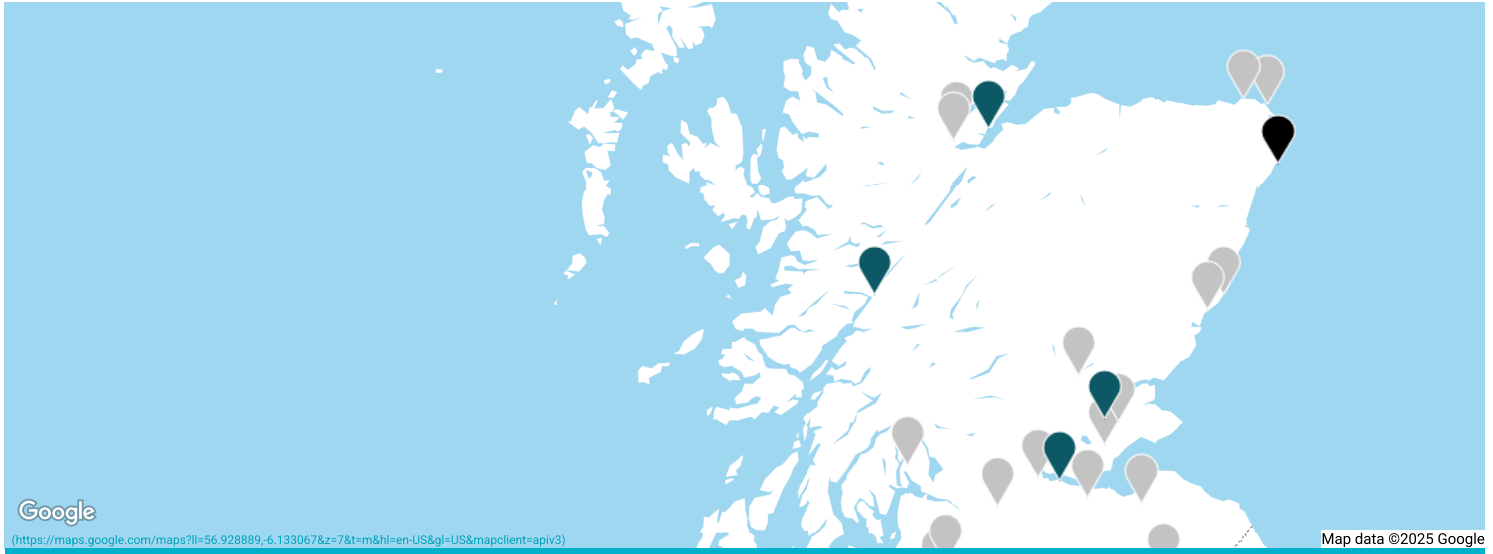




Cruden Bay

Cruden Bay is located on the Buchan coast in Aberdeenshire. The Danes are reported to have been defeated here. In the 1920s it was a holiday resort but after a period of decline the town was reinvigorated as a commuting settlement with the oil boom.

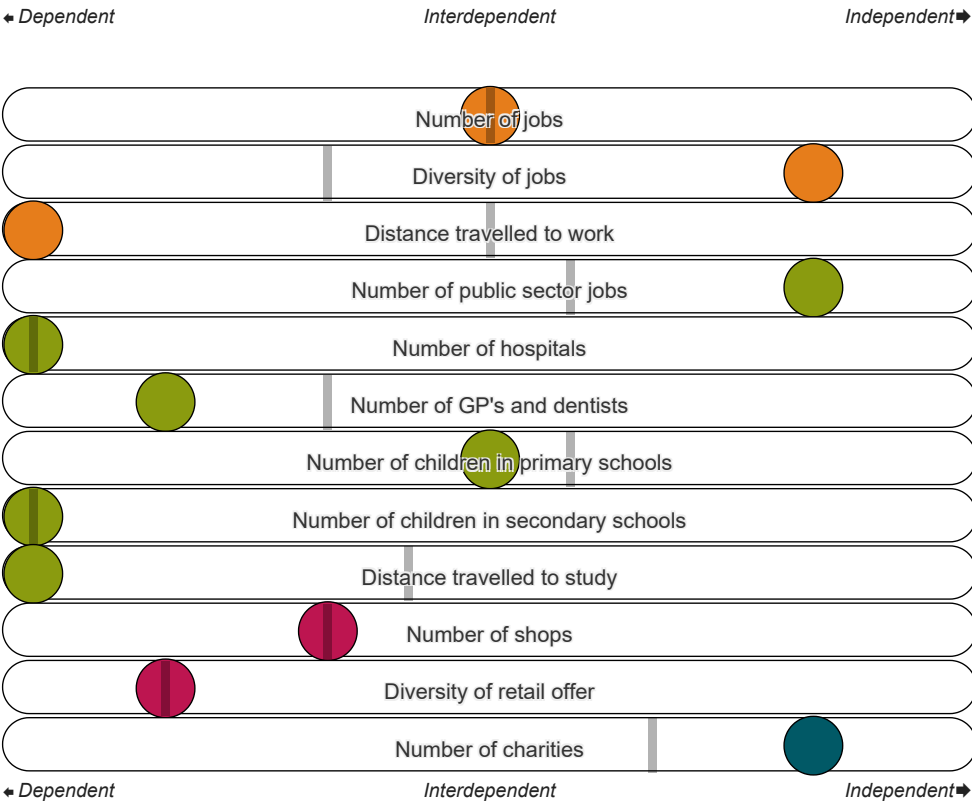
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Cruden Bay is an interdependent to dependent town.

Cruden Bay is an **interdependent to dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Cruden Bay is grouped with 22 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the diversity of jobs. Cruden Bay differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work, and the distance travelled to study.

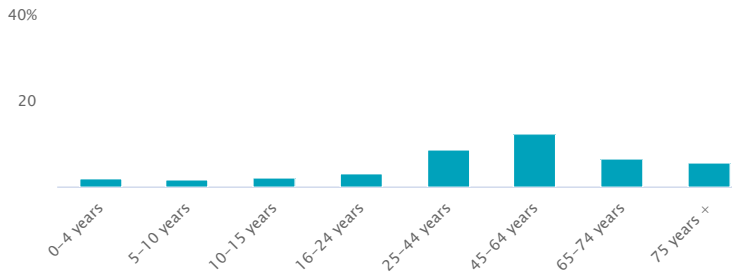

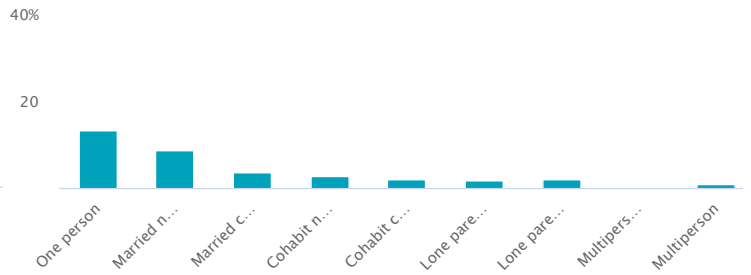

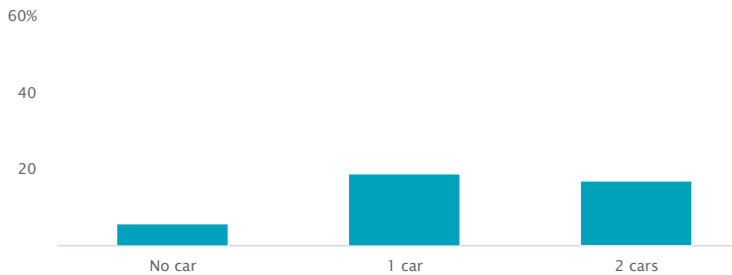

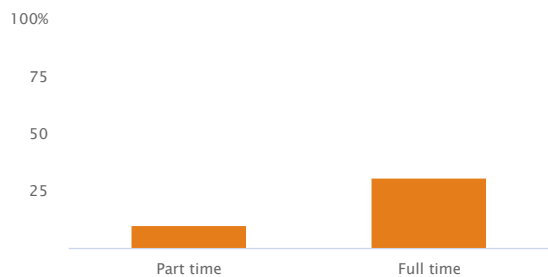

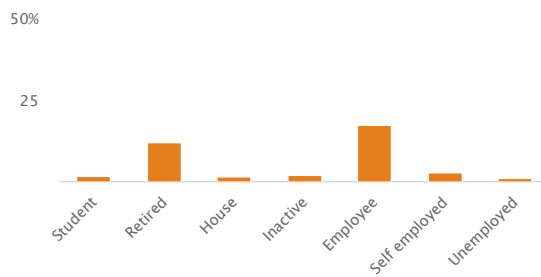
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



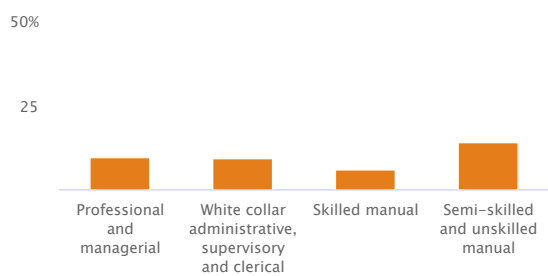
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

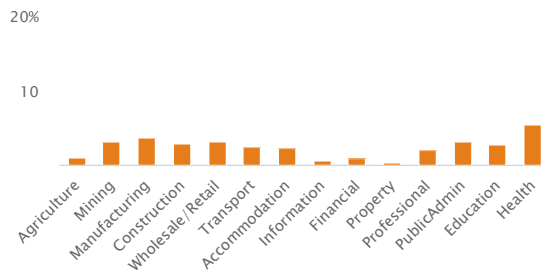

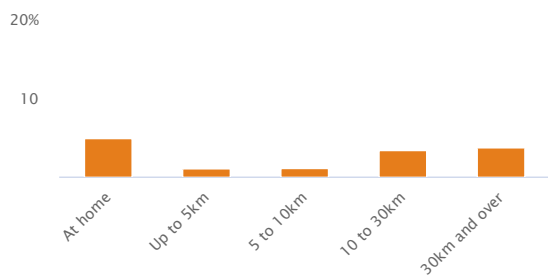
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

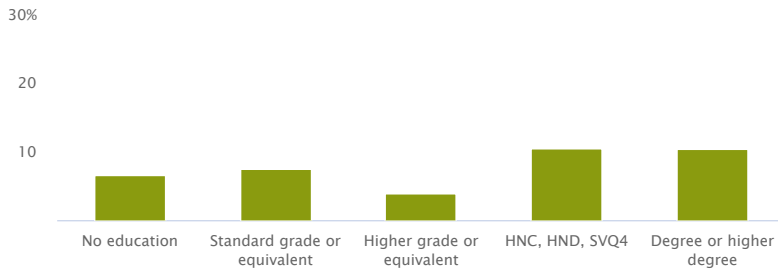


Distance travelled to work

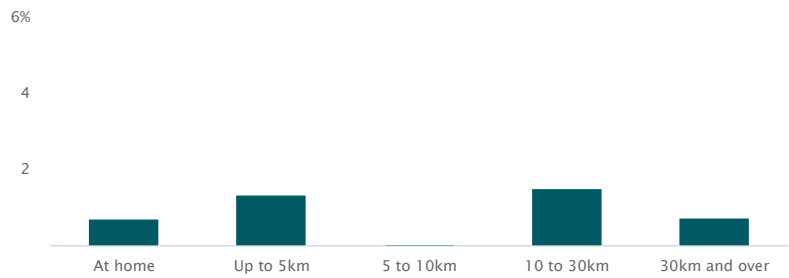
