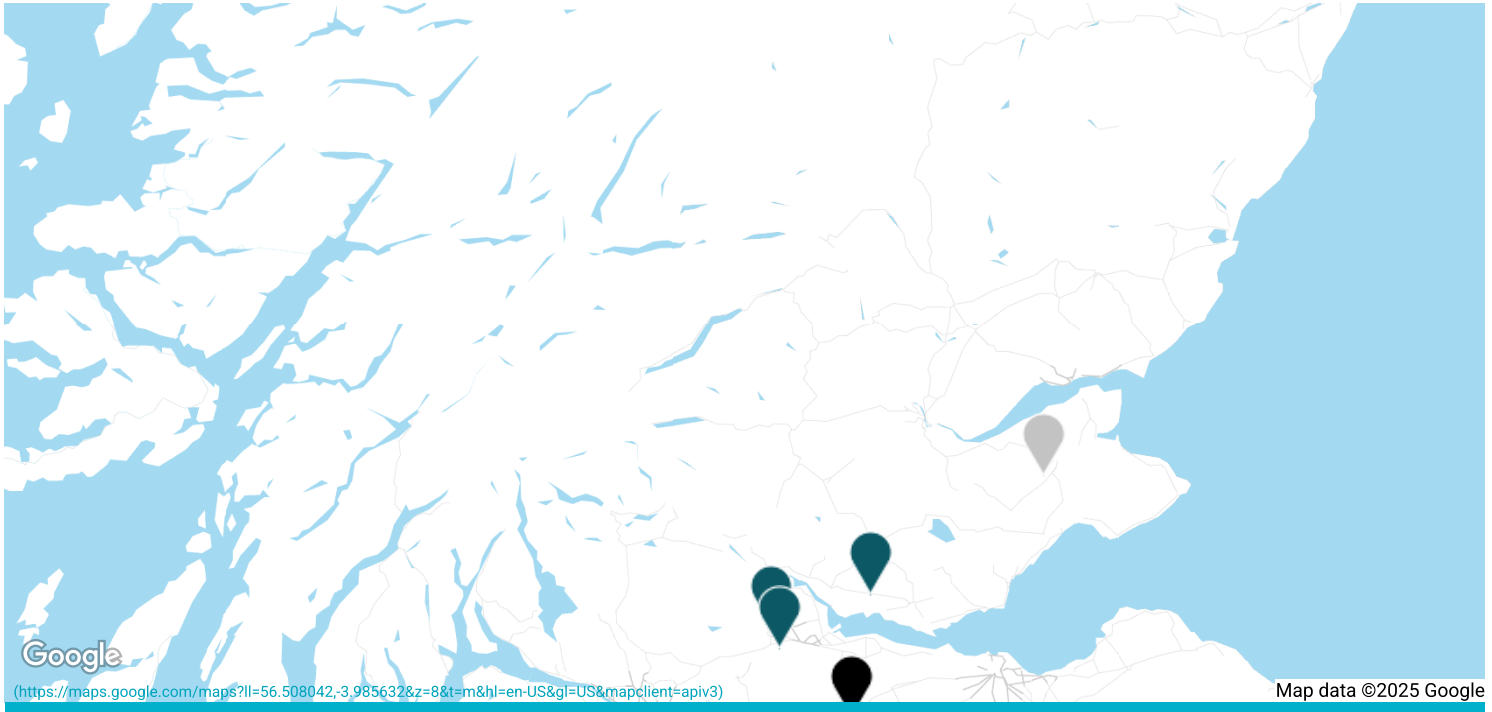




# East Whitburn

East Whitburn in West Lothian is essentially a suburb of Whitburn. It has seen much recent growth with new housing.

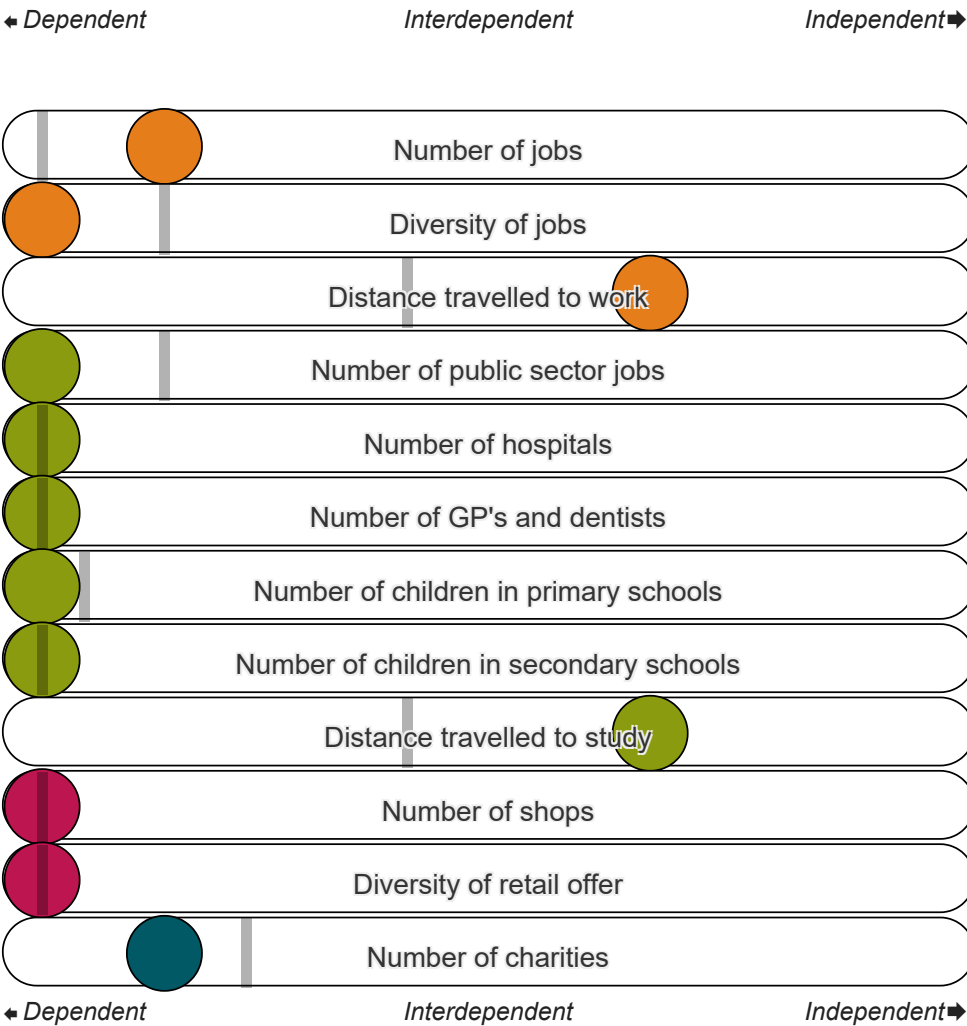
In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

East Whitburn is a **dependent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, East Whitburn is grouped with 5 other towns. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs.

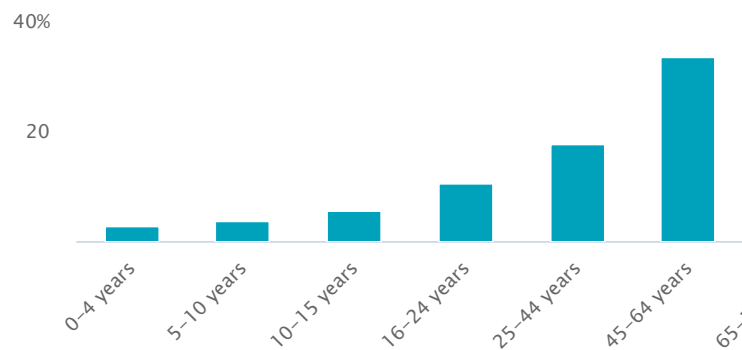

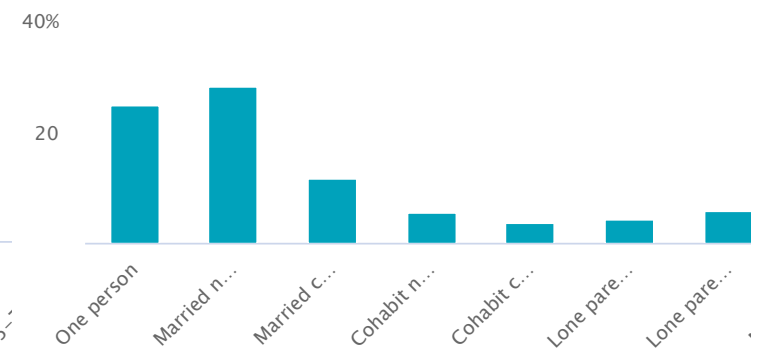

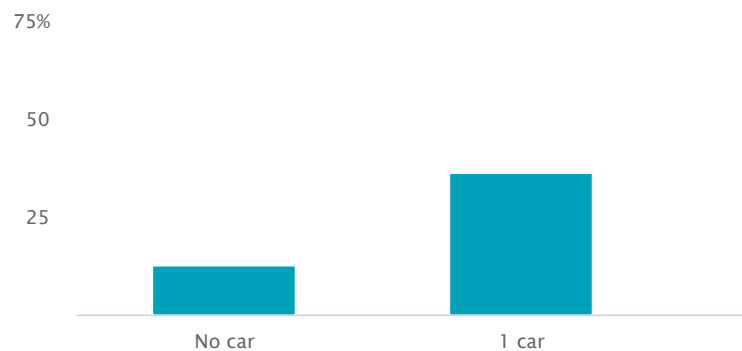

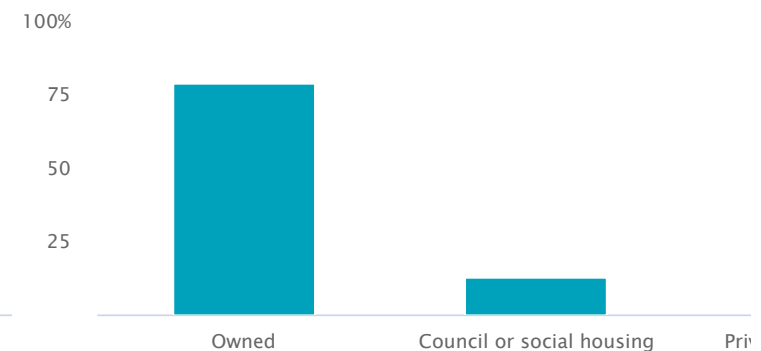

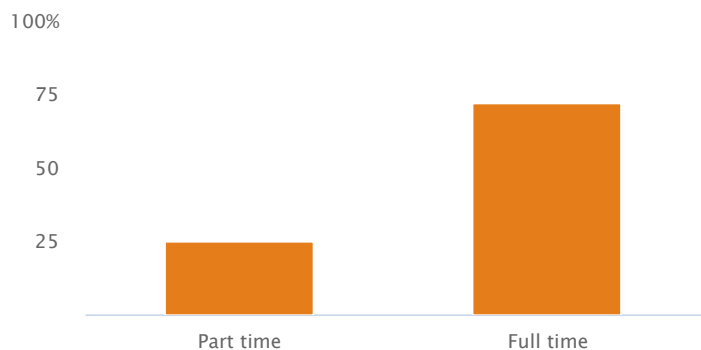

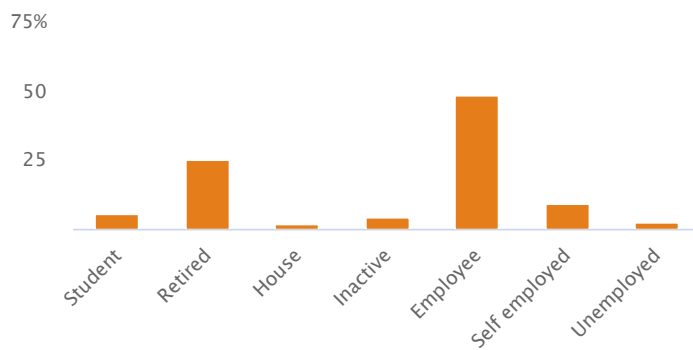
## Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



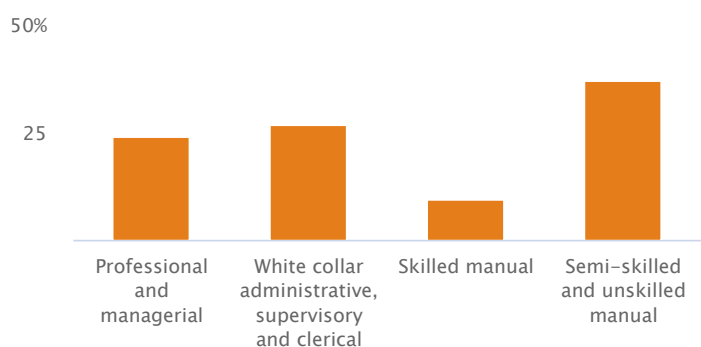
## Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

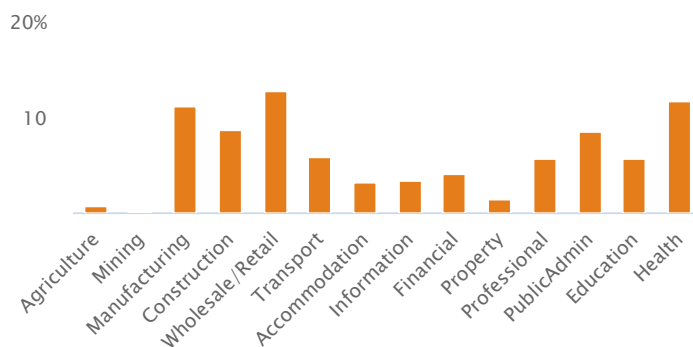


## Social Grade

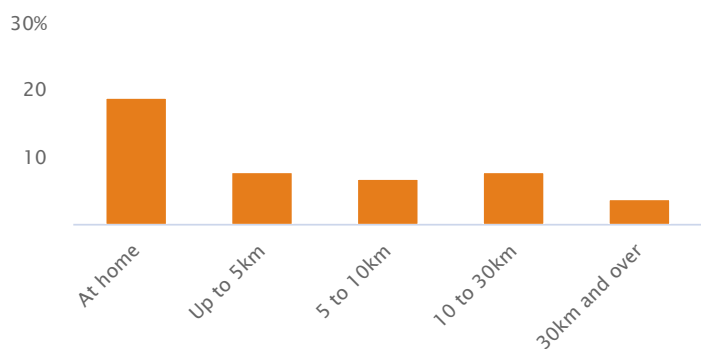
(% households aged 16-64)



## Sector Diversity

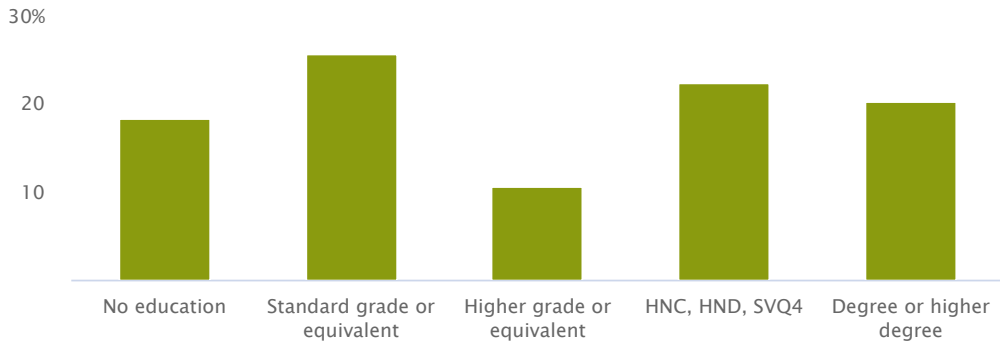

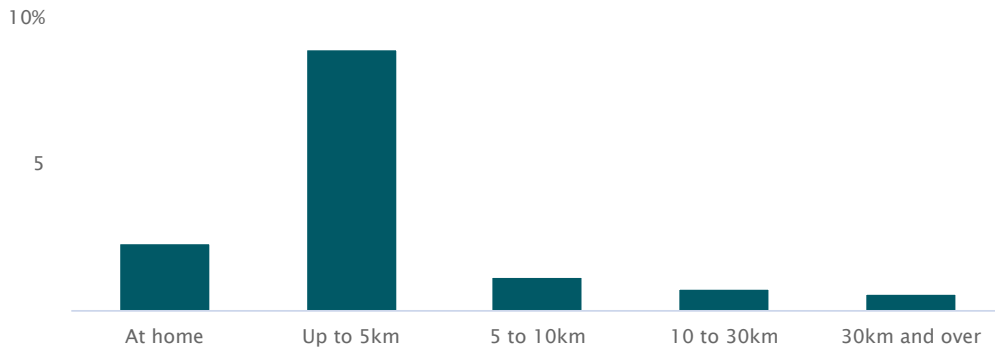


Number of people per shop
