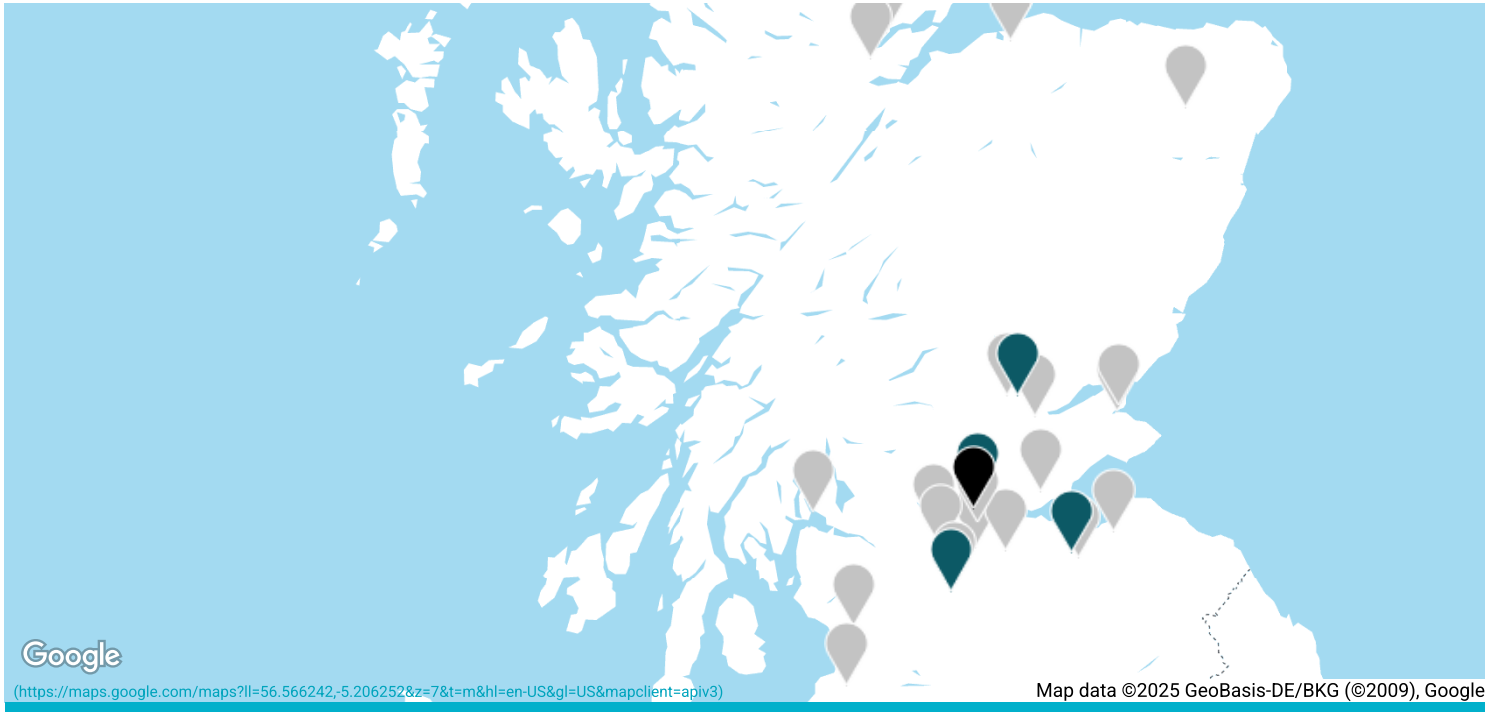

Carron in Falkirk Council area had the first large scale iron foundry in Scotland founded in the mid 18th century. A key product was cannons. The company went bankrupt in 1987 but was re-established as Carron Pheonix and operated by Franke UK. Instead of cannons it makes kitchen sinks.

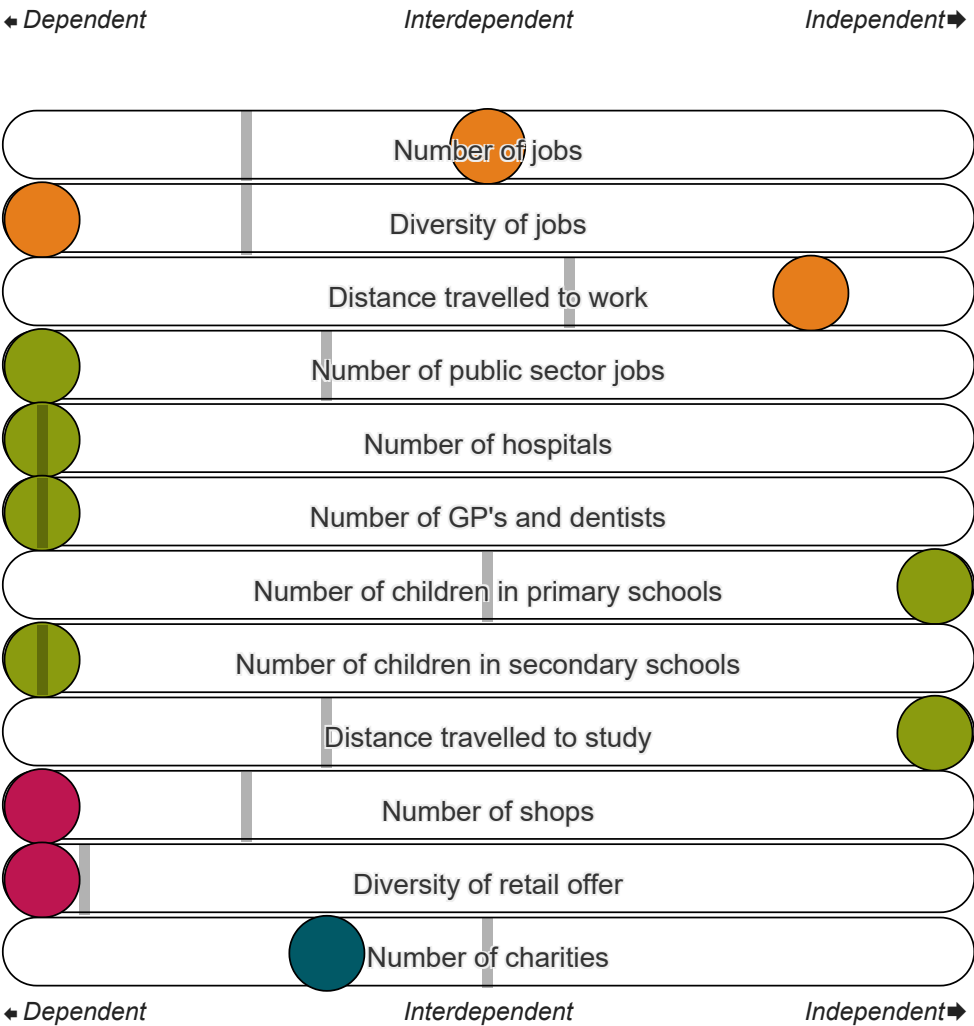
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Carron is a dependent to interdependent town.

Inter-relationships



Carron is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Carron is grouped with 25 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Carron differs most from its group in the number of public sector jobs; and the diversity of jobs.

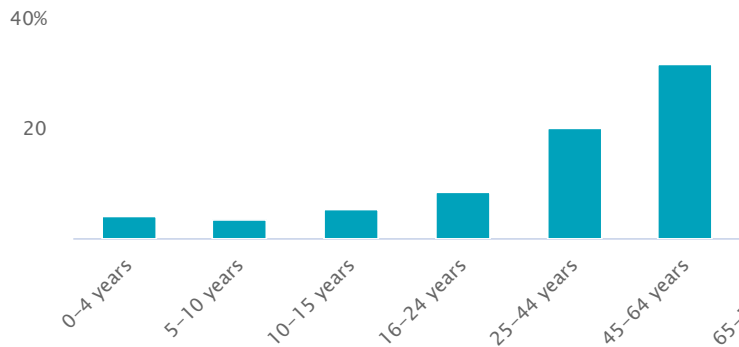

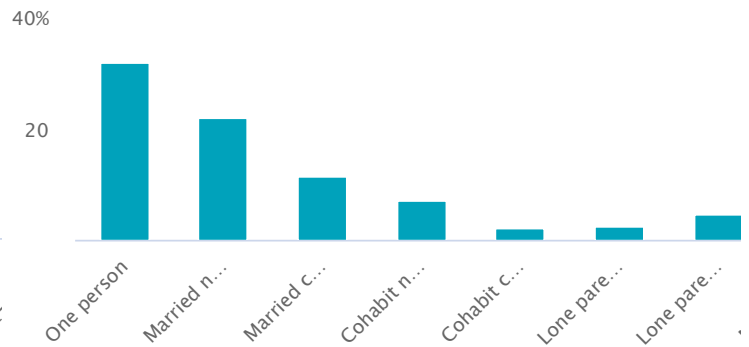

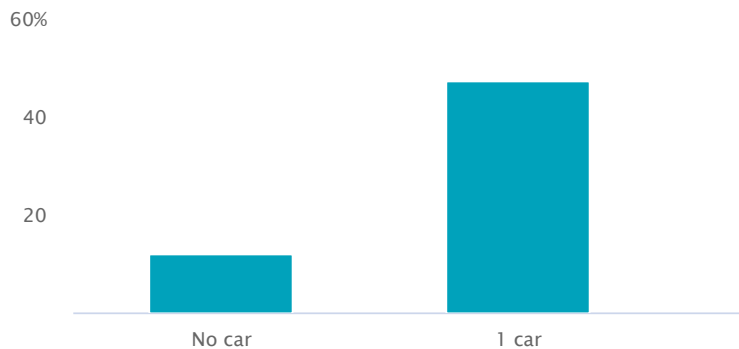

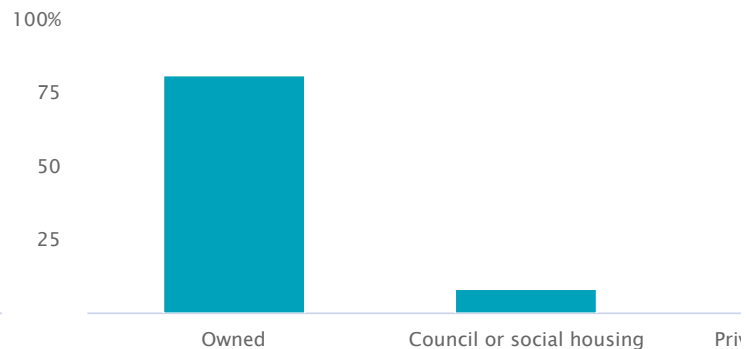

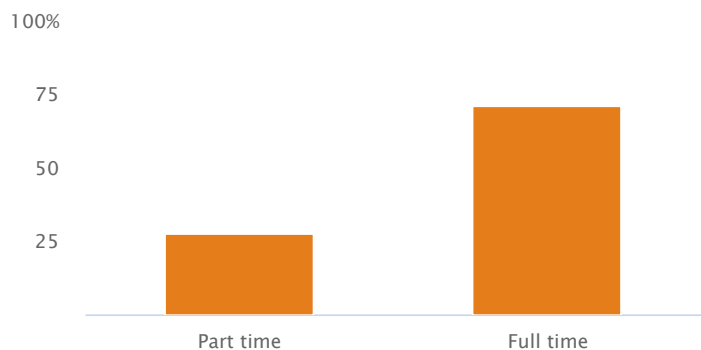

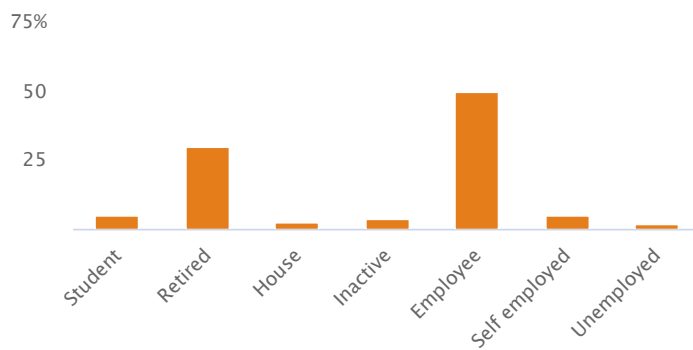
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



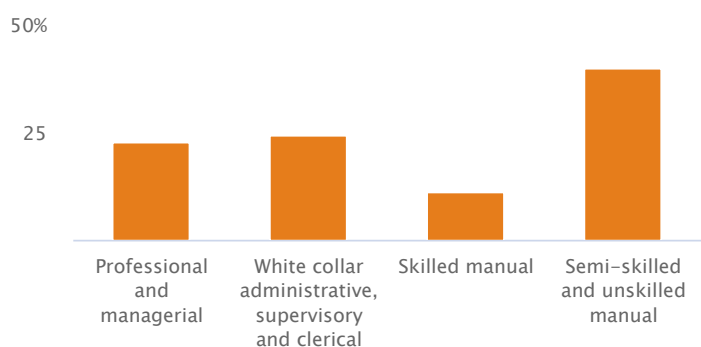
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

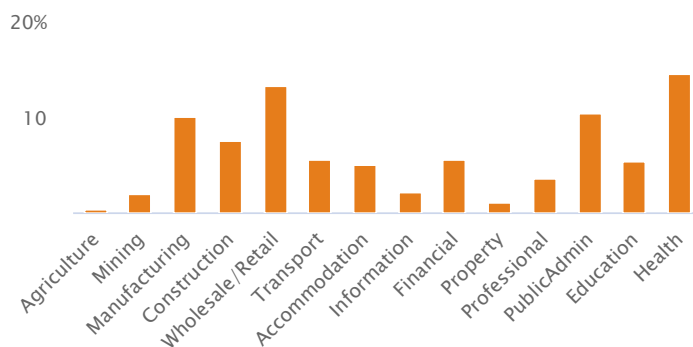

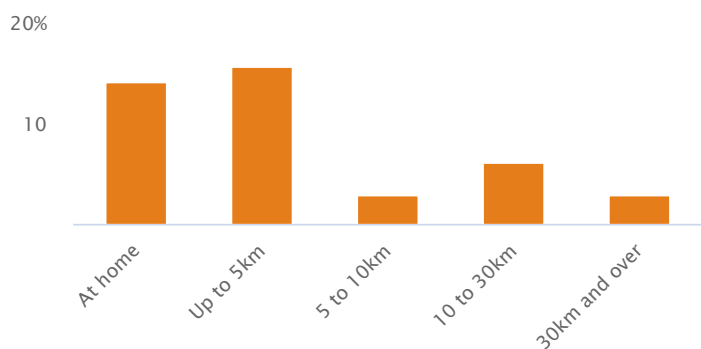
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

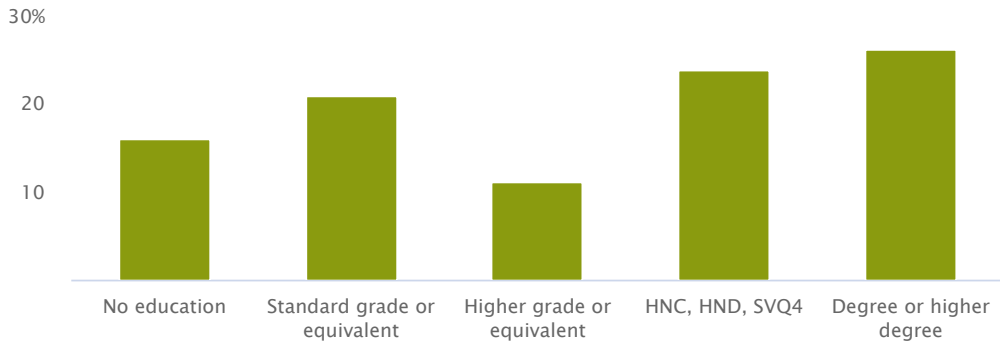


Distance travelled to work

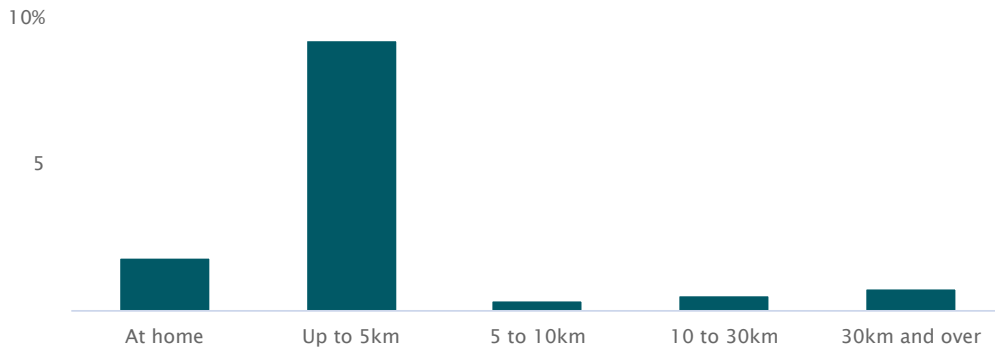
