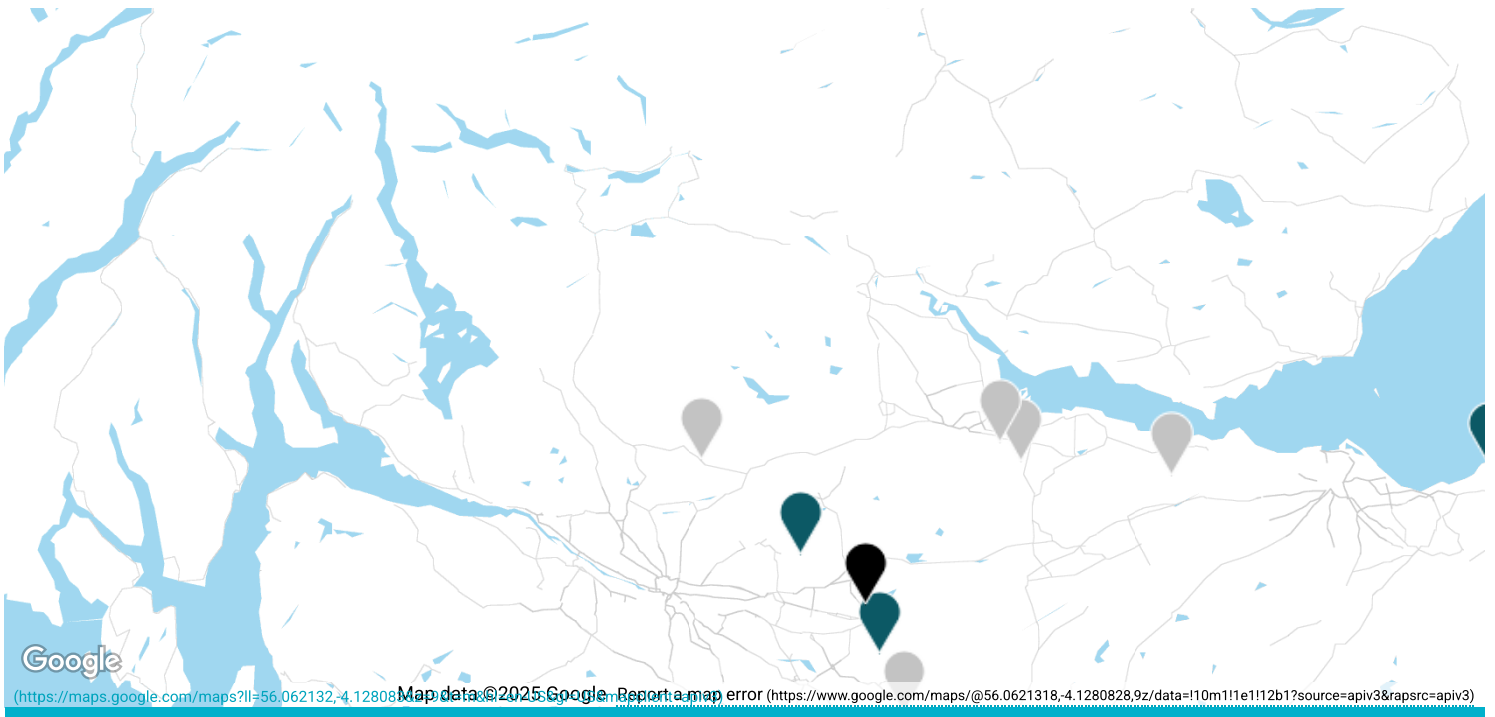




Chapelhall

Chapelhall is located in North Lanarkshire. It was formerly a mining settlement and had 3 blast furnaces. Increasingly it has become a suburb of Airdrie. The Eurocentral freight terminal is close to Chapelhall.

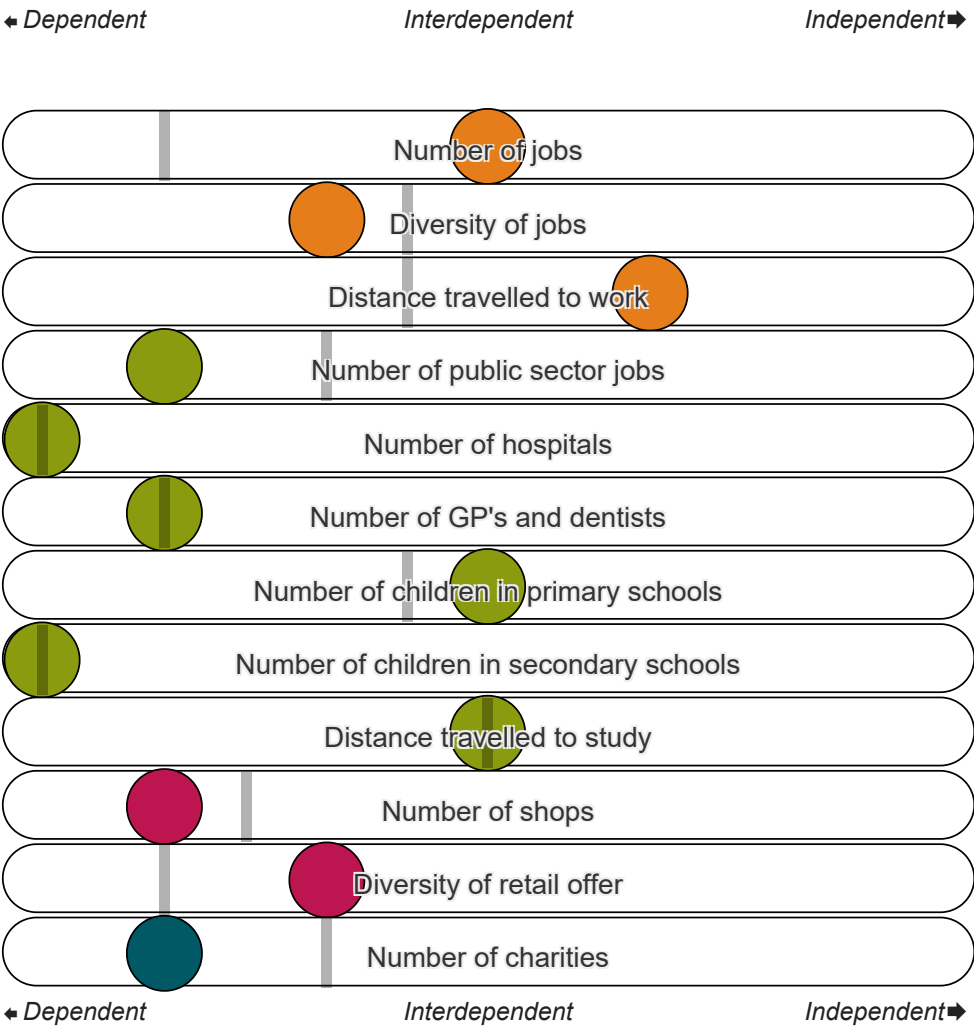
In this and similar medium towns, this population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Chapelhall is a dependent to interdependent town.

Chapelhall is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Chapelhall is grouped with 10 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the distance travelled to work. Chapelhall differs most from its group in the number of jobs.

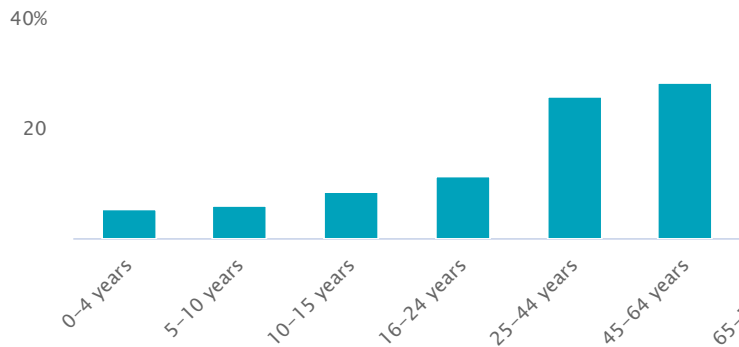

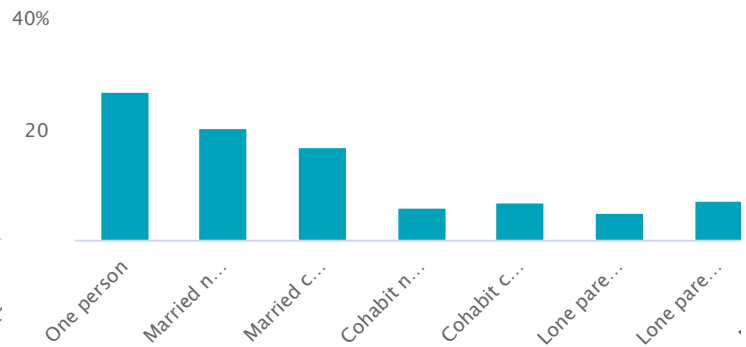

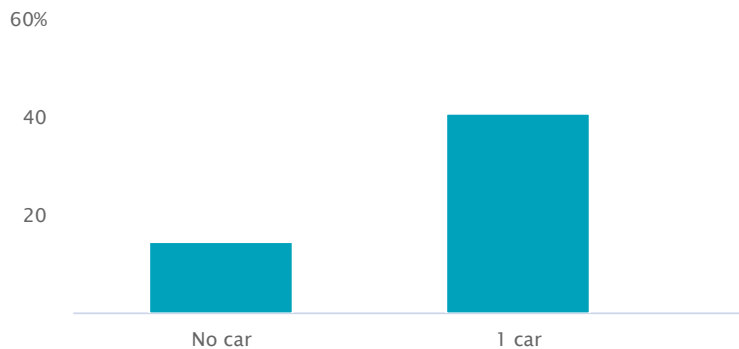

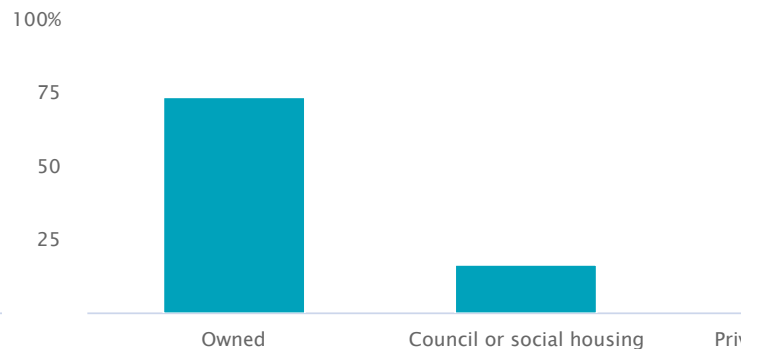

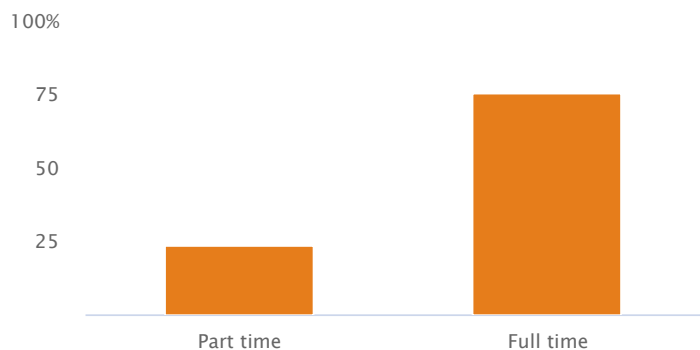

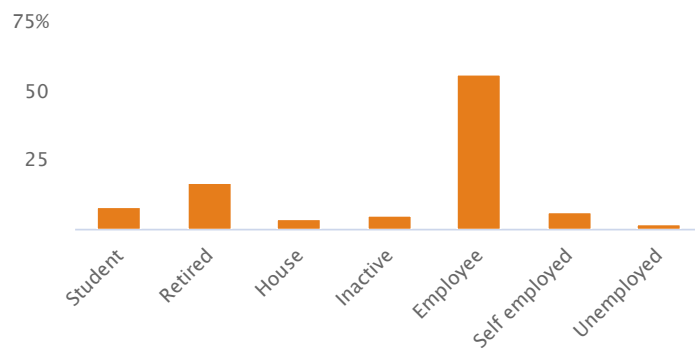
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



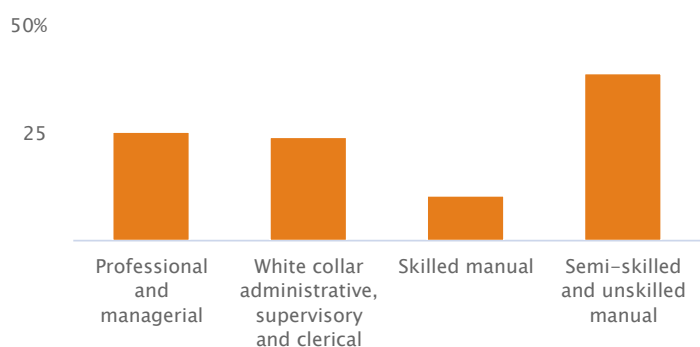
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

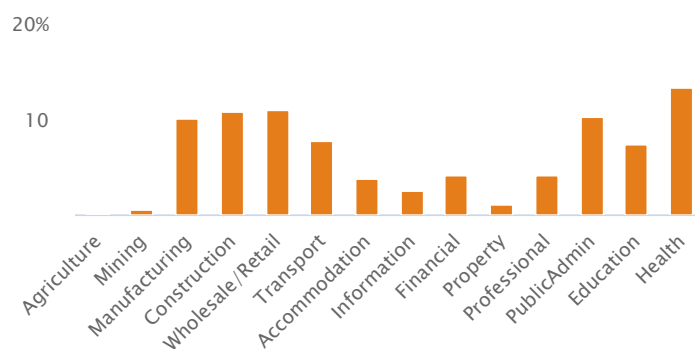


Social Grade

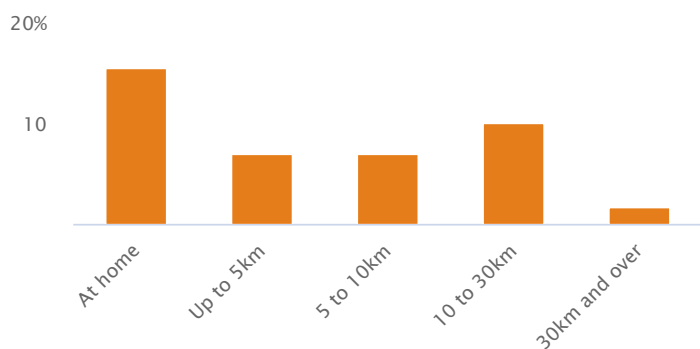
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

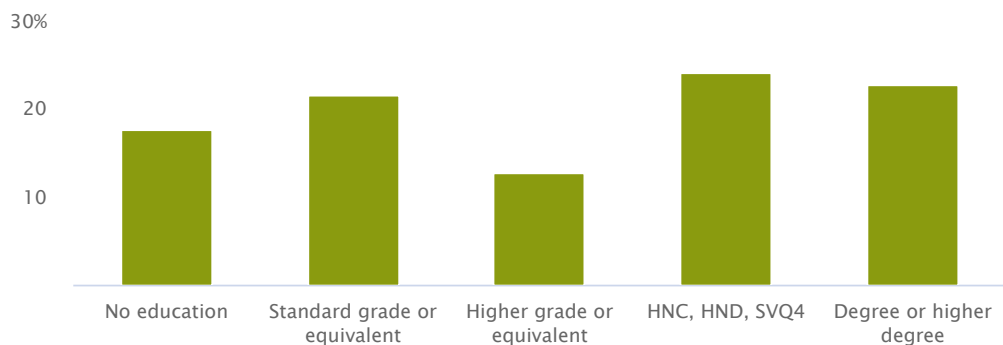


Distance travelled to work

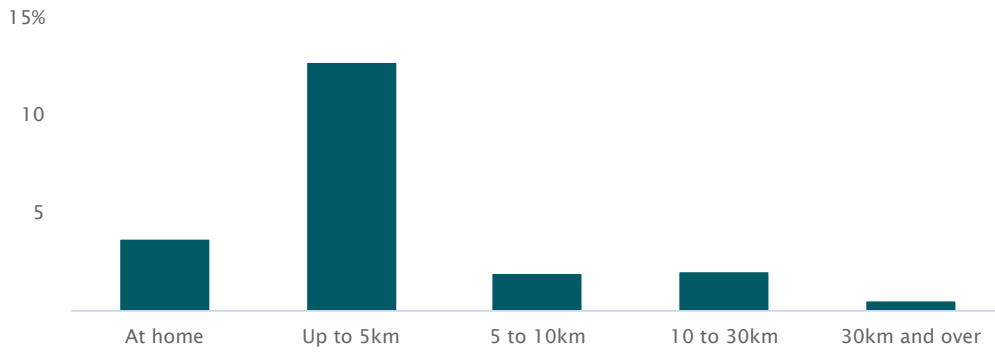
