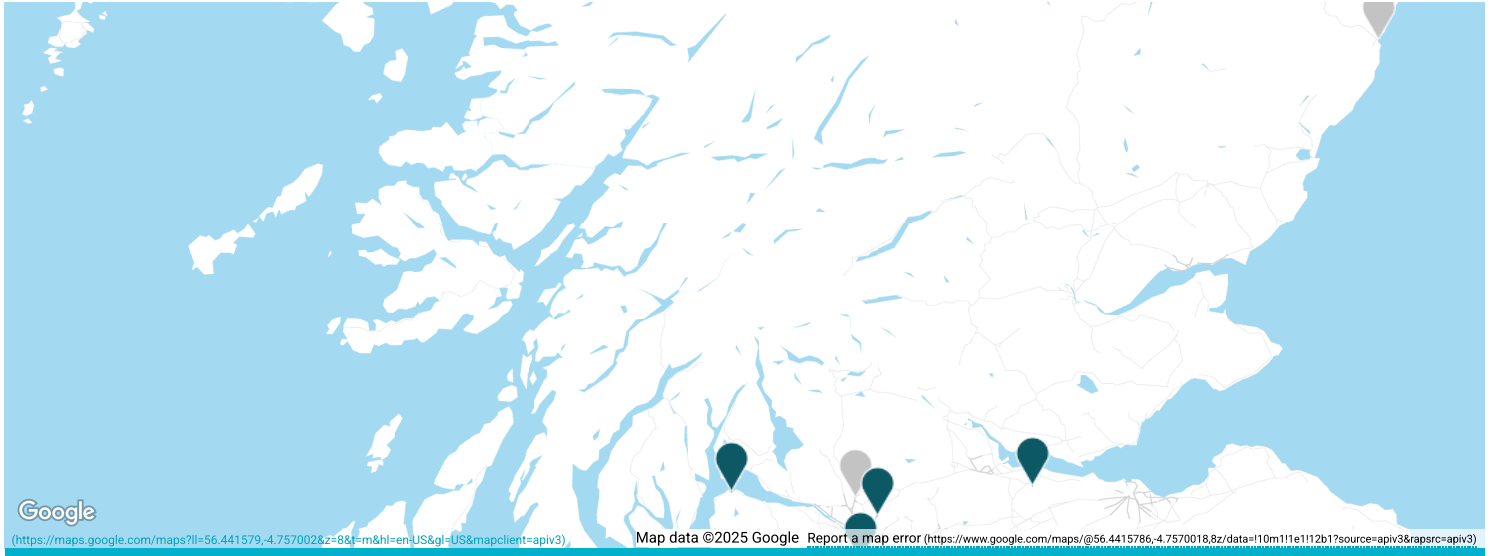




Ellon

Ellon in Aberdeenshire was a Pictish settlement. It served as a local market town with associated industries but expanded considerably with the oil boom as a commuter town.

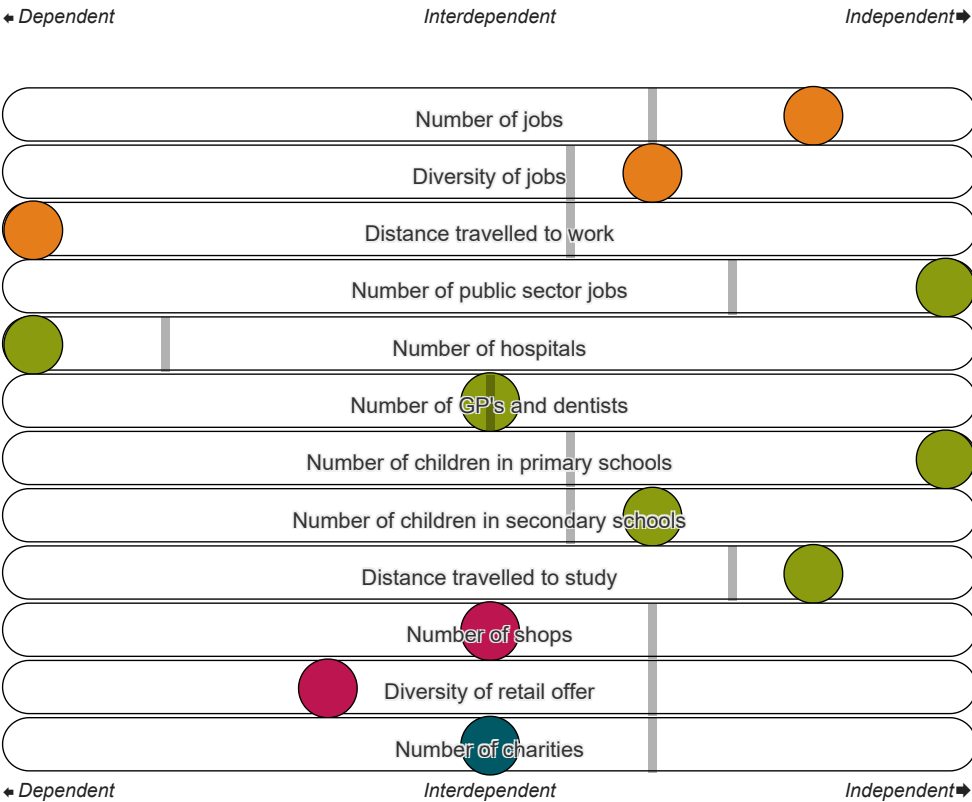
In large towns such as this one, the population typically is older. The group has higher social grade status than other groups, a higher proportion are owner occupiers and car ownership is also higher.

Ellon is an interdependent to independent town.

Inter-relationships



Ellon is an **interdependent to independent** town.

Combining inter-relationships and typology, Ellon is grouped with 7 other towns. It has similarities to these towns in terms of the number of charities, hospitals, children in secondary schools, jobs, shops, and GP's and dentists. It also has similarities in the diversity of jobs, and the distance travelled to study.

It differs in terms of the number of children in primary schools, and diversity of retail offer. Ellon differs most from its group in the distance travelled to work.

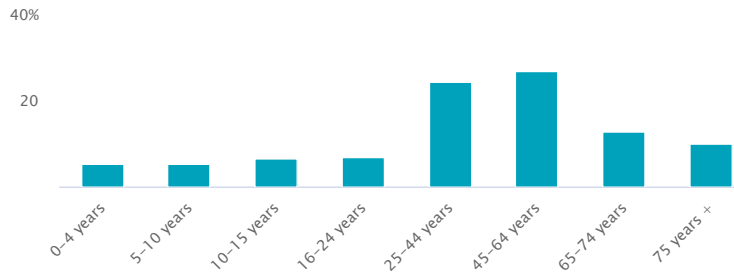

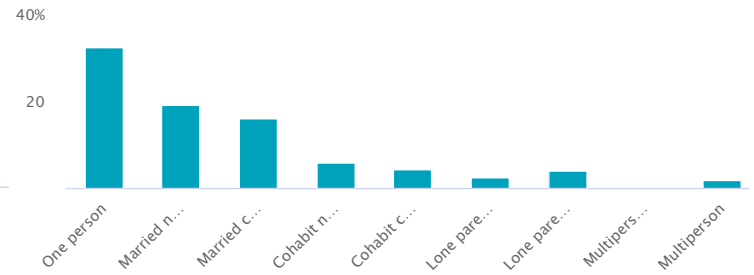

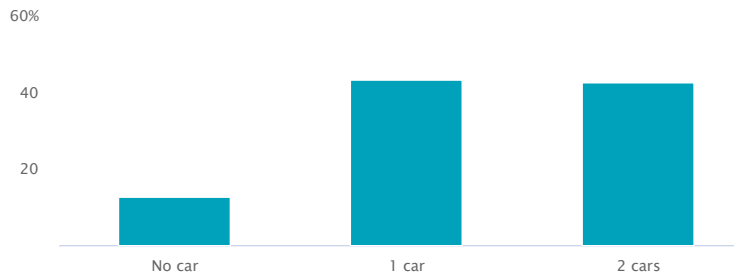

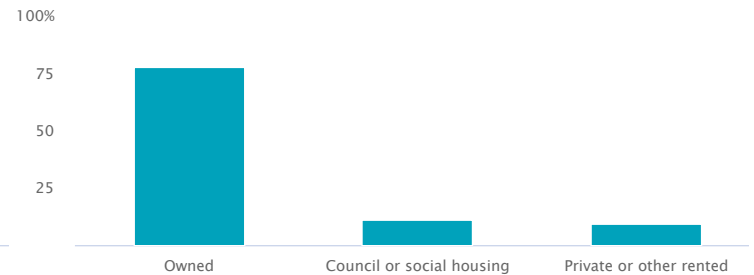

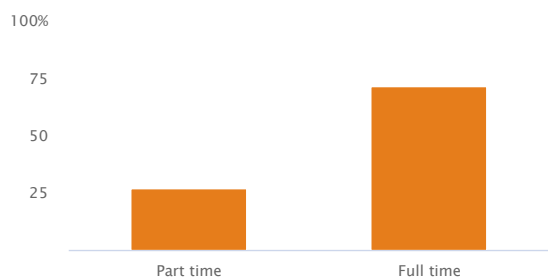

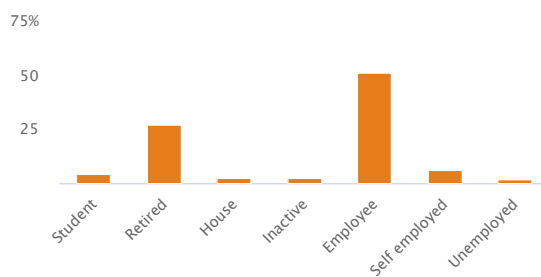
Employment type

(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



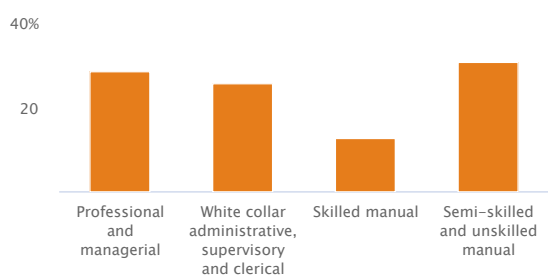
Occupation

(% aged 16-74)

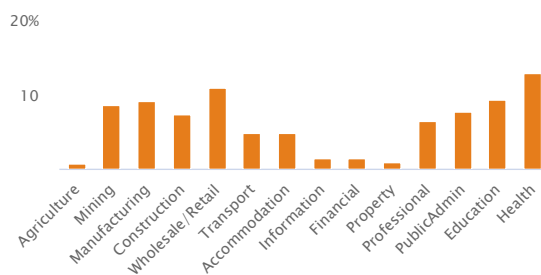

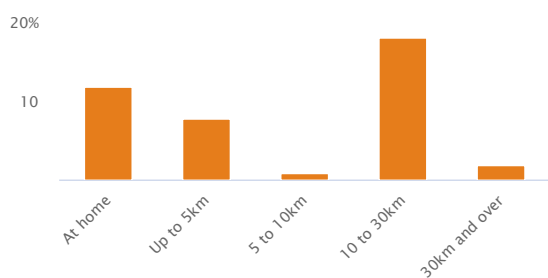
(% households aged 16-64)



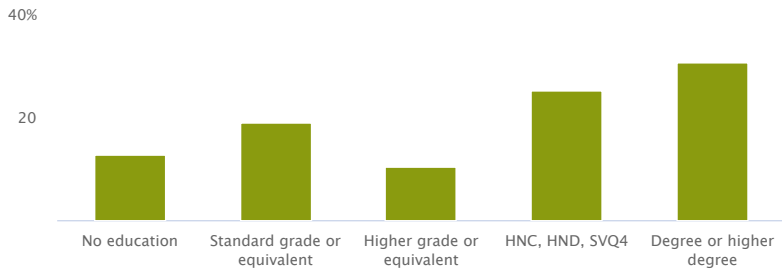
Sector Diversity

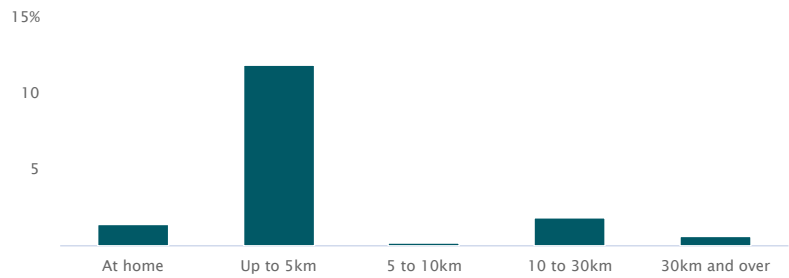
