Countesswells has emerged since 2014 as a greenfield suburban town in an agricultural area close to Aberdeen. There is a variety if new housing and building is ongoing.


In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Its most similar towns are Blairhall, Dunipace, East Whitburn, and Greenhill.










#### **Social Grade**

(% households aged 16-64)




#### **Sector Diversity**






