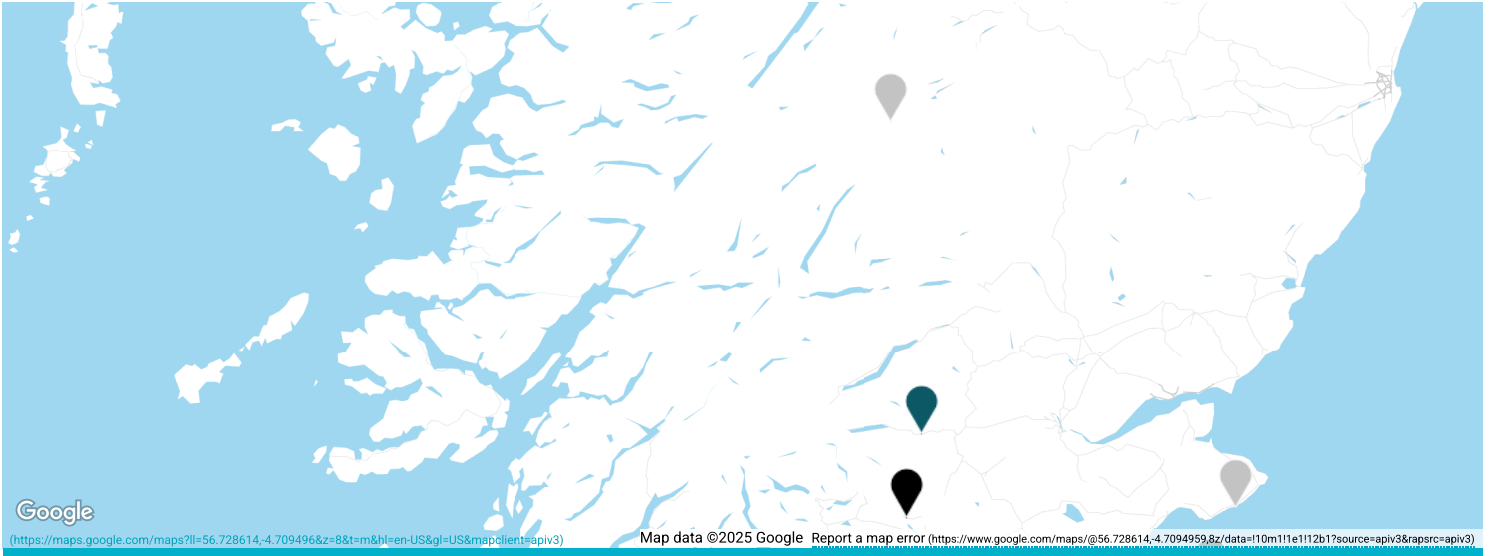

Doune in Stirling Council is an historic town built next to Doune Castle. It is primarily a commuter town today but historically was famed for the production of pistols.

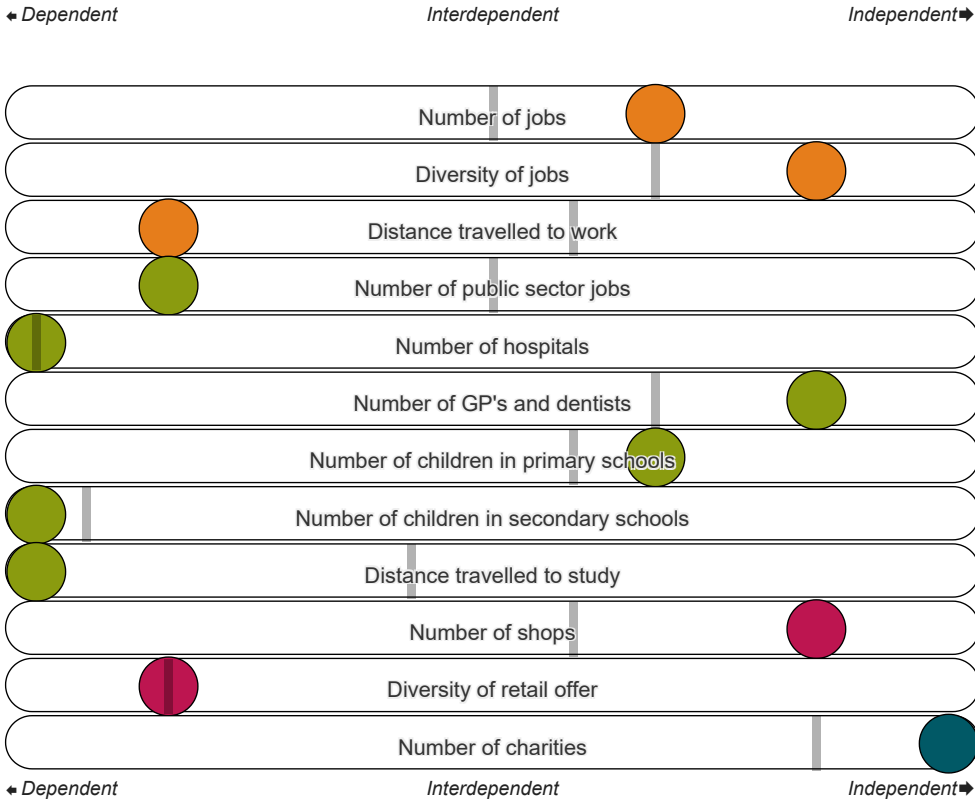
In this and similar small towns, the population is commonly older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Doune is an interdependent town.

Doune is an **interdependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Doune is grouped with 8 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

It differs in terms of the number of public sector jobs. It also differs in the distance travelled to work. Doune differs most from its group in the distance travelled to study.

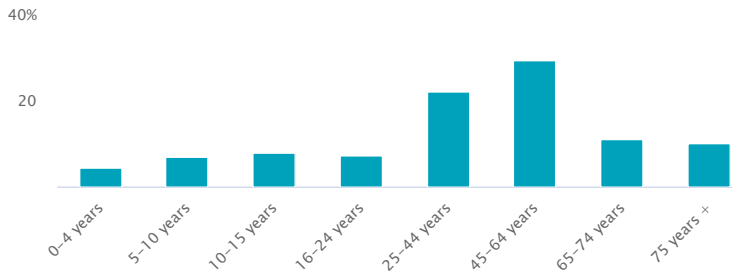

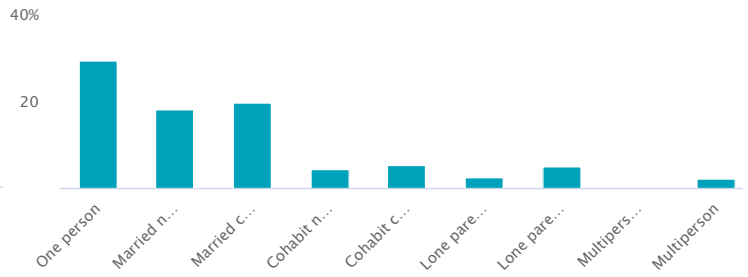

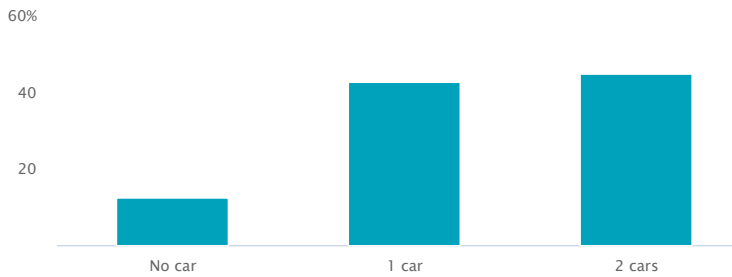

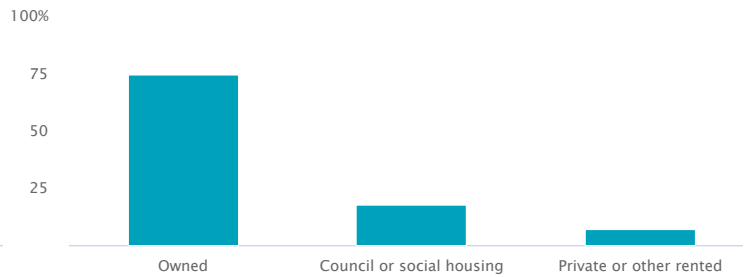

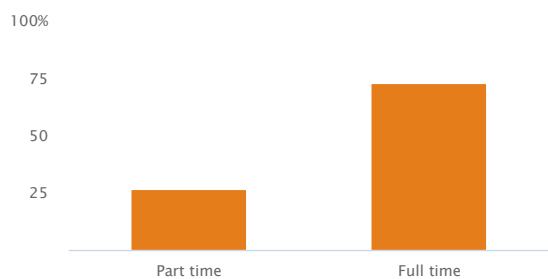

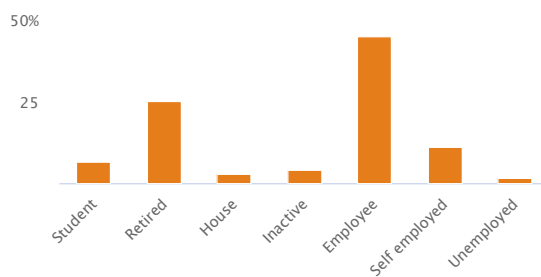
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



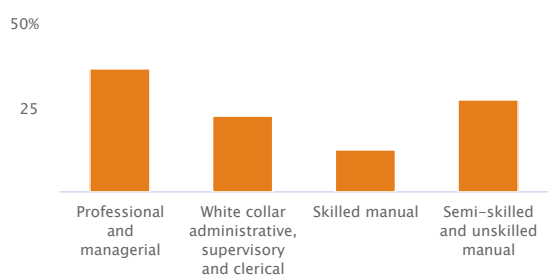
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

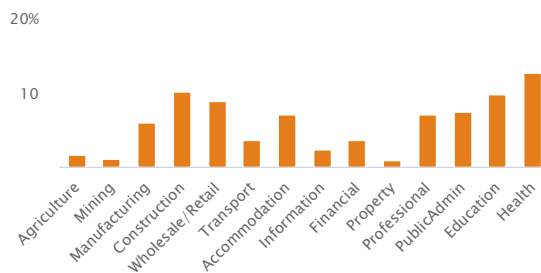

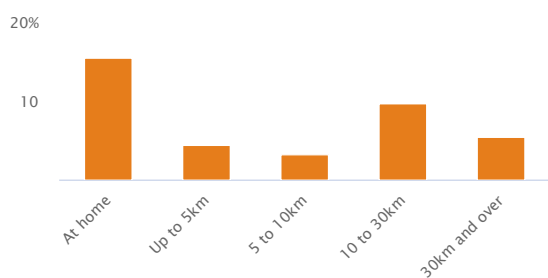
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

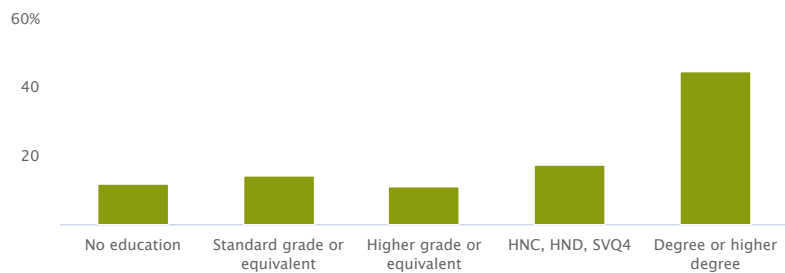


Distance travelled to work

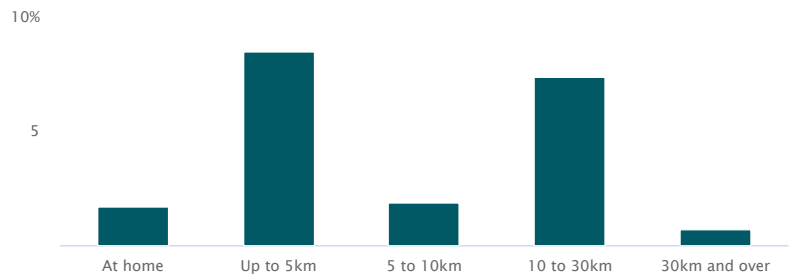
