Dalmellington and Burnton is an historic market town in East Ayrshire. Coal mining sustained the local economy from the 18th century until 1978. It had an important woollen industry making blankets and plaids and later carpets. The Scottish Dark Sky Observatory is located close to the town


In this, and similar small towns, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Dalmellington is an interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Leslie, and Sanquhar.

Dalmellington is an interdependent town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Dalmellington is grouped with 2 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, jobs, shops, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled

It differs in terms of the number of children in secondary schools, public sector jobs, and GP's and dentists. Dalmellington differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.


Population change 2011 to 2022




Employment type




