East Kilbride in South Lanarkshire was Scotland's first new town as part of the Clyde Valley planning development. It has seen a transition from manufacturing with Motorola and Rolls Royce plants to a more service/administrative oriented economy with the National Engineering Lab, HMRC and a section of the Department for International Development.

In cities like this, this group comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

East Kilbride is an interdependent to independent town.












Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Occupation

Social Grade


(% households aged 16-64)



Sector Diversity




Distance travelled to work


