Crail in the East Neuk of Fife was an early burgh. It was known for its harbour and fishing trade. Today it is popular with tourists and as a retirement town


In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.






