Dalrymple is located in East Ayrshire. It dates from the early 1800s. It was sutsained by coal mining and in the late 20th century new council housing was built to house families from areas where mining had declined.


In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.










Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






