Elderslie in Renfrewshire is a post-industrial town where mining, distilling, textiles and carpets for ships were key industries. It is now a commuter settlement


In medium towns such as this, the population is typically older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Population change 2011 to 2022






Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)




Social Grade

(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




Occupation

(% aged 16-74)






