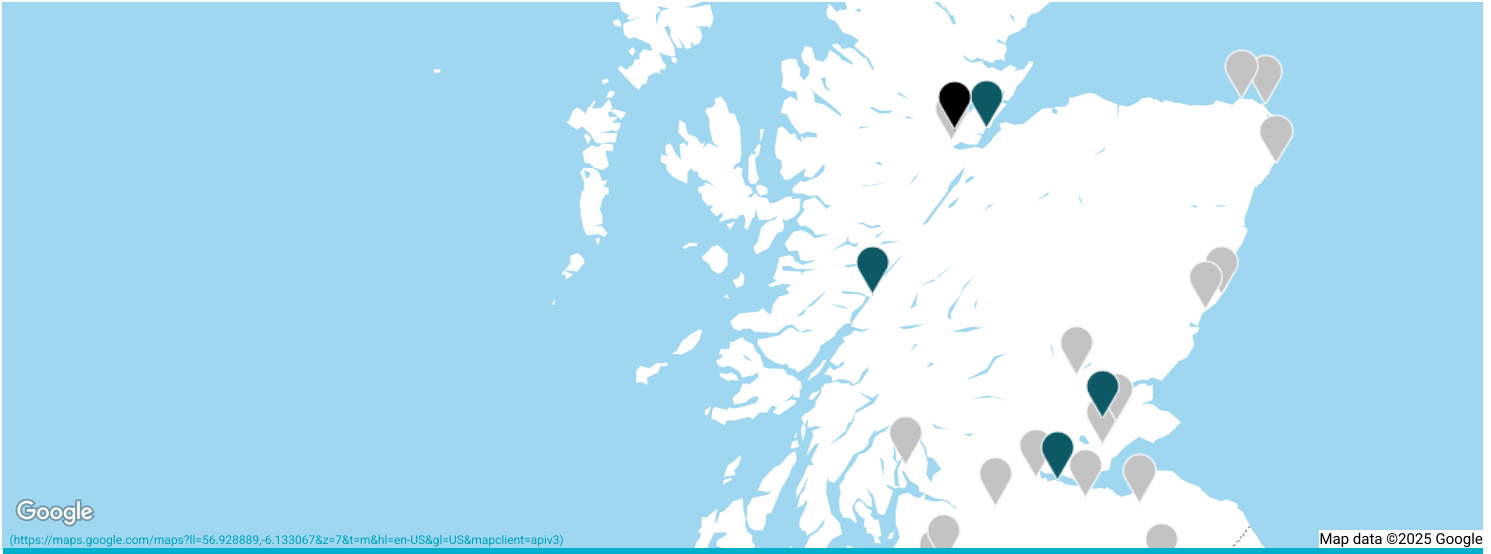




Conon Bridge

Cononbridge is in Easter Ross are in Highland. The vilalge pre-existed thye bridge built by Telford.. In the 20th century local trades were boosted by the development of a naval base. The town's accessibility, including the re-opened station, has encouraged commuters to live in the town.

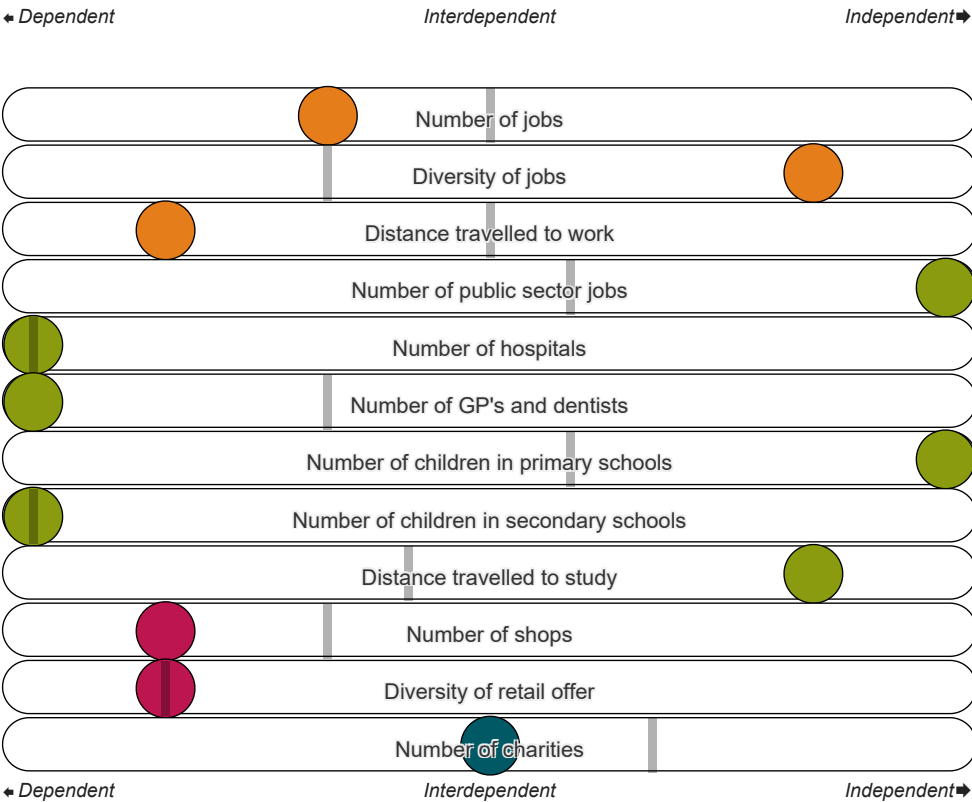
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Conon Bridge is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

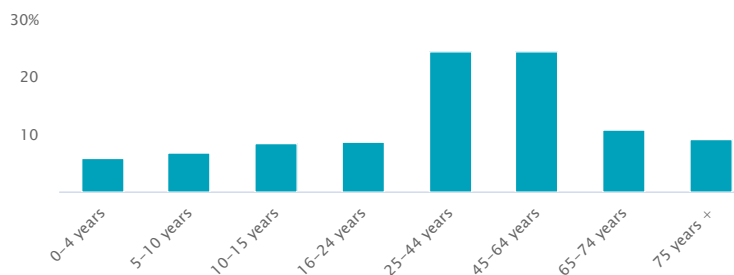
Combining inter-relationships and typology, Conon Bridge is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs, the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study. Conon Bridge differs most from its group in the number of GP's and dentists.

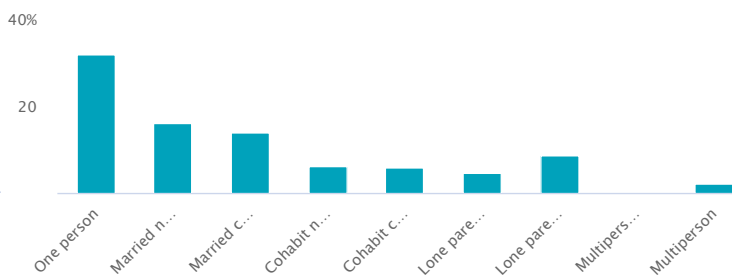

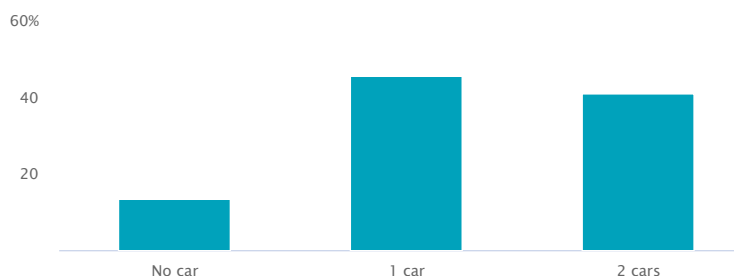

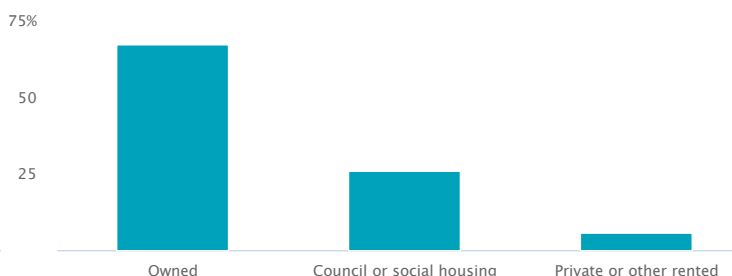
Household composition

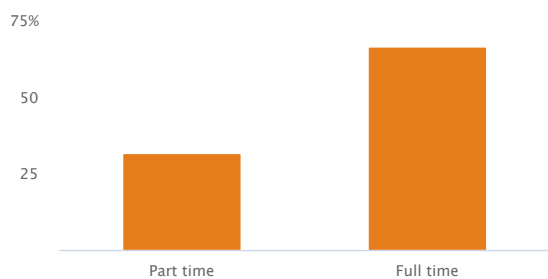

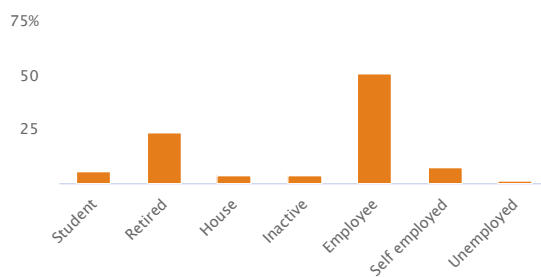
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



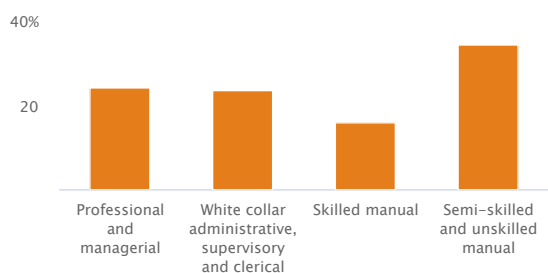
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

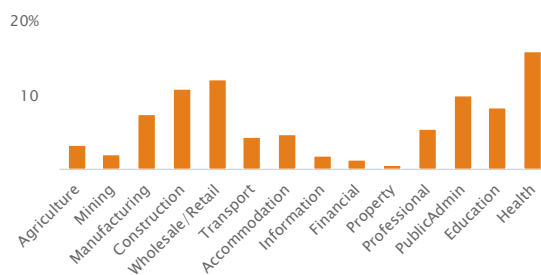

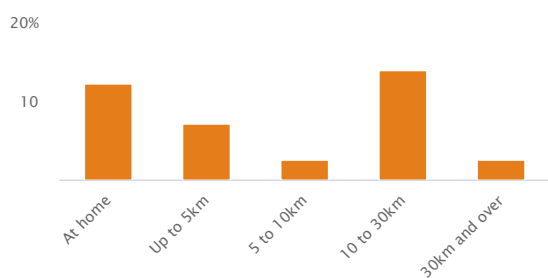
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

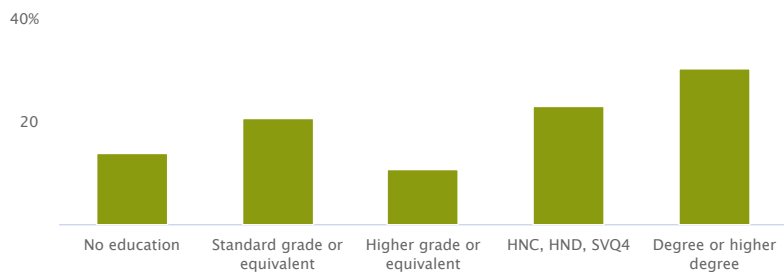


Distance travelled to work

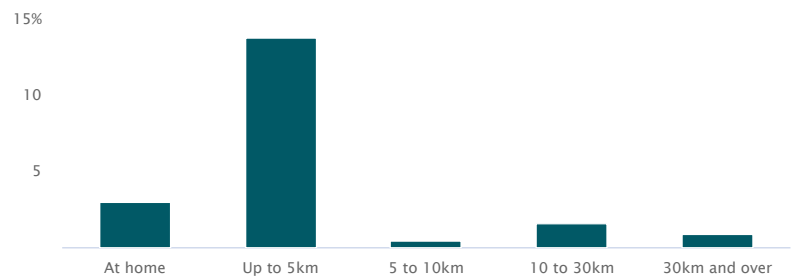
