Dreghorn in North Ayrshire is an ancient site occupied since Neolithic times. The town developed as a coal mining town in the 19th century and lasted until the 1980s. New estates have been developed on the site of the former mines. Since the 1980s many residents have had to commute to jobs elsewhere.


In this medium town, population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Dreghorn is an interdependent to dependent town.

Its most similar towns are Beith, Burntisland, Dalry, and Gretna.






#### **Employment type**

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




#### **Social Grade**

(% households aged 16-64)




#### Distance travelled to work






