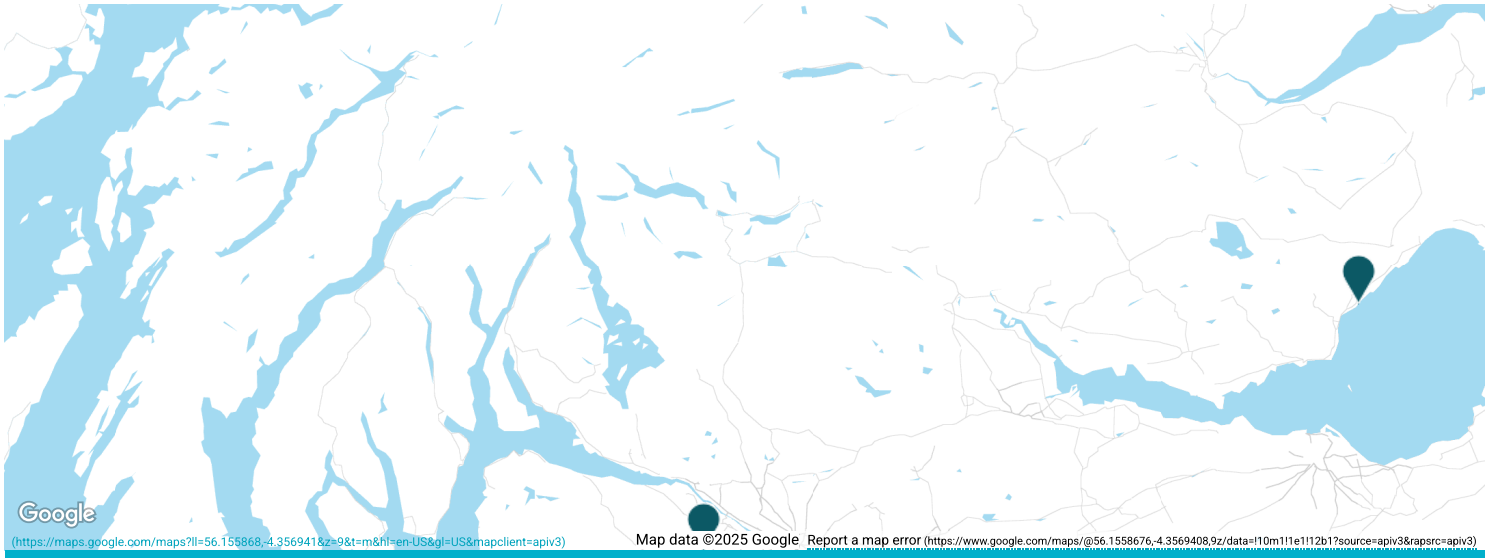

Dundee in Dundee City Council area is the town of jam, jute and journalism reflecting the importance of the port in importing jute, marmalade making and DC Thompson, the publishing magnate whose publications include the comic The Beano. Its strapline 'City of Discovery' or now 'One City, Many Discoveries' spans its Antarctic explorations of the past and the biomedical research of the present. It is home to the new V&A gallery. It became UNESCO City of Design in 2014. The digital entertainment sector is a key industry and for the city.

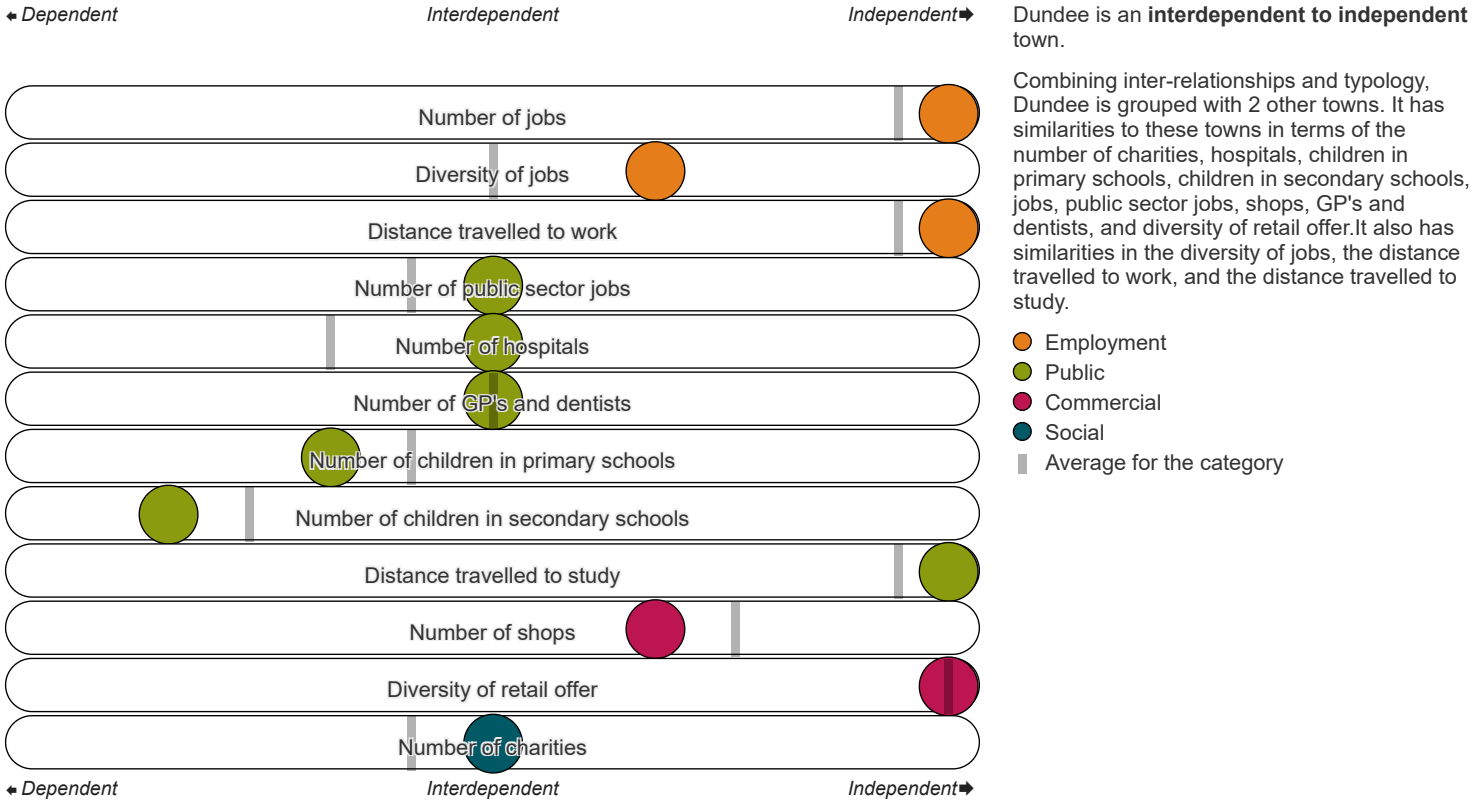
In this, and similar cities, this population includes older people, some still in work often in less well paid sectors. It also includes a significant inactive population, some in poorer health. There is a higher proportion of single households and car ownership is lower.

Population change 2011 to 2022**0%**

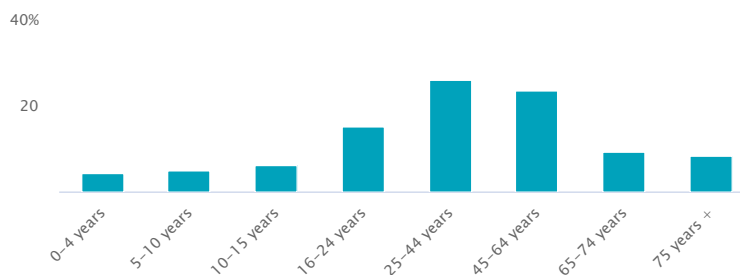

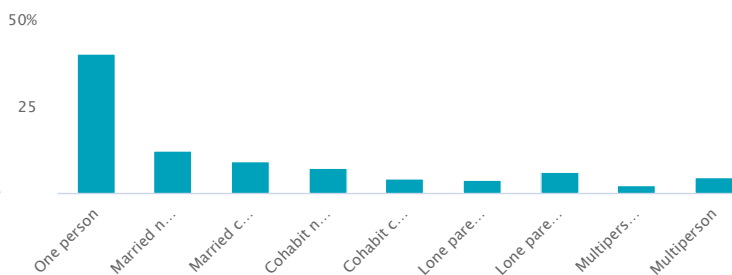

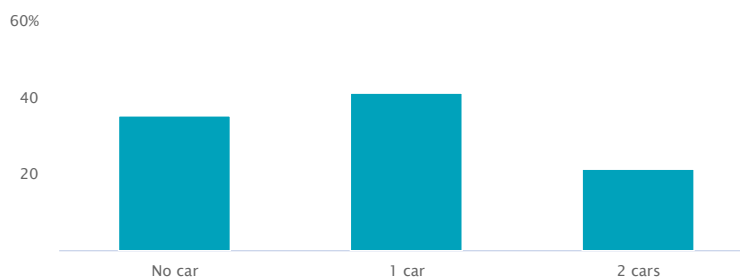

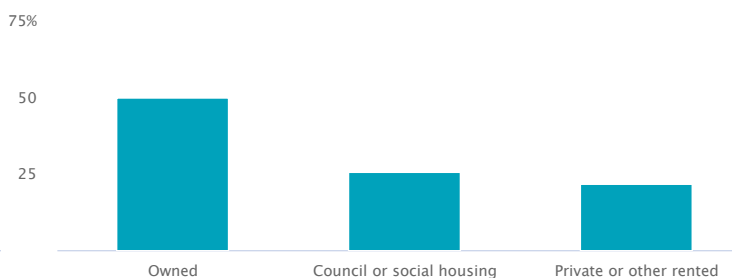

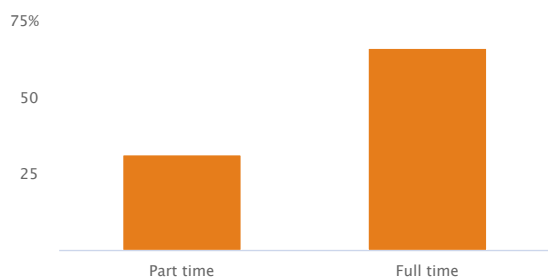

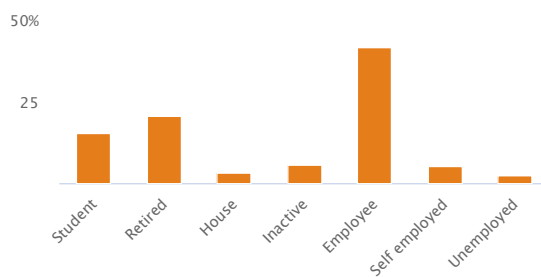
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



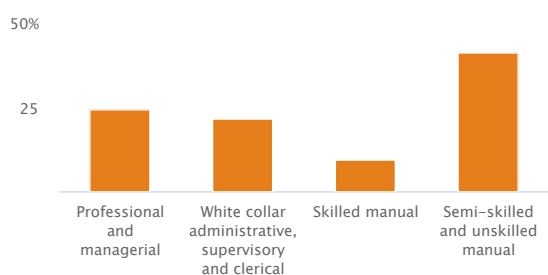
Occupation

Social Grade

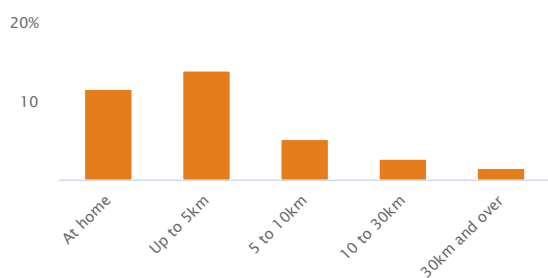
(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity

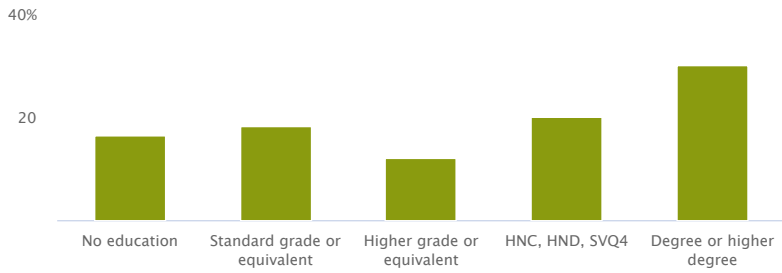


Distance travelled to work

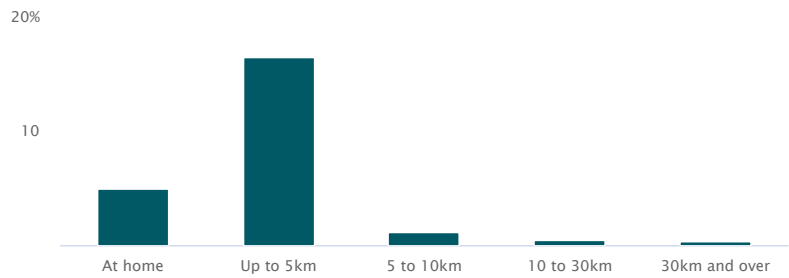
