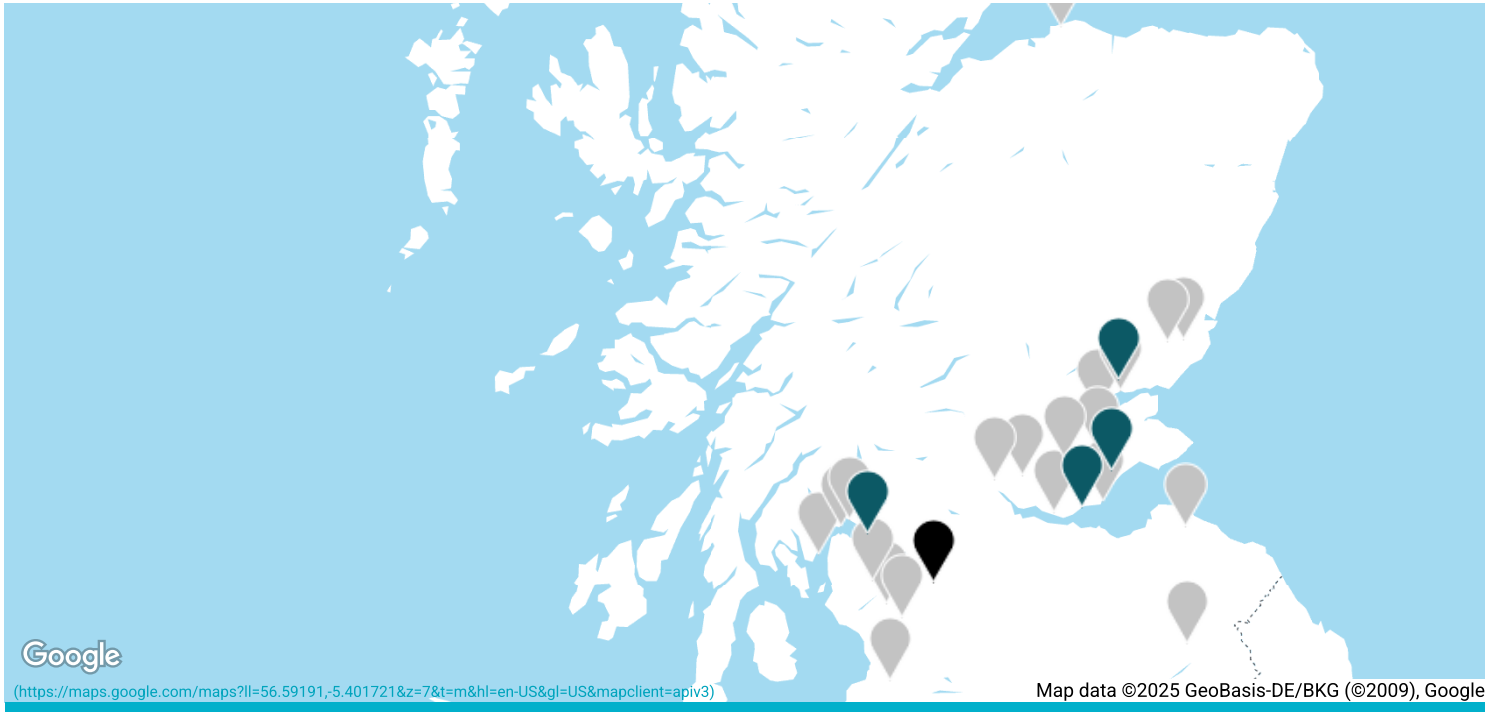




Carmunnock

Carmunnock in Glasgow City was an early Christian settlement. It has a medieval street plan and its character is part of its attraction as a commuter settlement today.

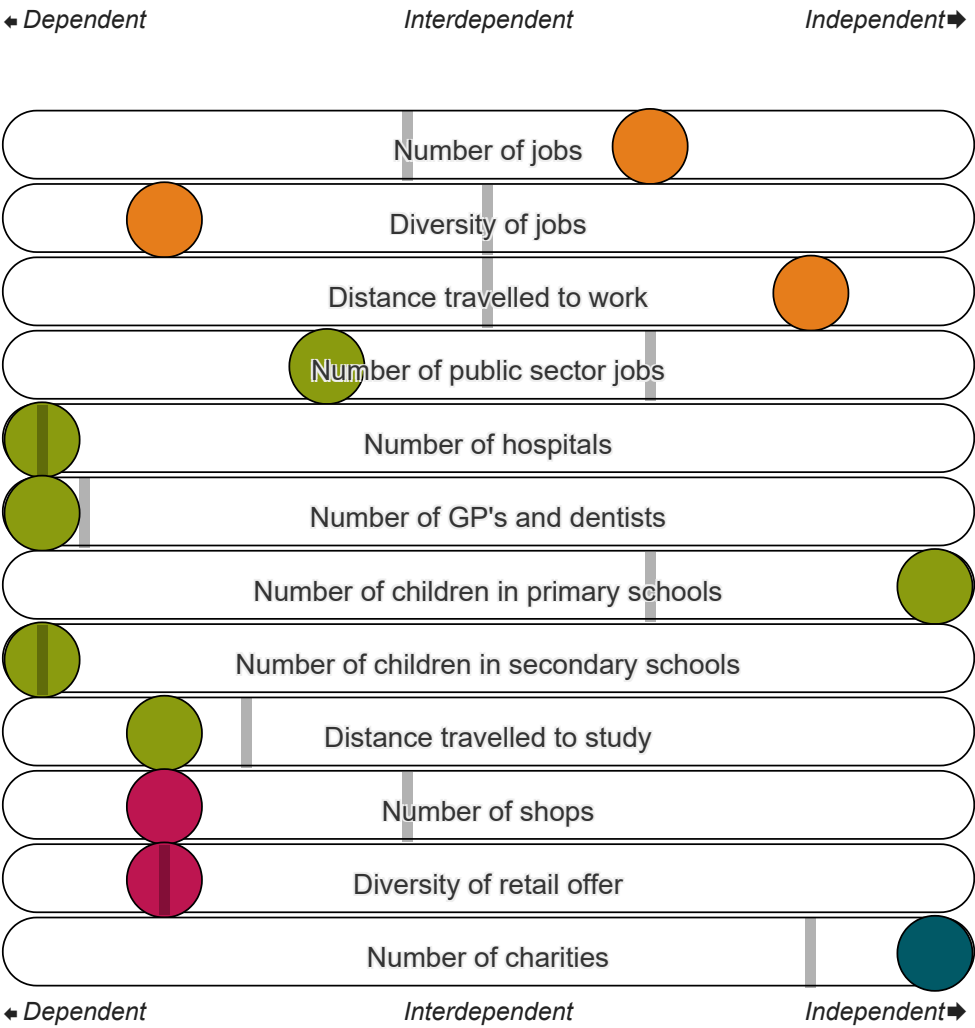
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Carmunnock is an interdependent to dependent town.

Its most similar towns are [Aberdour](#), [Birkhill and Muirhead](#), [Cardross](#), and [Coaltown of Balgonie](#).

Inter-relationships



Carmunnock is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Carmunnock is grouped with 24 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, jobs, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Carmunnock differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs.

Population change 2011 to 2022**2%**

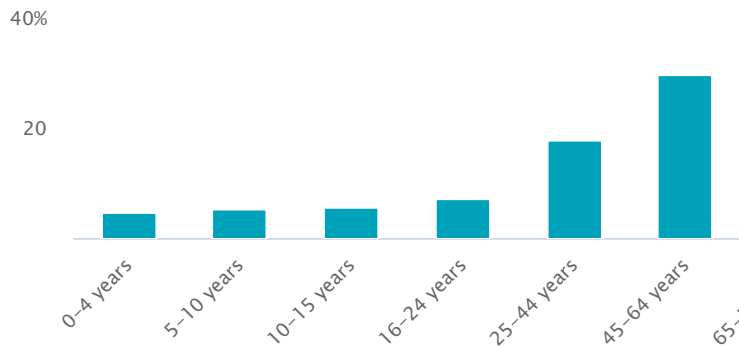

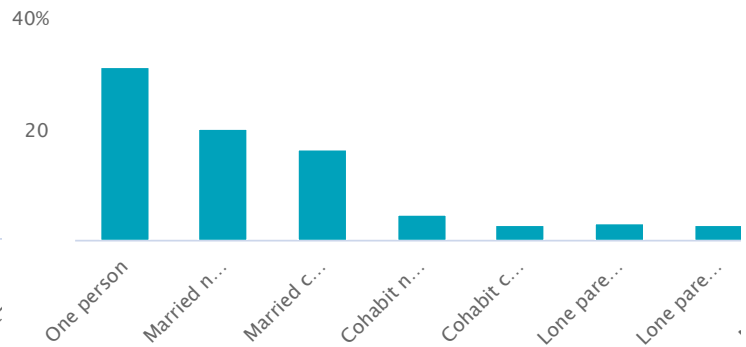

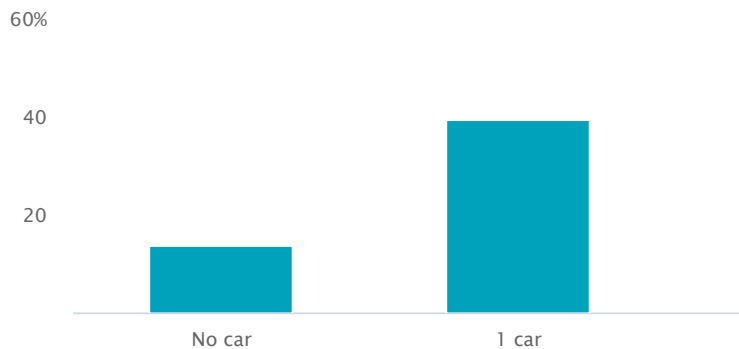

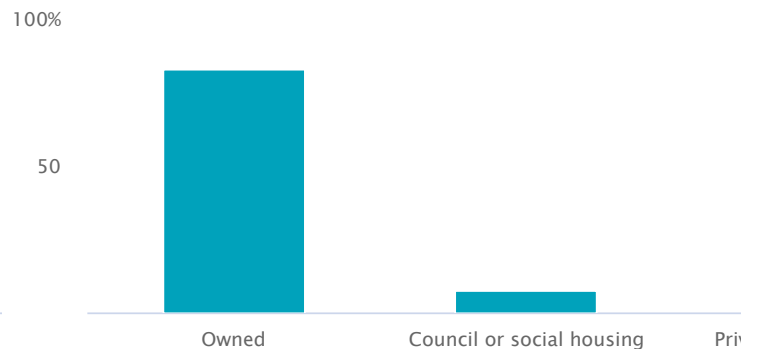

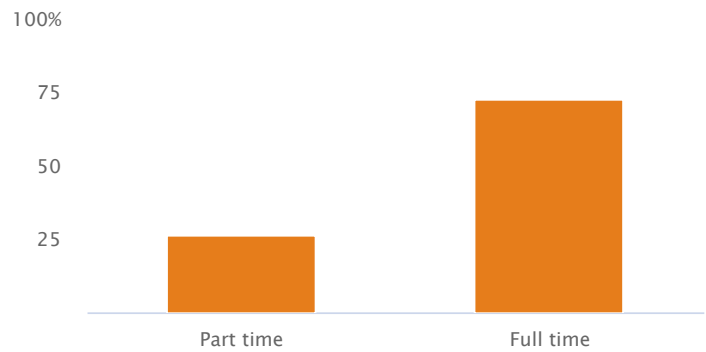

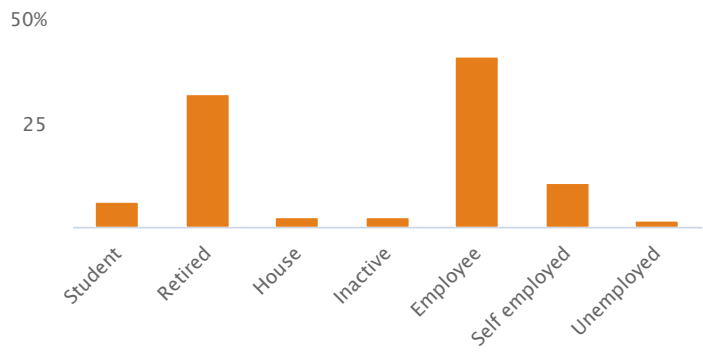
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



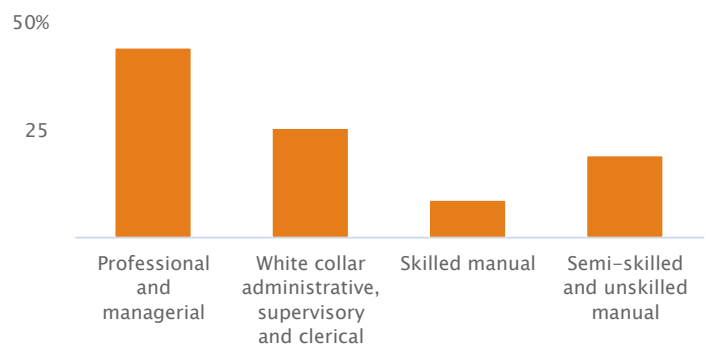
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

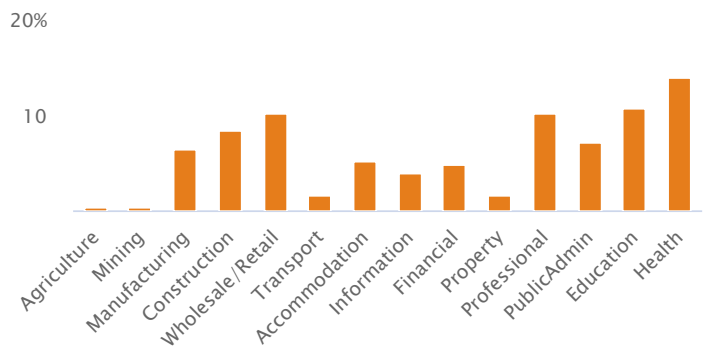


Social Grade

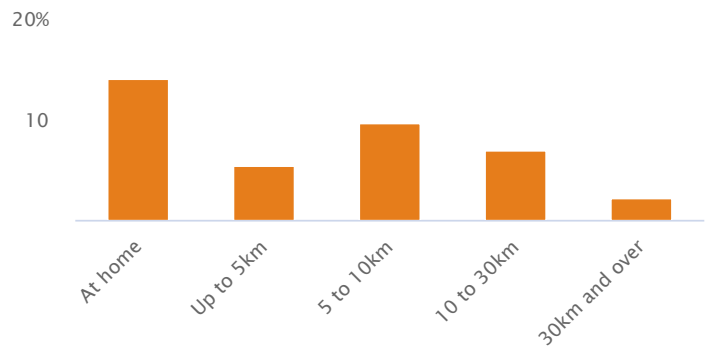
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

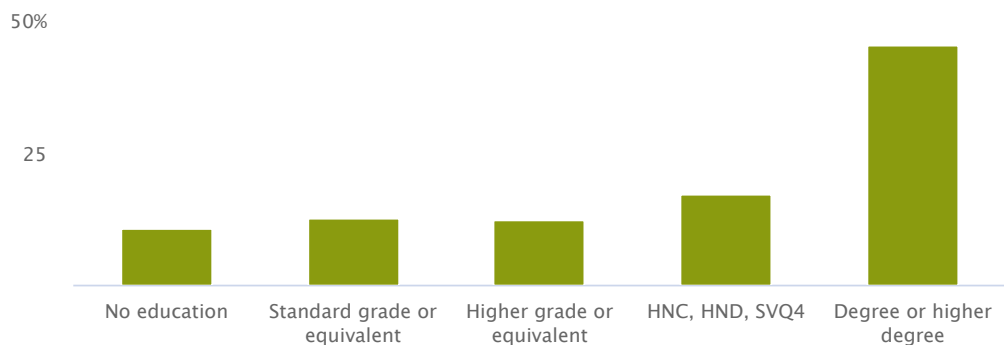


Distance travelled to work

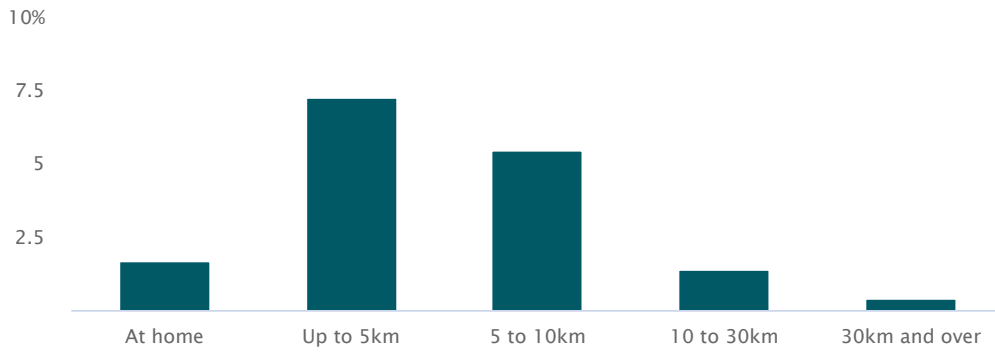
