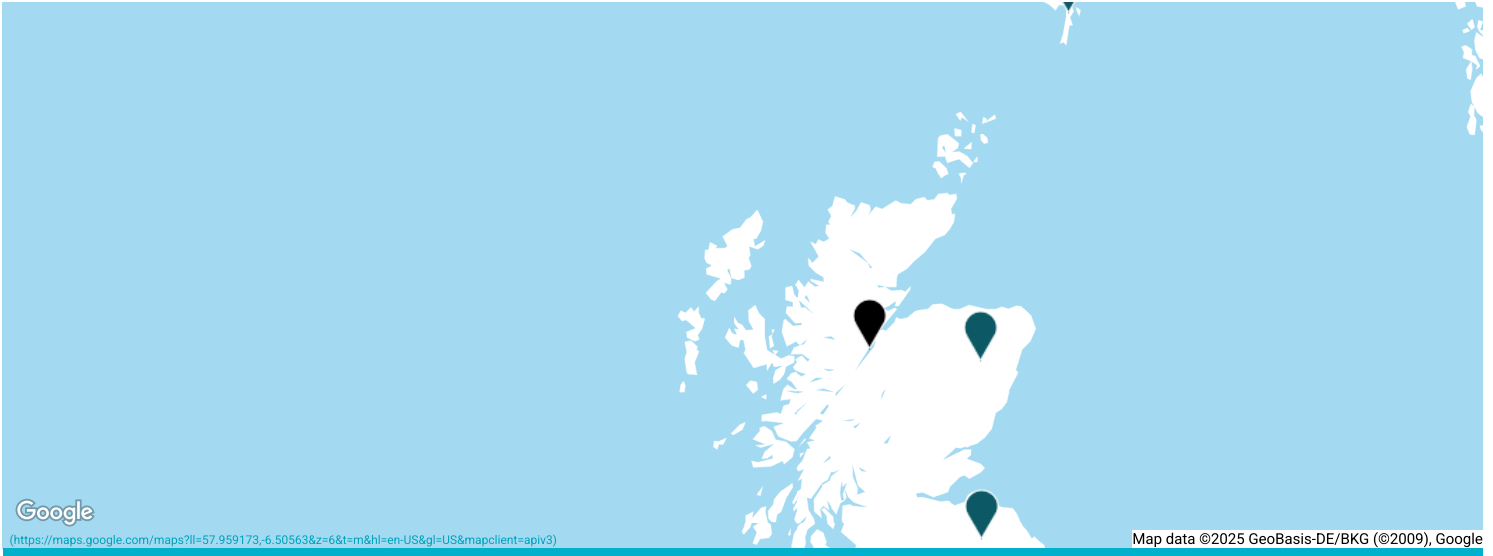




Drumnadrochit

Drumnadrochit in Highland is a tourist centre for the Loch Ness.

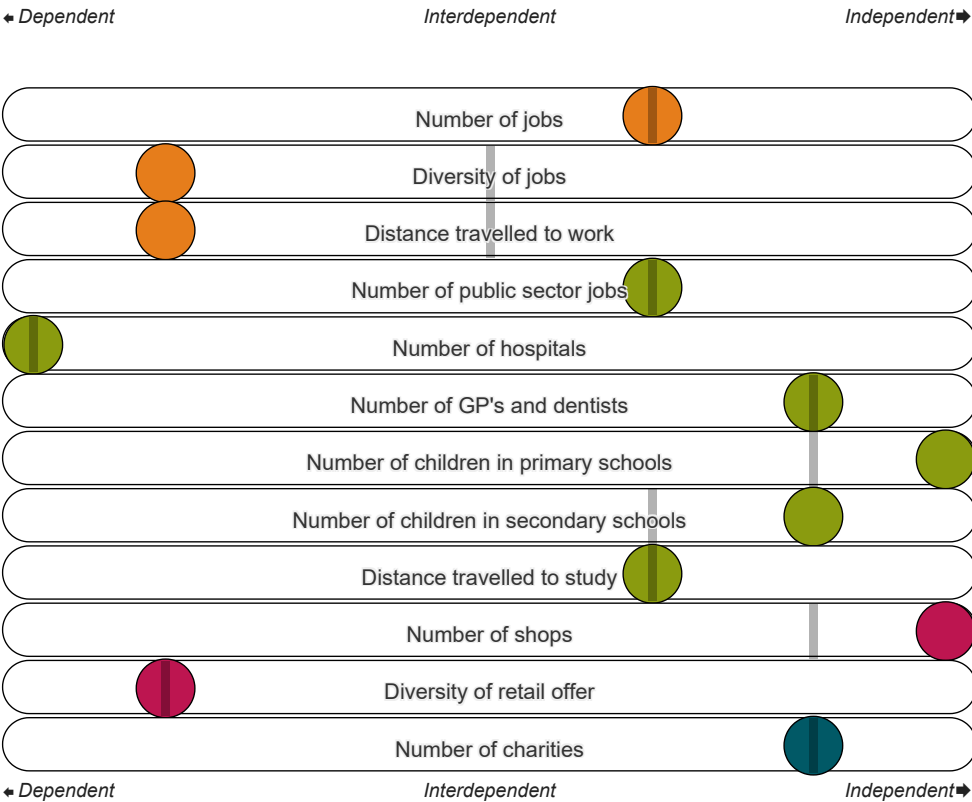
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Inter-relationships



Drumnadrochit is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Drumnadrochit is grouped with 3 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in primary schools, children in secondary schools, jobs, public sector jobs, GP's and dentists, and diversity of retail offer. It also has similarities in the distance travelled to study.

Drumnadrochit differs most from its group in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to work.

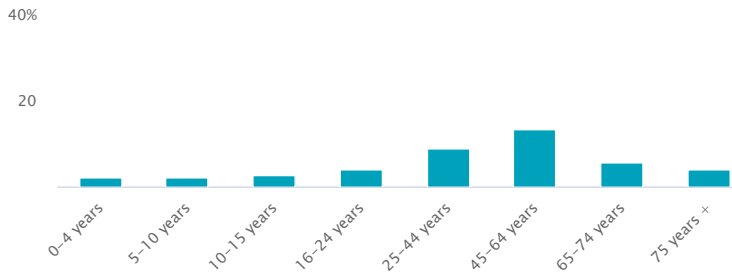

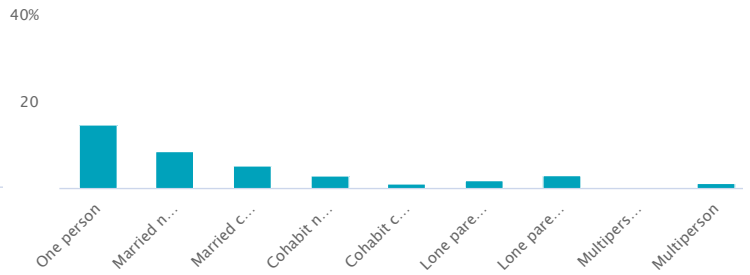

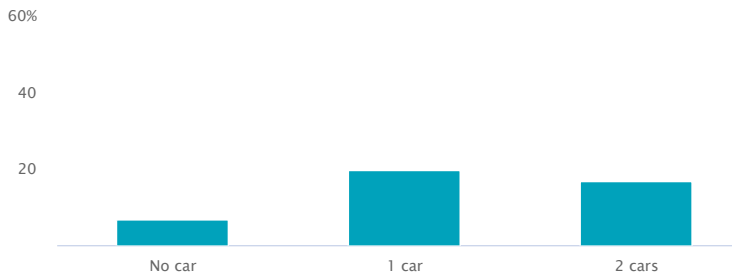

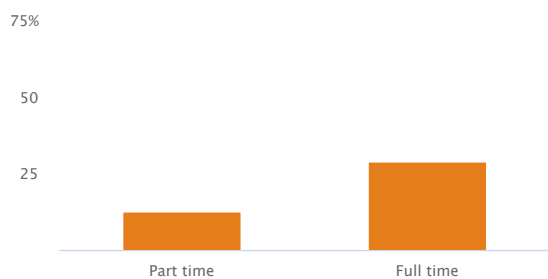

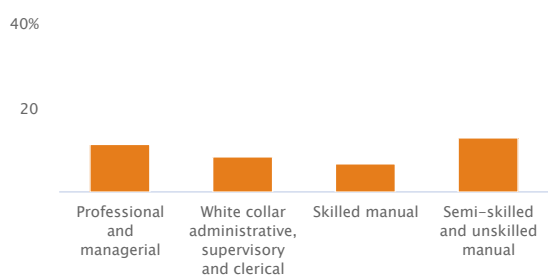
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



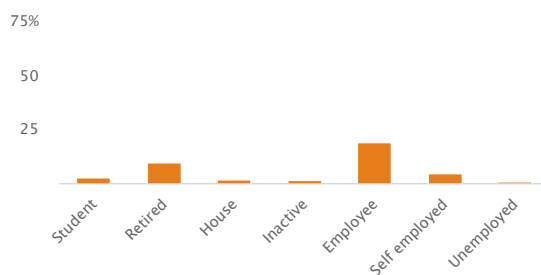
Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)

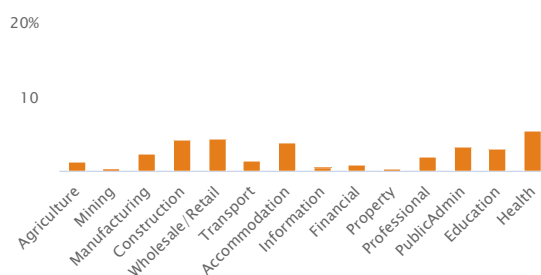

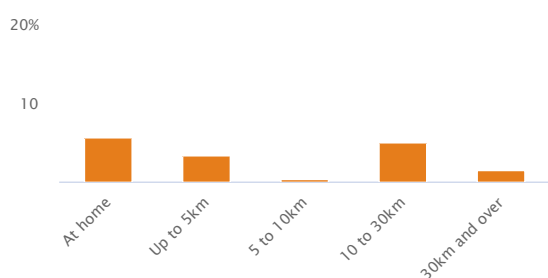

Sector Diversity

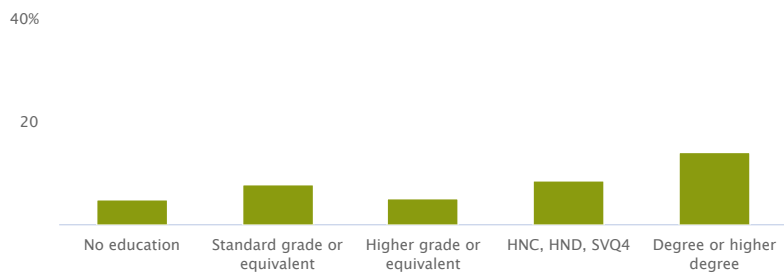


Distance travelled to work

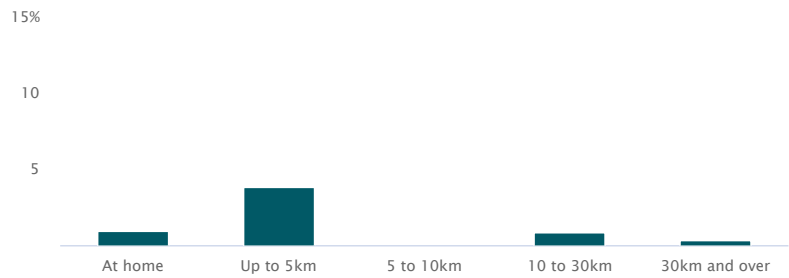
