Drongan in East Ayrshire was a rural settlement until the development of coal mining from 1900. It was a town where miners were resettled in new public housing from surrounding areas in the 1950s. Local employment is in service industries.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Drongan is an interdependent to dependent town.

Its most similar towns are Auchinleck, Blackburn (West Lothian), Cardenden and Auchterderran, and Kilbirnie.






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






