Evanton in Easter Ross is in Highland. It developed from an estate village established by the local laird Alexander Fraser of Balconie in 1810 to house crofters who had been put off their land. The town suffered from famine and disease in the early 10th century but recovered to become a local service centre. The oil boom brought new industries and expansion of the town.


In this type of small town, the population comprises families with a higher proportion of adults in the 25–44 age grouping. Higher rates of full time employment are found.

Evanton is a dependent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Airth, Almondbank, Ashgill, and Bilston.










