#### POPULATION 8,825

Cumnock in East Ayrshire is an ancient market town. In addition to weaving the town was known for its snuff box industry. Mining was important for a time but the open cast mine is now closed. In the 20th century shoes, spinning, carpets and knitwear made up its manufacturing base. Today these have been replaced by food industries (Caledoninan Bottlers), animal feeds and fire and rescue vehicles (Emergency One).


In this medium town, population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Cumnock is an interdependent to independent town.

Its most similar towns are Alva, Anstruther, Blairgowrie, and Brechin.
















