Eyemouth in Scottish Borders is a traditional fishing town. Historically it had a reputation for smuggling. In the 1960s the harbour was deepened to accommodate new larger fishing boats. There is an ice plant and fish market.


In medium towns like this one, people experience more challenging circumstances with higher rates of unemployment, poorer health, lack of a car, lower levels of education and lower social grades than other groups. A higher proportion live in social rented housing. There is a higher proportion of single person households and lone parents.

Eyemouth is an independent to interdependent town.

Its most similar towns are Annan, Campbeltown, Duns, and Huntly.





(% working full time vs part time aged 16-74)



(% households aged 16-64)




Distance travelled to work




