Dunipace is located in Falkirk Council. Dunipace is close to Denny and has faced decline with the demise of industry in Denny.


In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.










### Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




### **Occupation**

(% aged 16-74)








