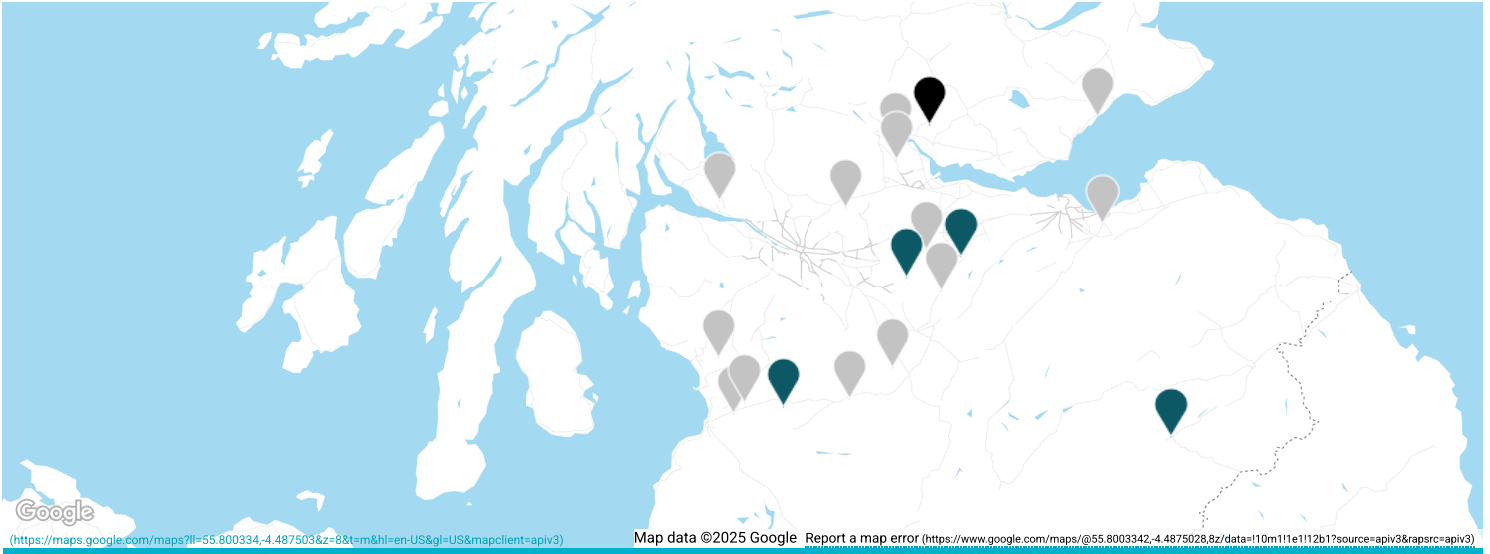




Coalsnaughton

Coalsnaughton is in Clackmannanshire. It was a mining settlement with brick production. It remains a residential village with a few local businesses. Some new affordable/social housing has been built. Local jobs are in Tillicoultry, Menstrie and Alloa.

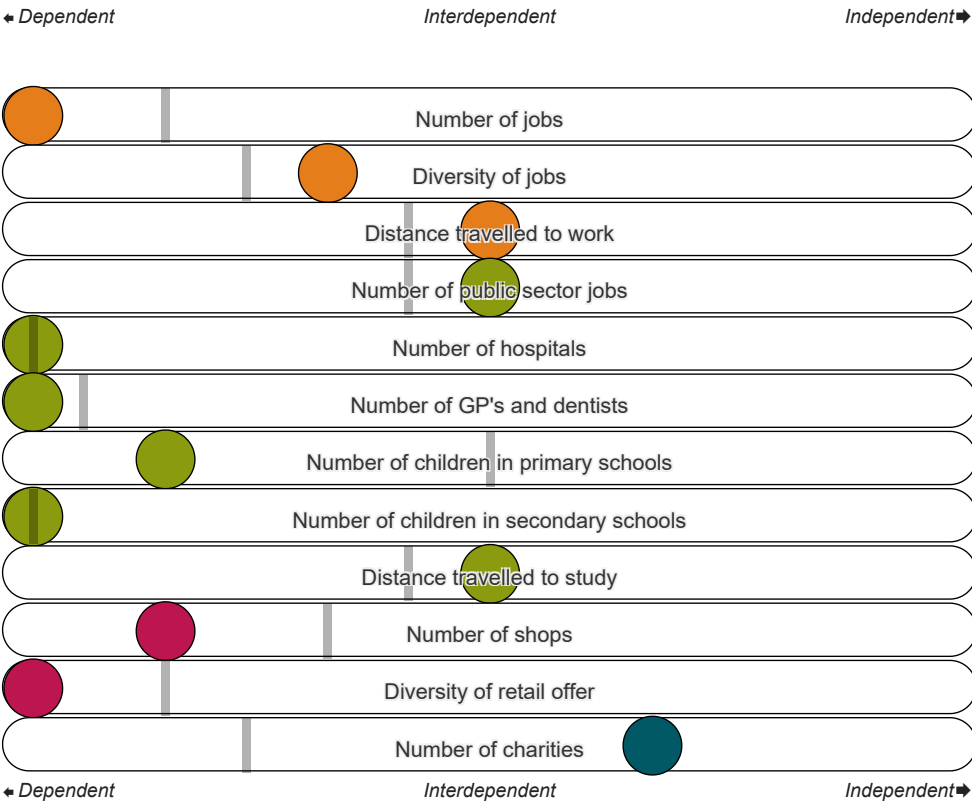
In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Coalsnaughton is a dependent to interdependent town.

Coalsnaughton is a **dependent to interdependent** town.

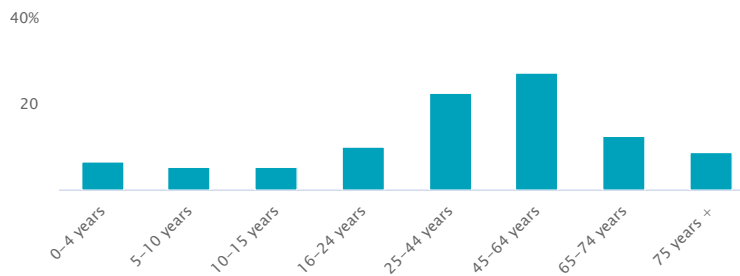
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Coalsnaughton is grouped with 17 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of charities. Coalsnaughton differs most from its group in the number of children in primary schools.

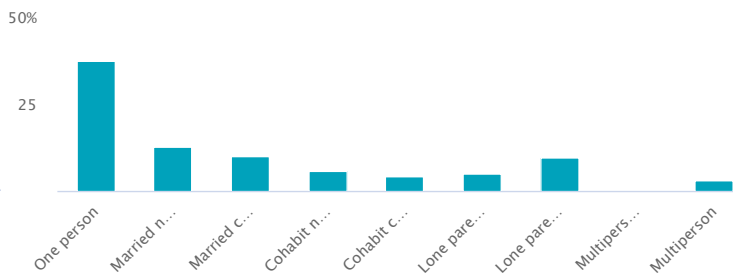

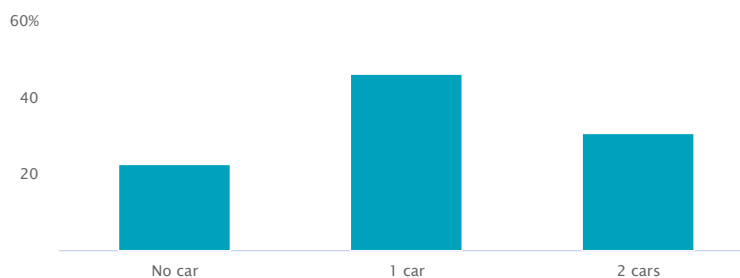

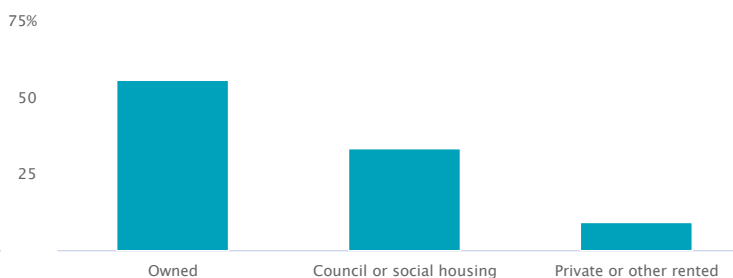
Household composition

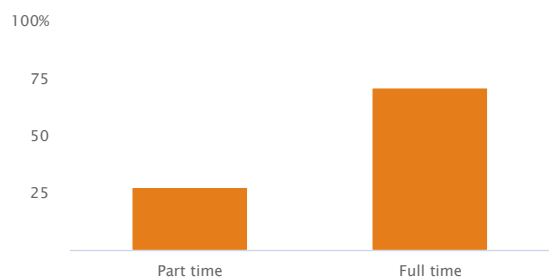

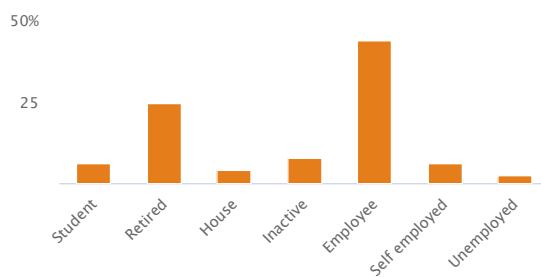
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



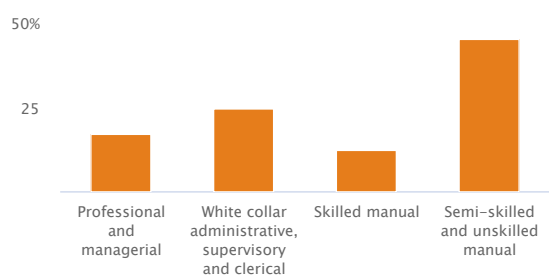
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

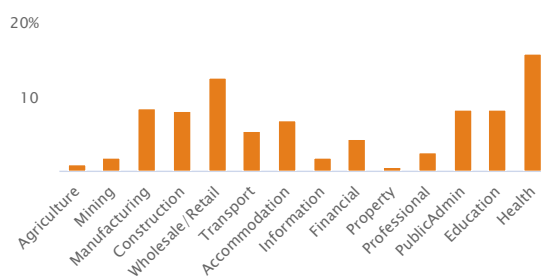

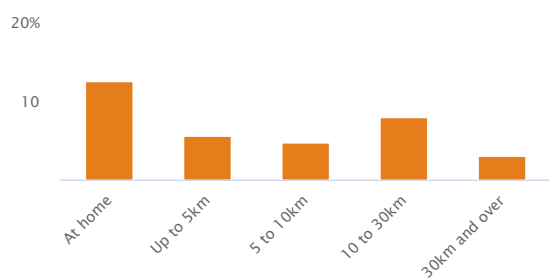
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

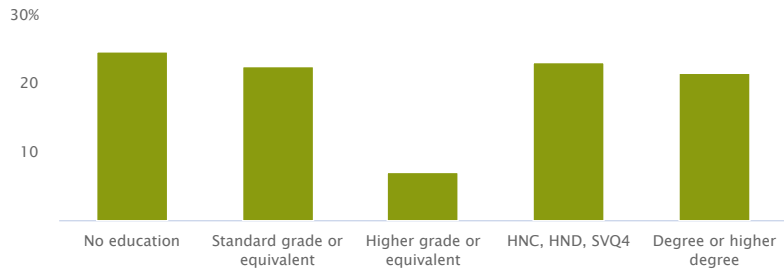


Distance travelled to work

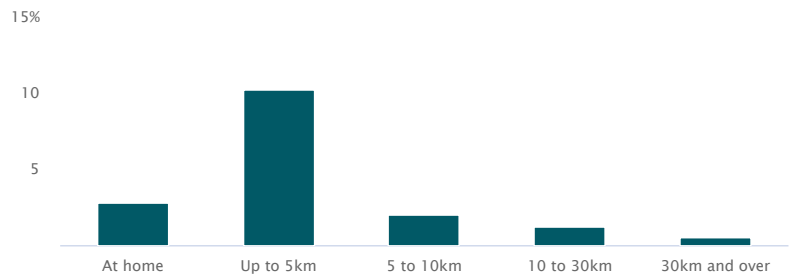
