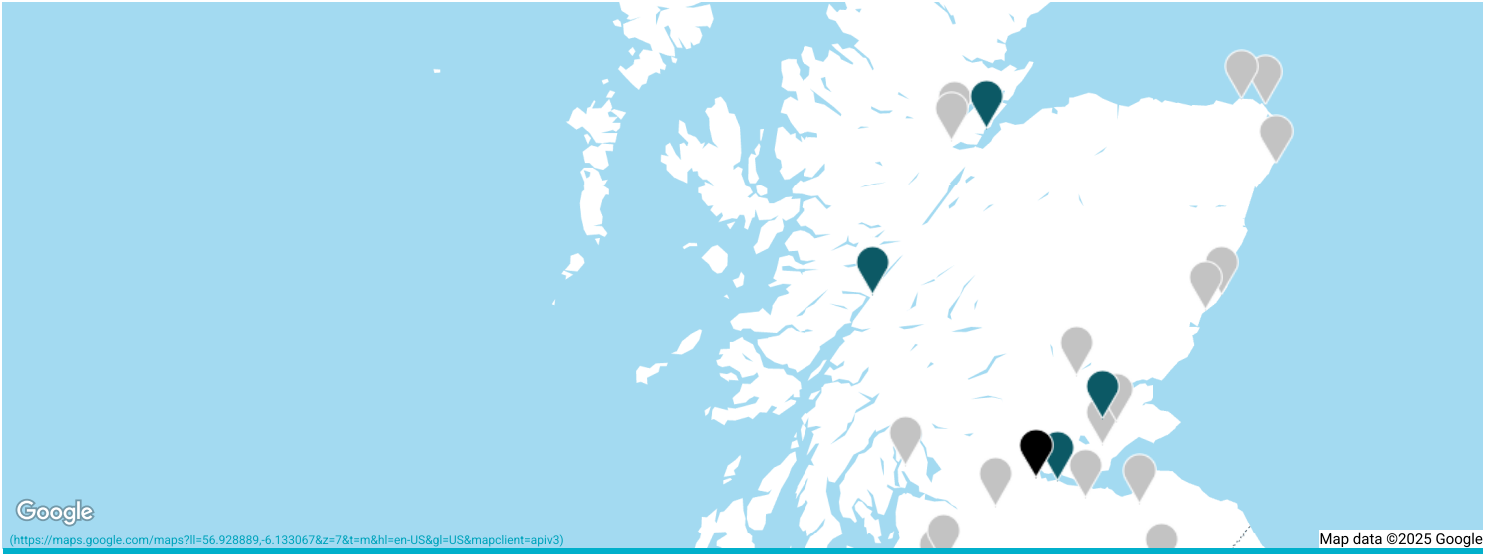




# Carronshore

FALKIRK

POPULATION **2,882**

Carronshore is located in Falkirk Council and is adjacent to Carron. It acted as the port for Carron and for the nearby coalfields.

In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

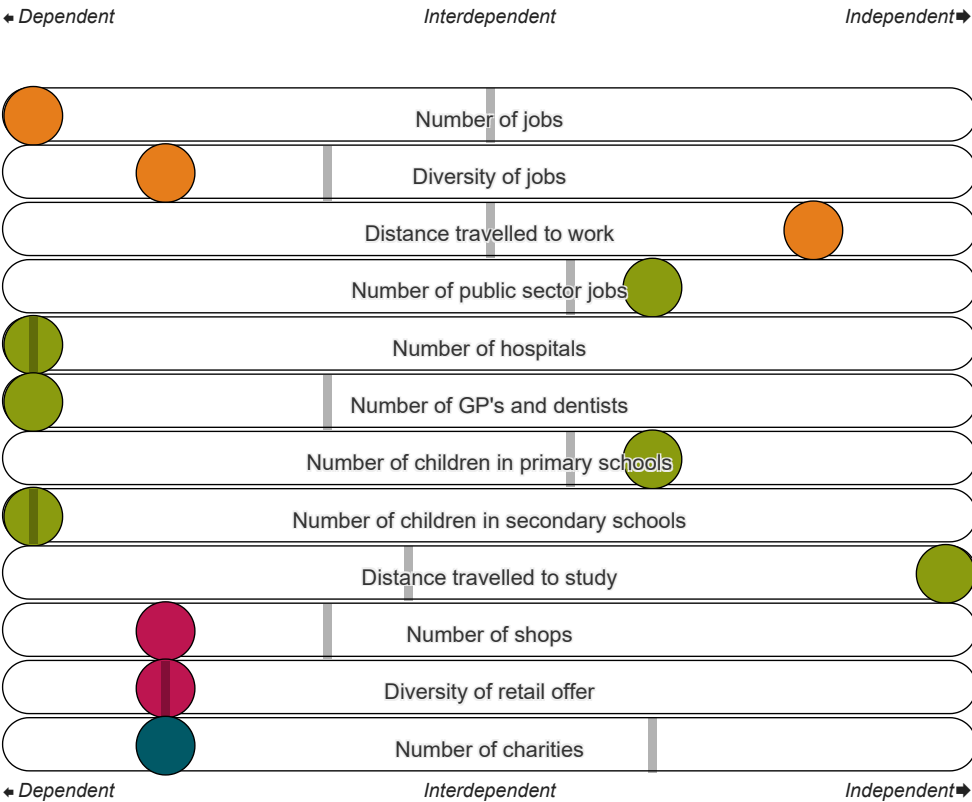
Carronshore is an interdependent to dependent town.

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# Inter-relationships



Carronshire is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Carronshire is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of charities. It also differs in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Carronshire differs most from its group in the number of jobs, and GP's and dentists.

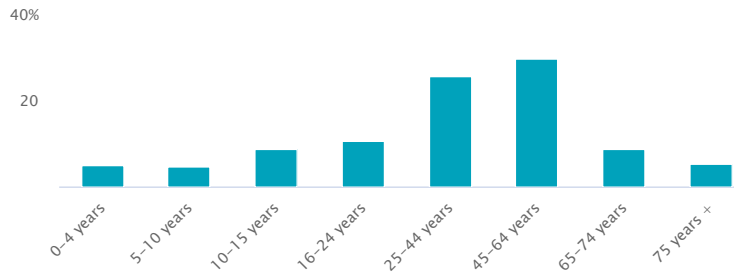

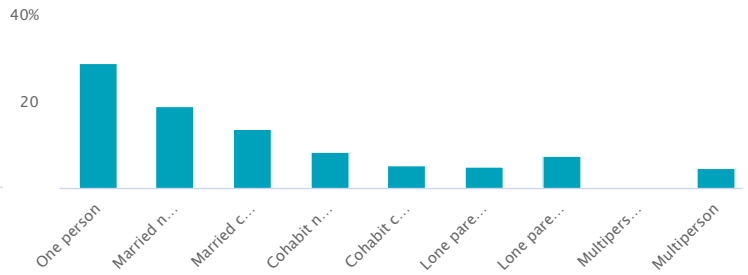

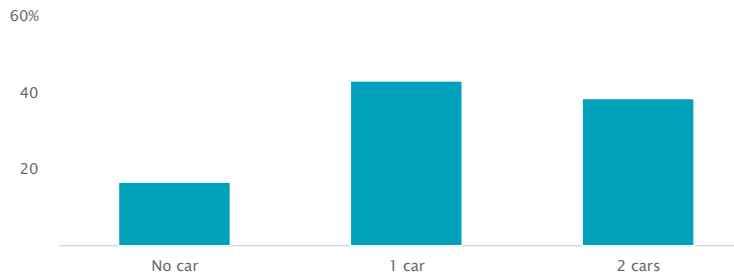

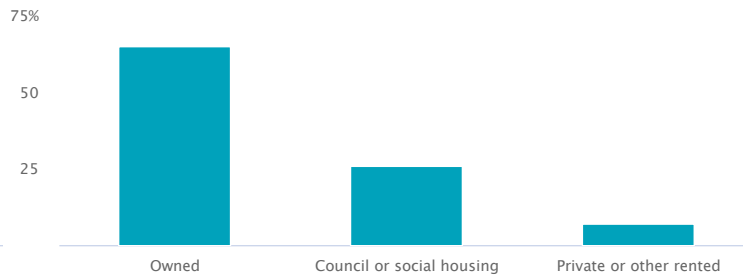

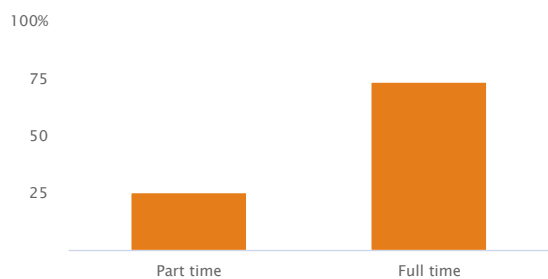

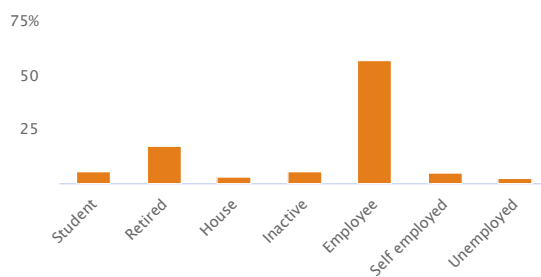
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



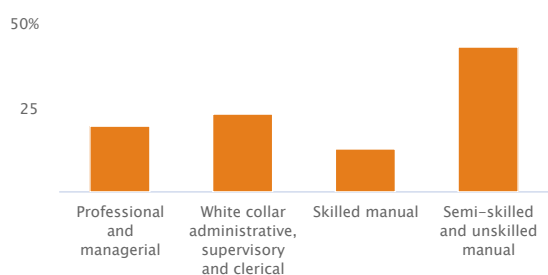
## Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

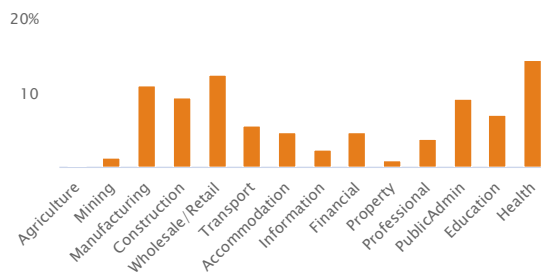


## Social Grade

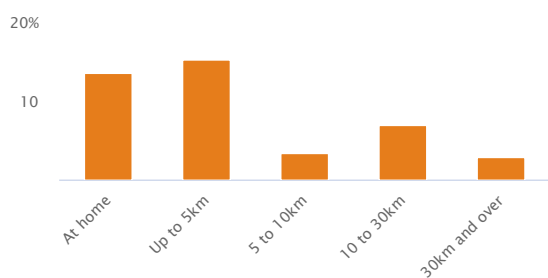
(% households aged 16-64)



## Sector Diversity

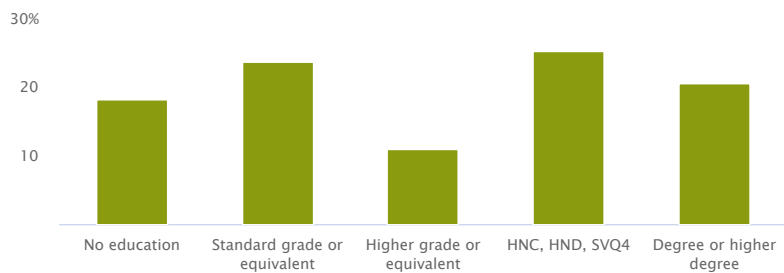


## Distance travelled to work

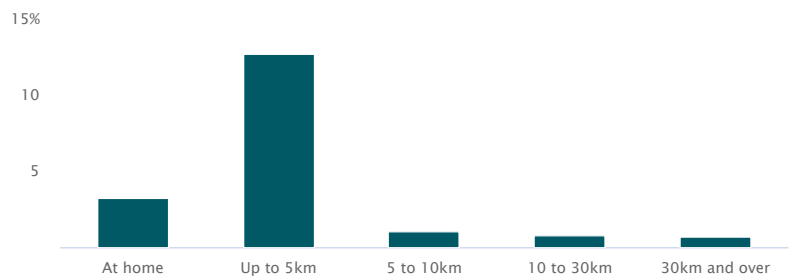
